In 2004, Ipigua produced 563 t of soy occupying a total of 245 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1092nd in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Ipigua was Citrovita Agro Industrial, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.

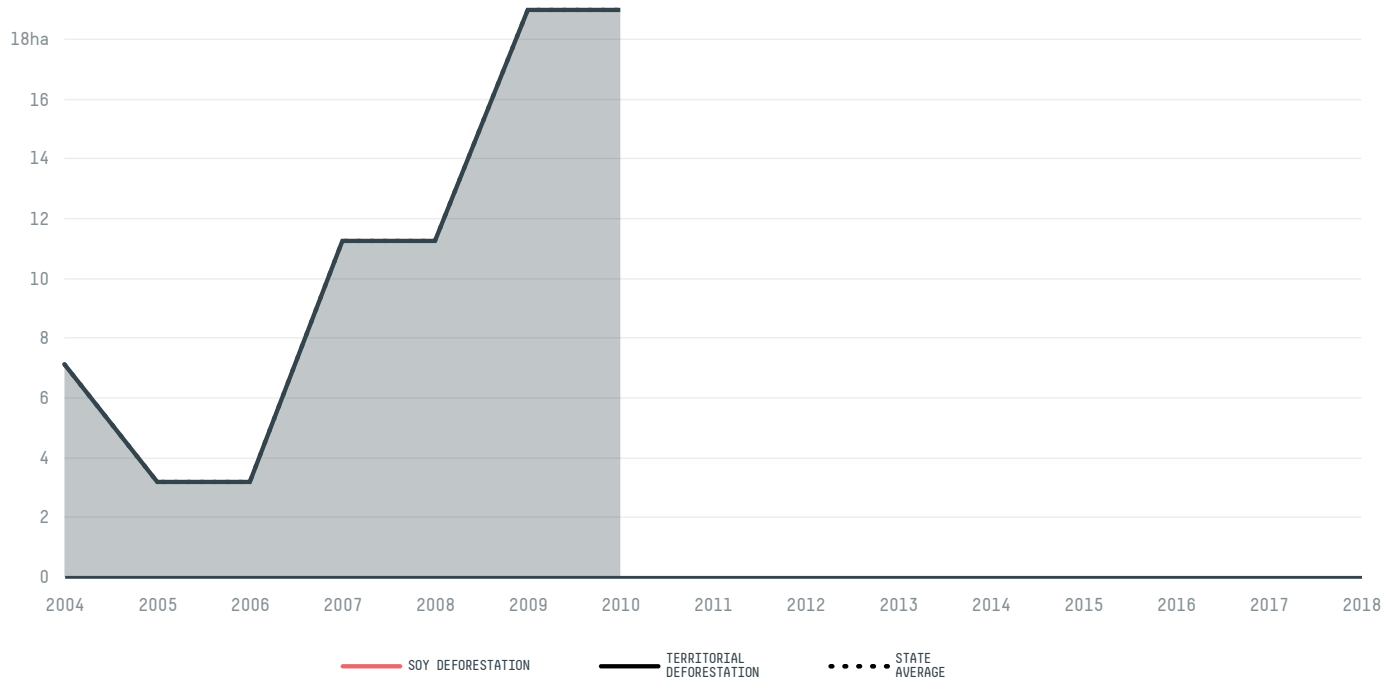
