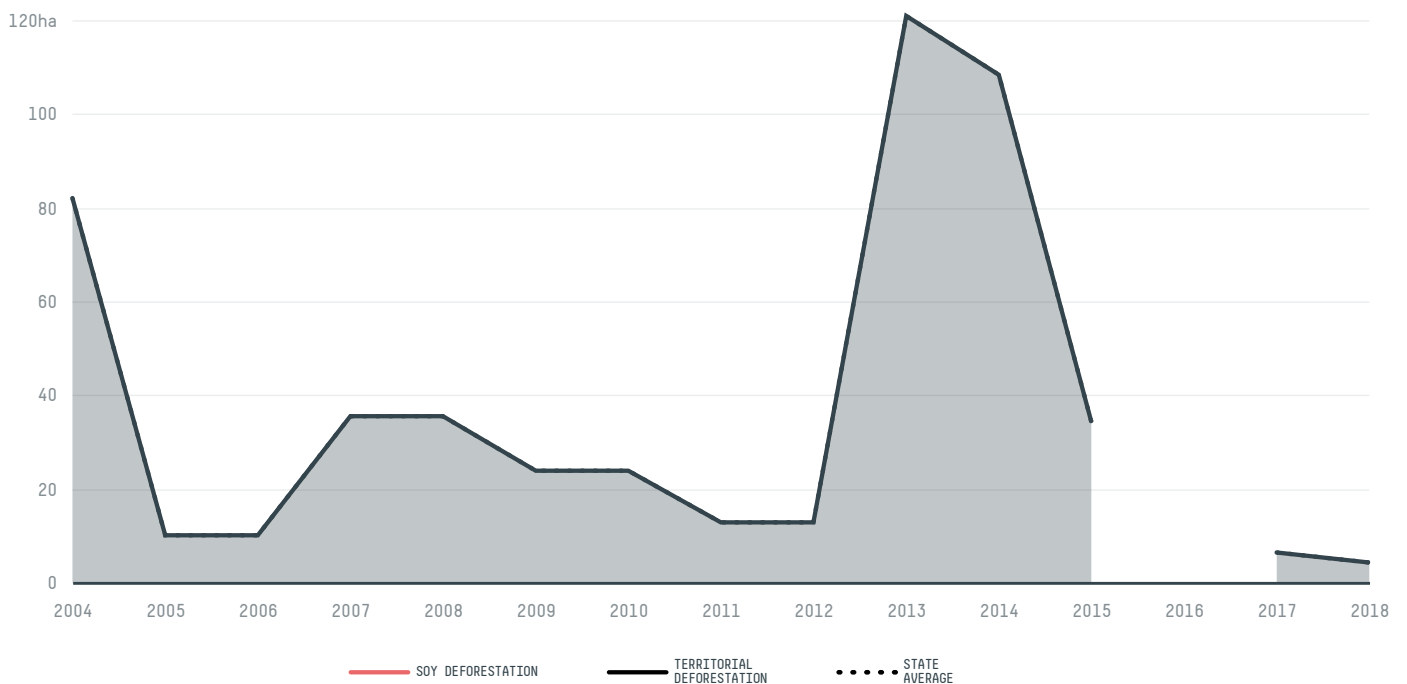

In 2018, Ibiraci produced 900 t of soy occupying a total of 250 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1463rd in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Ibiraci was Louis Dreyfus, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

