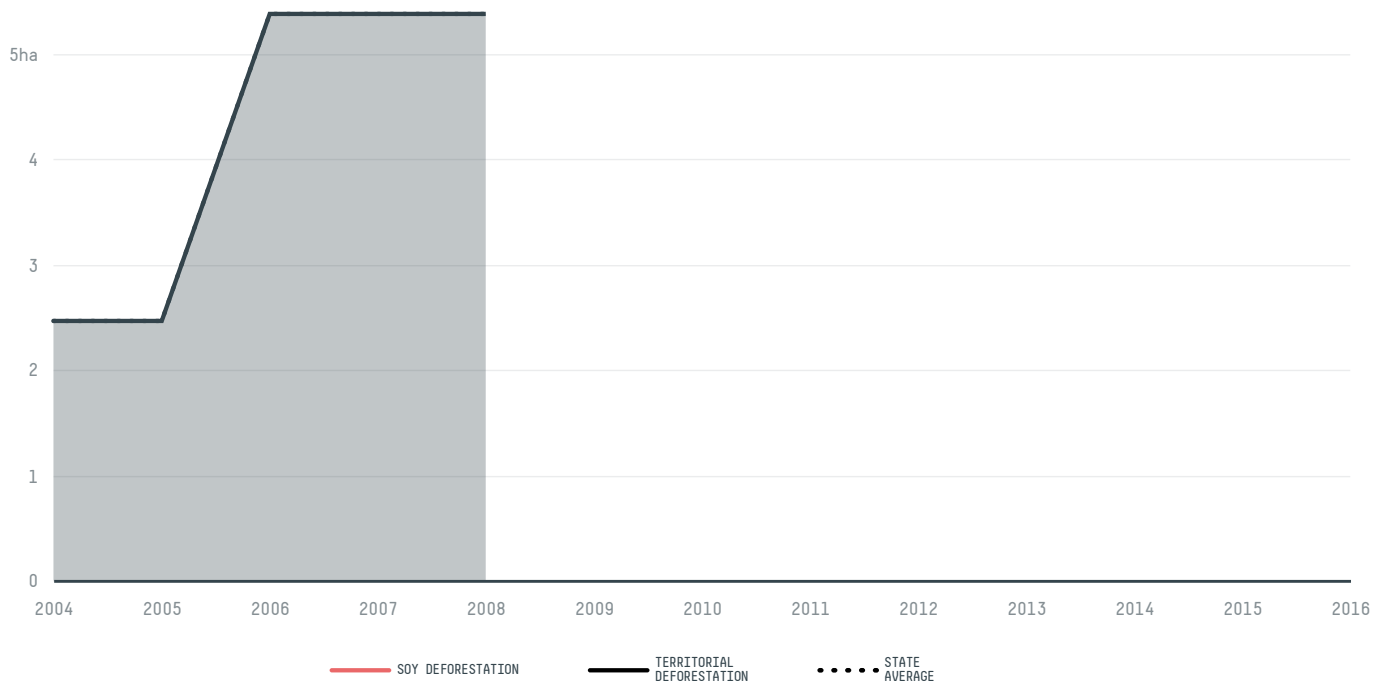
AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND

In 2015, Itanhomi produced 7 t of soy occupying a total of 3 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1444th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Itanhomi was Adm, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

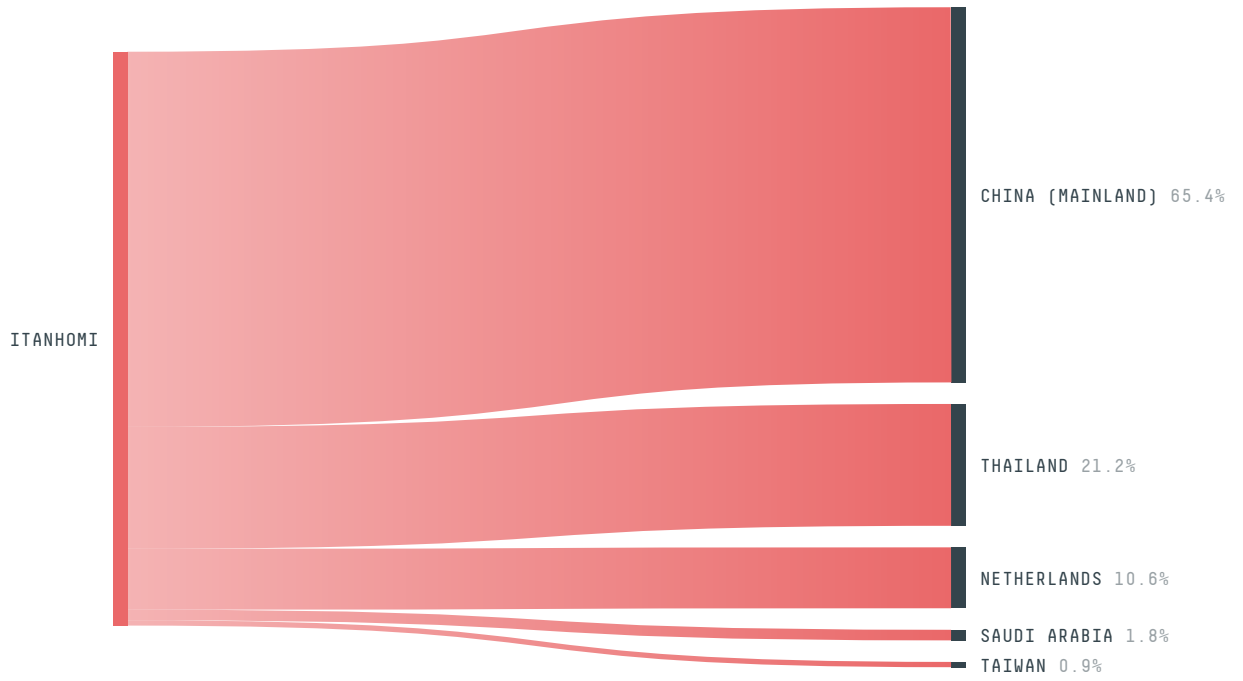
