AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND
3,793 km² 1,710 t 570 ha

In 2017, Cacoal produced 1,710 t of soy occupying a total of 570 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1360th in Brazil in soy production, and 27th in the state of Rondonia. The largest exporter of soy in Cacoal was Amaggi, which accounted for 60.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Spain.

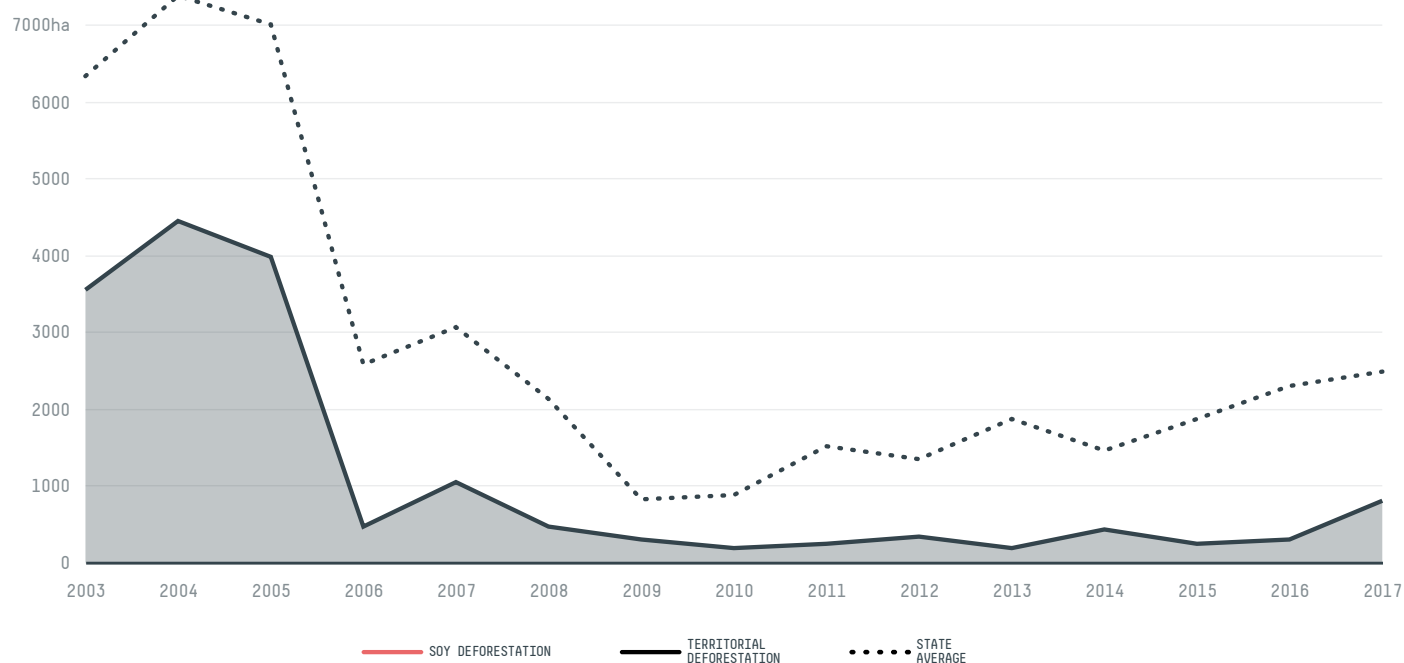

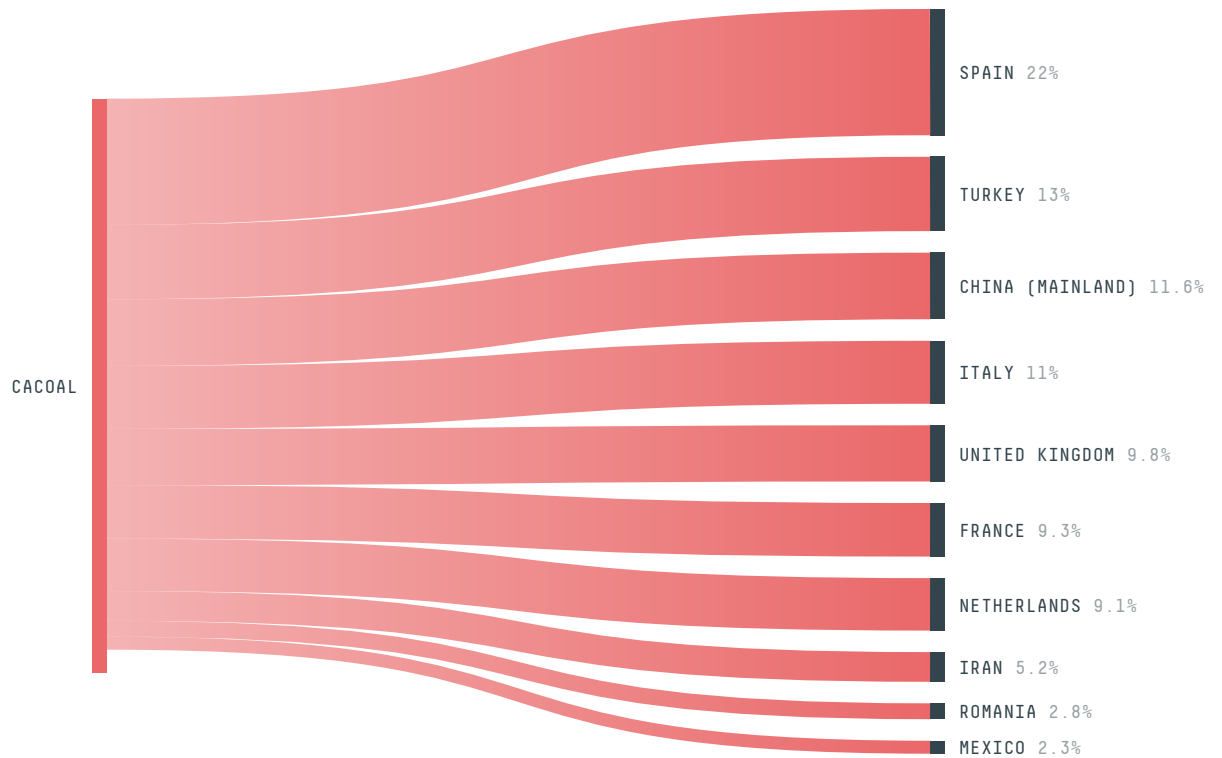
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CACAOAL
