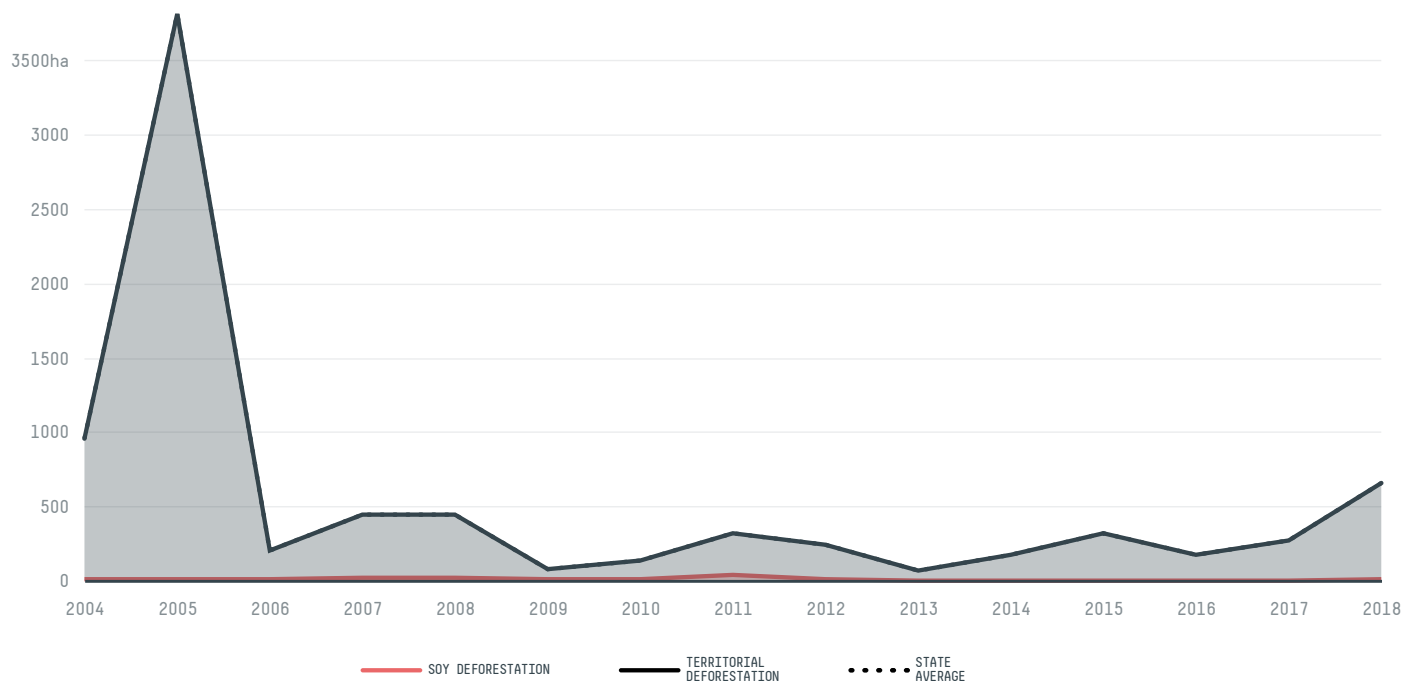
In 2018, Corumbiara produced 121,680 t of soy occupying a total of 39,000 ha of land. With 0.10% of the total production, it ranks 202nd in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Corumbiara was Cargill, which accounted for 68.7% of the total exports, and the main destination was Spain.

