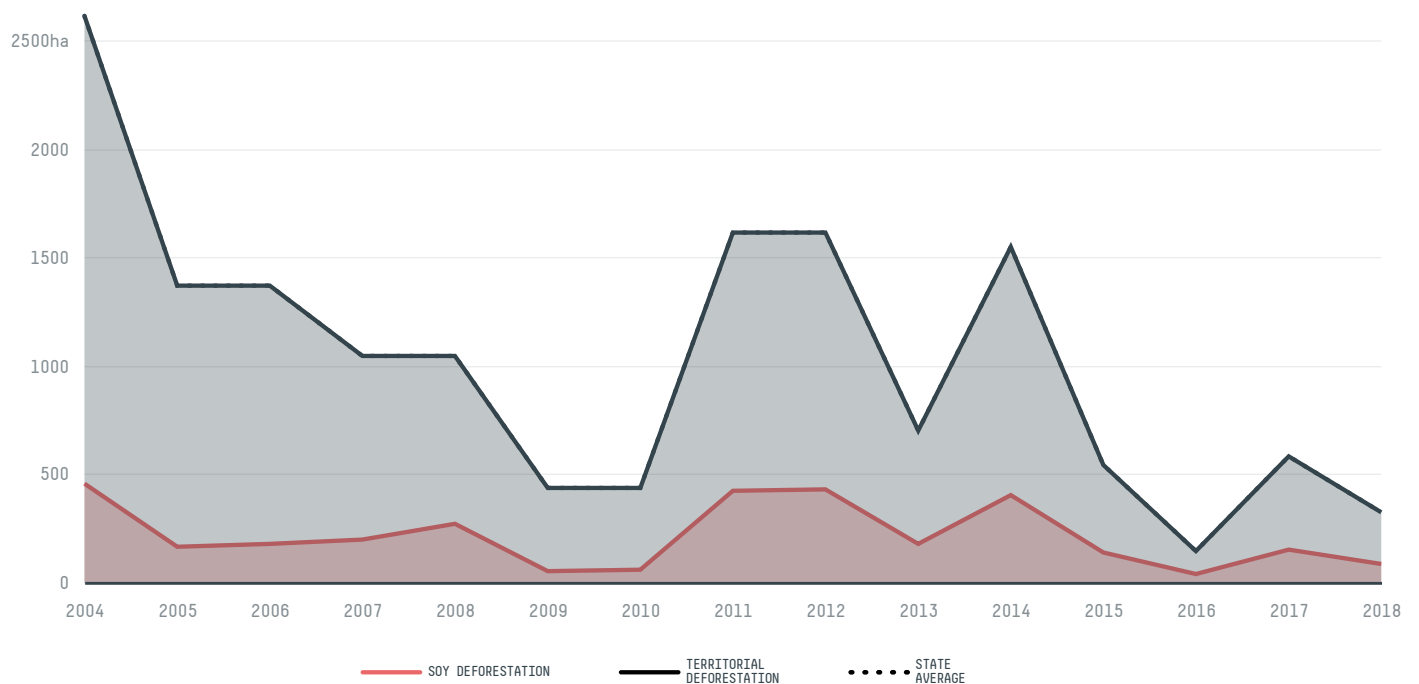
In 2018, Ibia produced 138,700 t of soy occupying a total of 38,000 ha of land. With 0.12% of the total production, it ranks 177th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Ibia was Adm, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).
