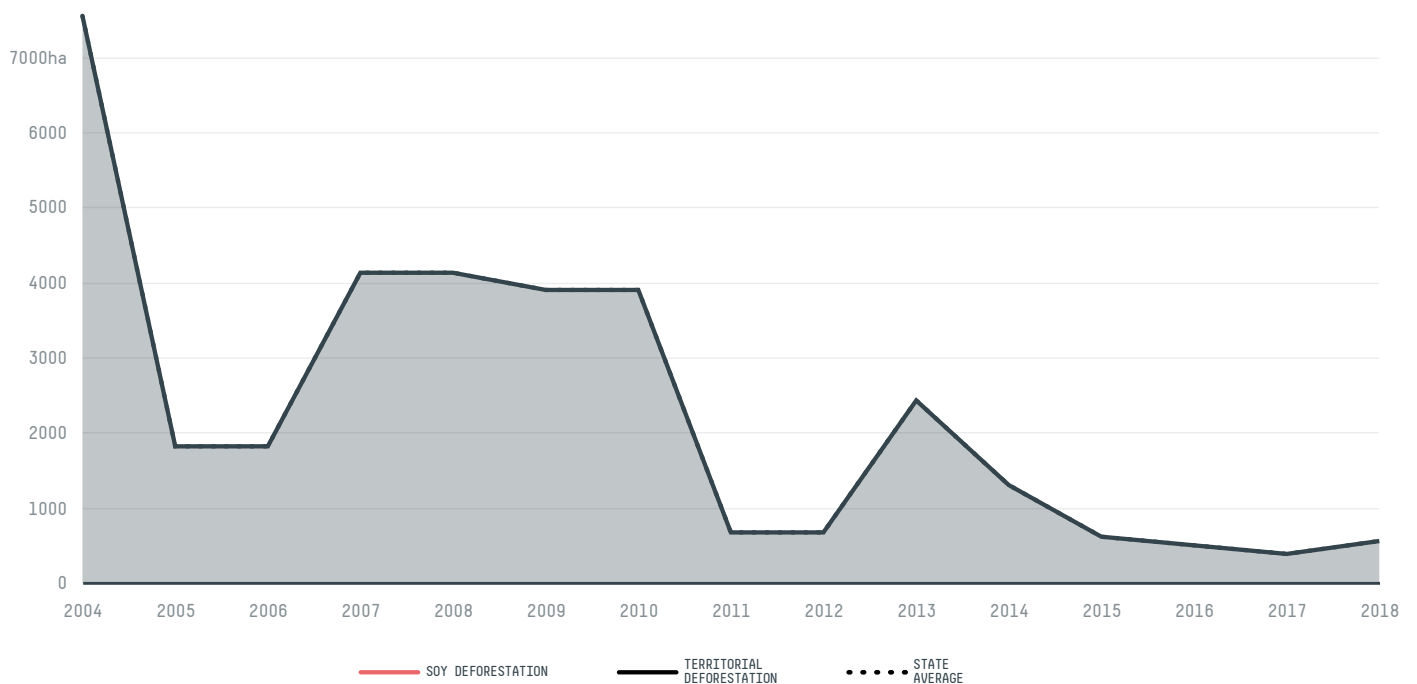
In 2004, Grao Mogol produced 16 t of soy occupying a total of 9 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1268th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Grao Mogol was Adm, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.
