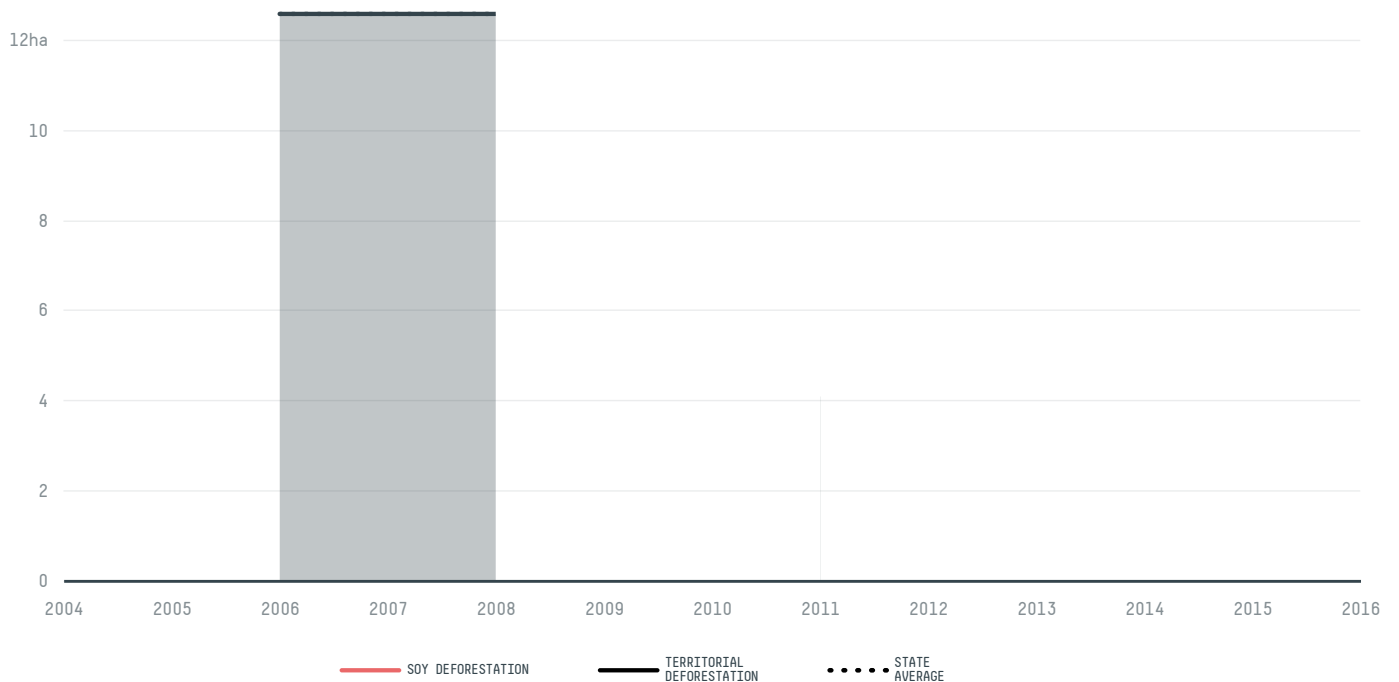
In 2018, Ipiacu produced 30,328 t of soy occupying a total of 8,999 ha of land. With 0.03% of the total production, it ranks 671st in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Ipiacu was Cutrale, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).