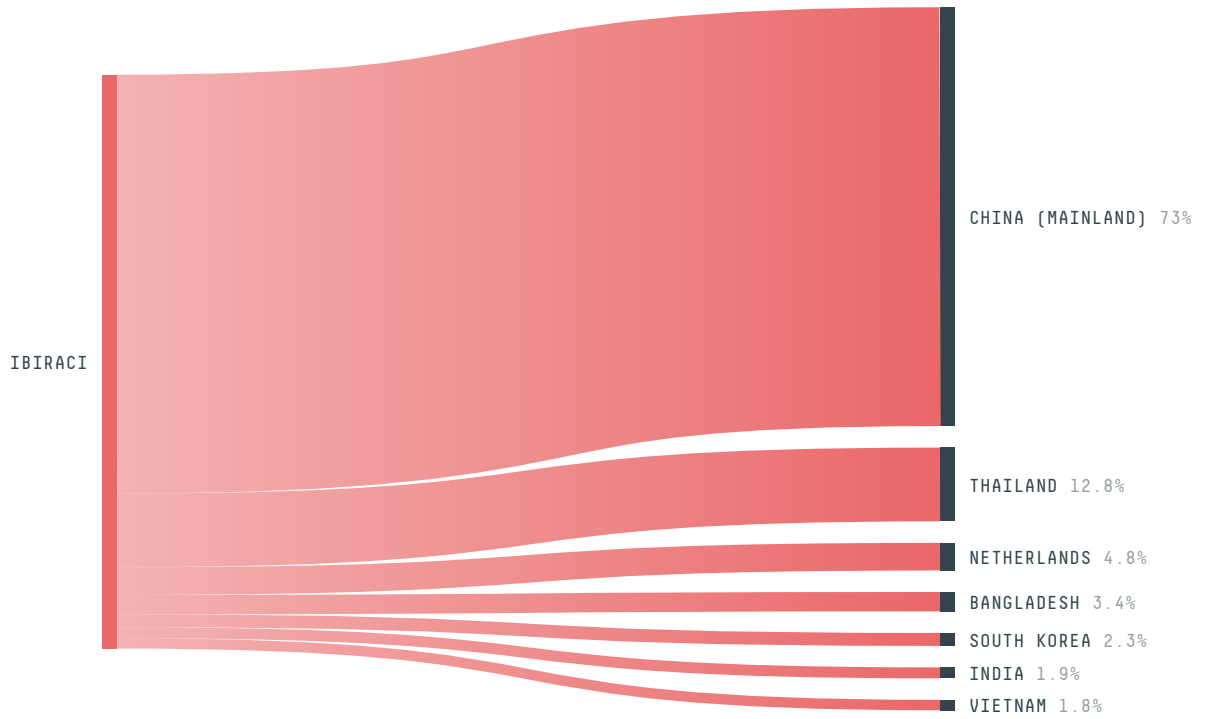

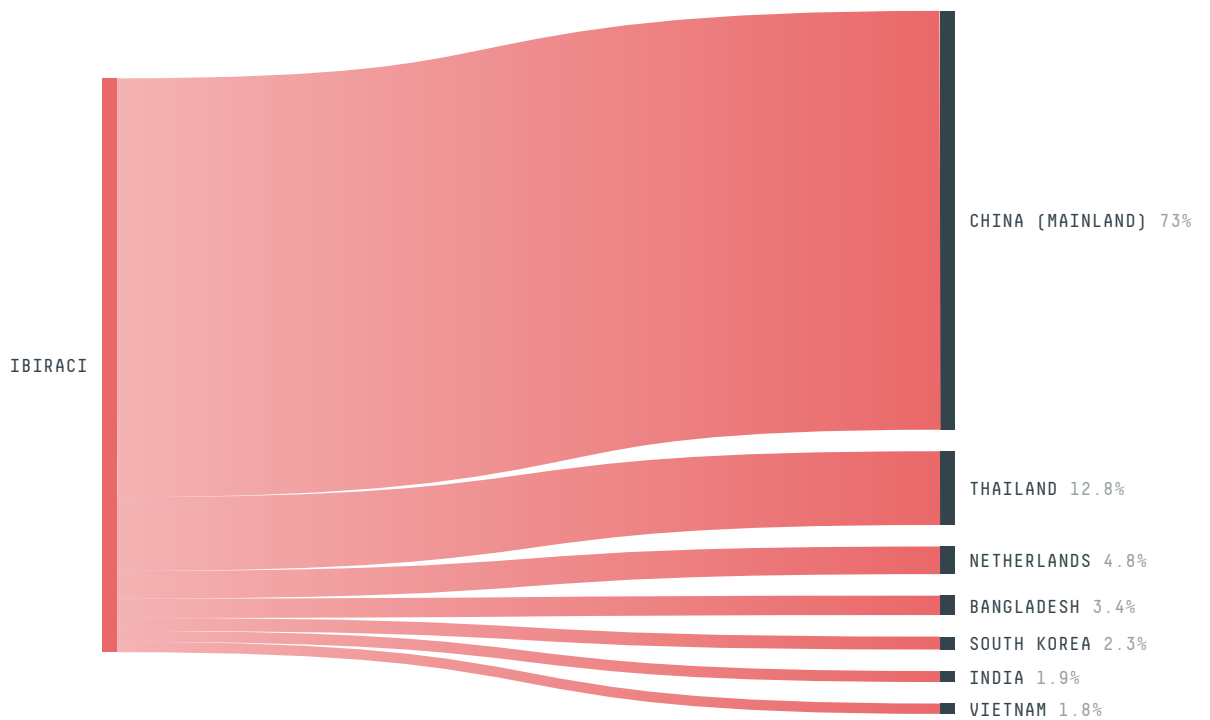
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF IBIRACI