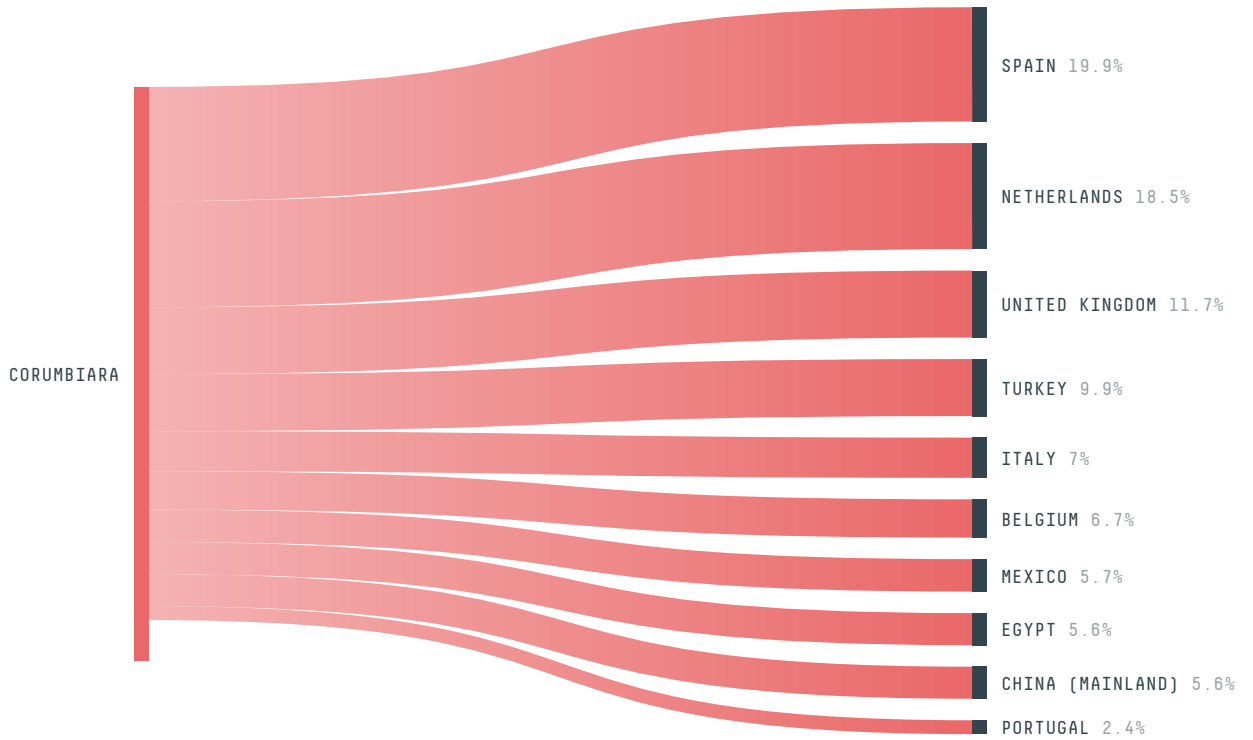

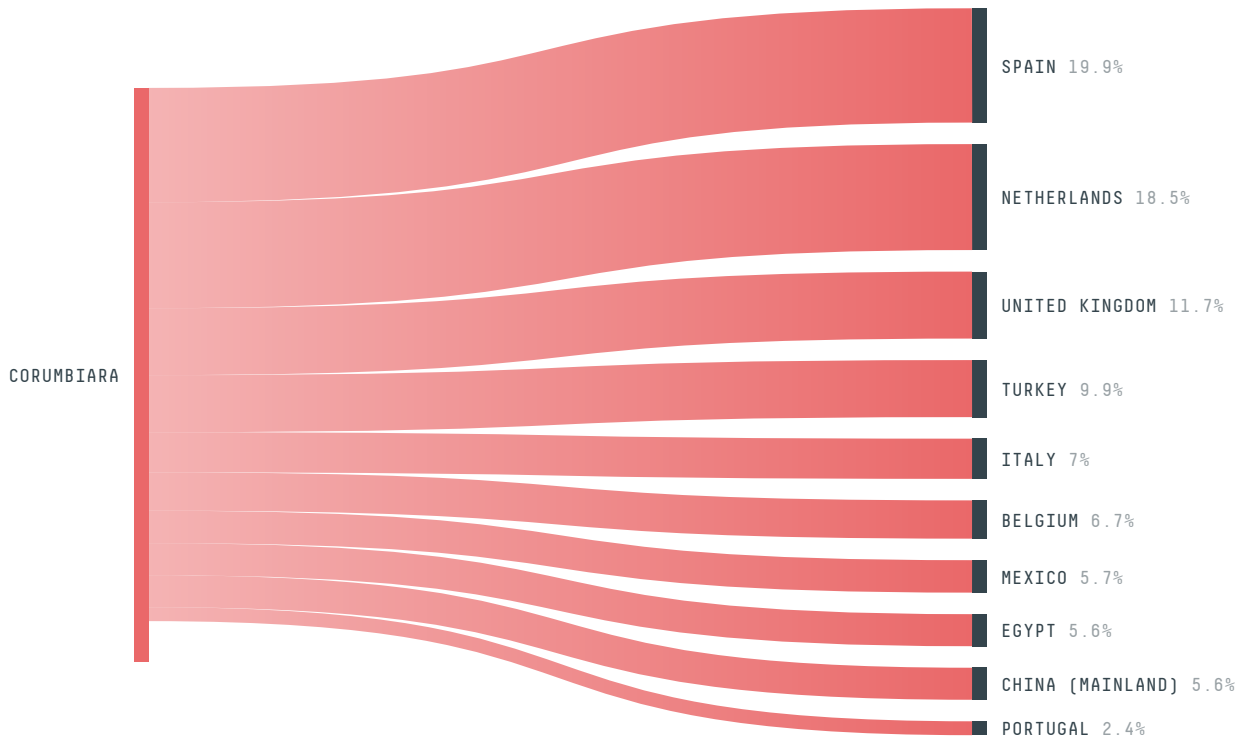
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CORUMBIARA
