In 2011, Olimpia produced 3,528 t of soy occupying a total of 1,400 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 894th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Olimpia was Guarani, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

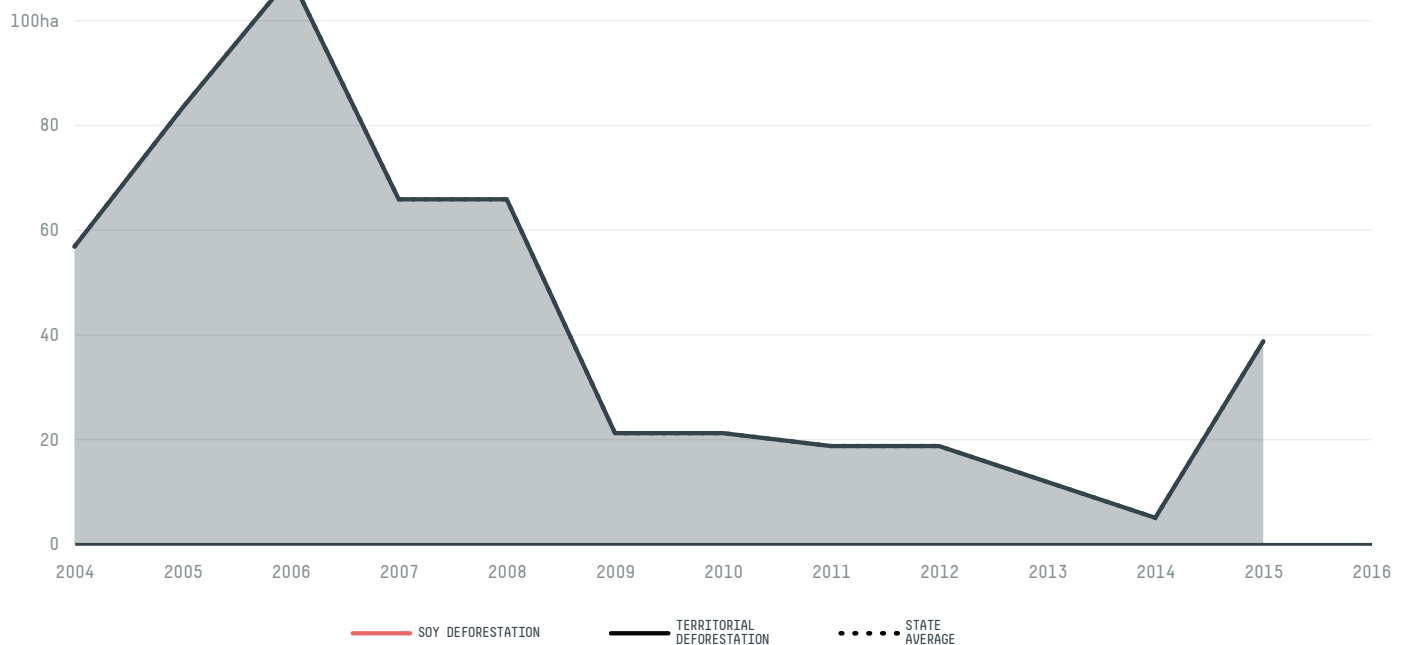
