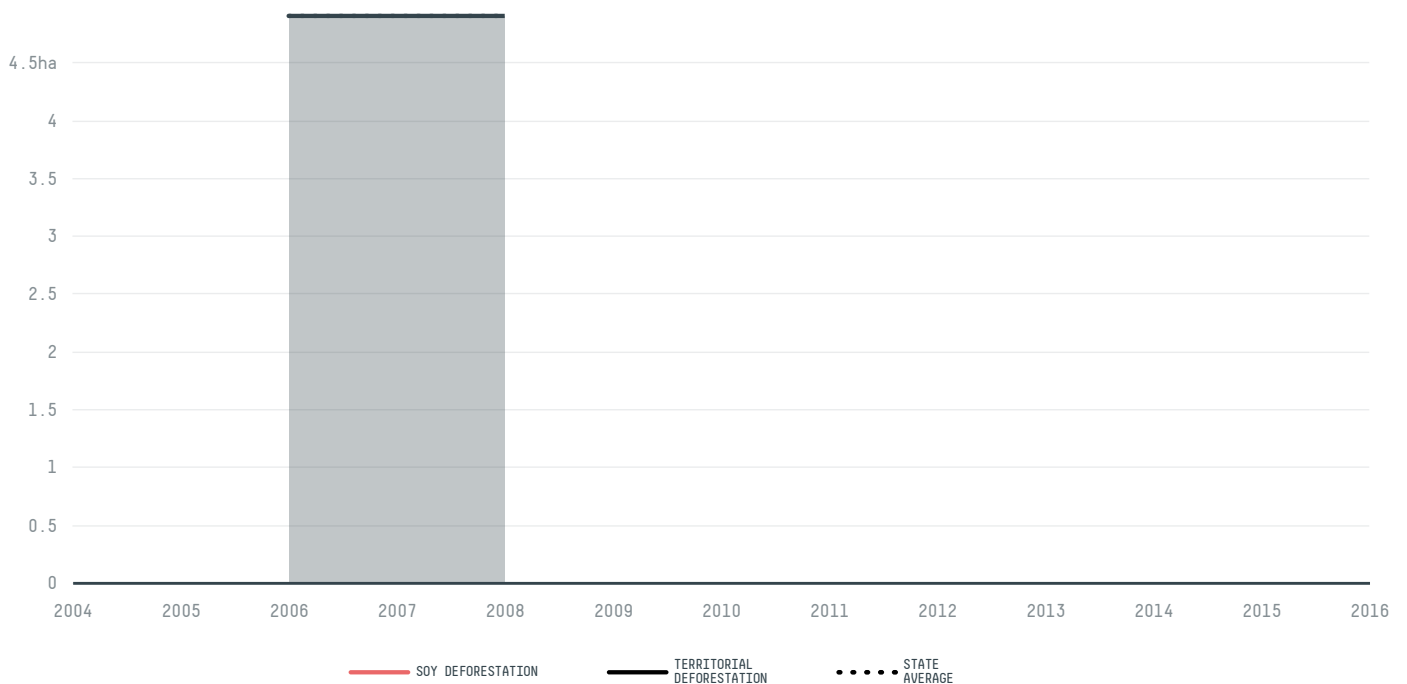
AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND

In 2016, Ibituruna produced 149 t of soy occupying a total of 45 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 14,28th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Ibituruna was Cutrale, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).
