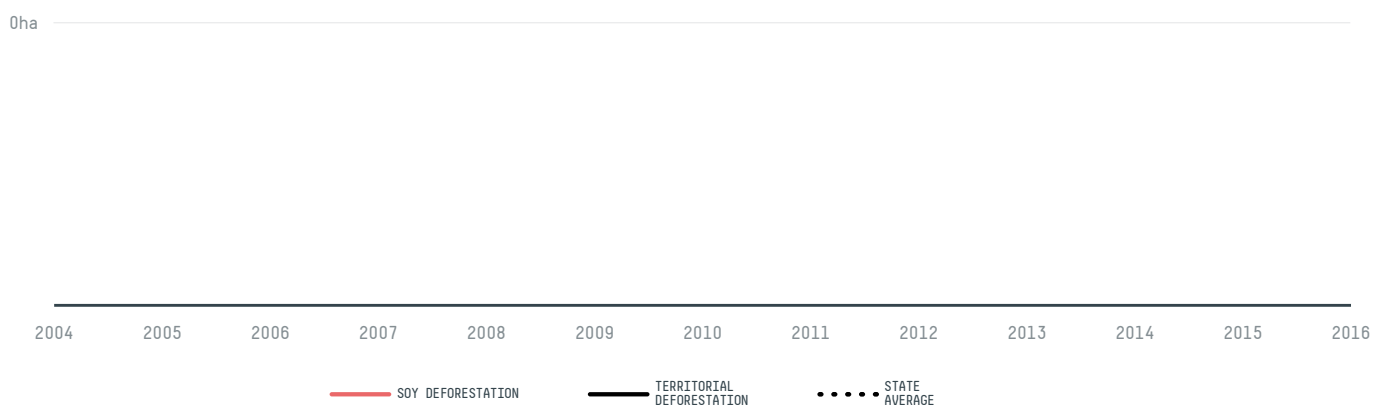
AREA PRODUCTION OF SOY SOY LAND

In 2017, Lindoia produced 14 t of soy occupying a total of 4 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1681st in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Lindoia was Galvani Industria, Comercio E Servicos, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

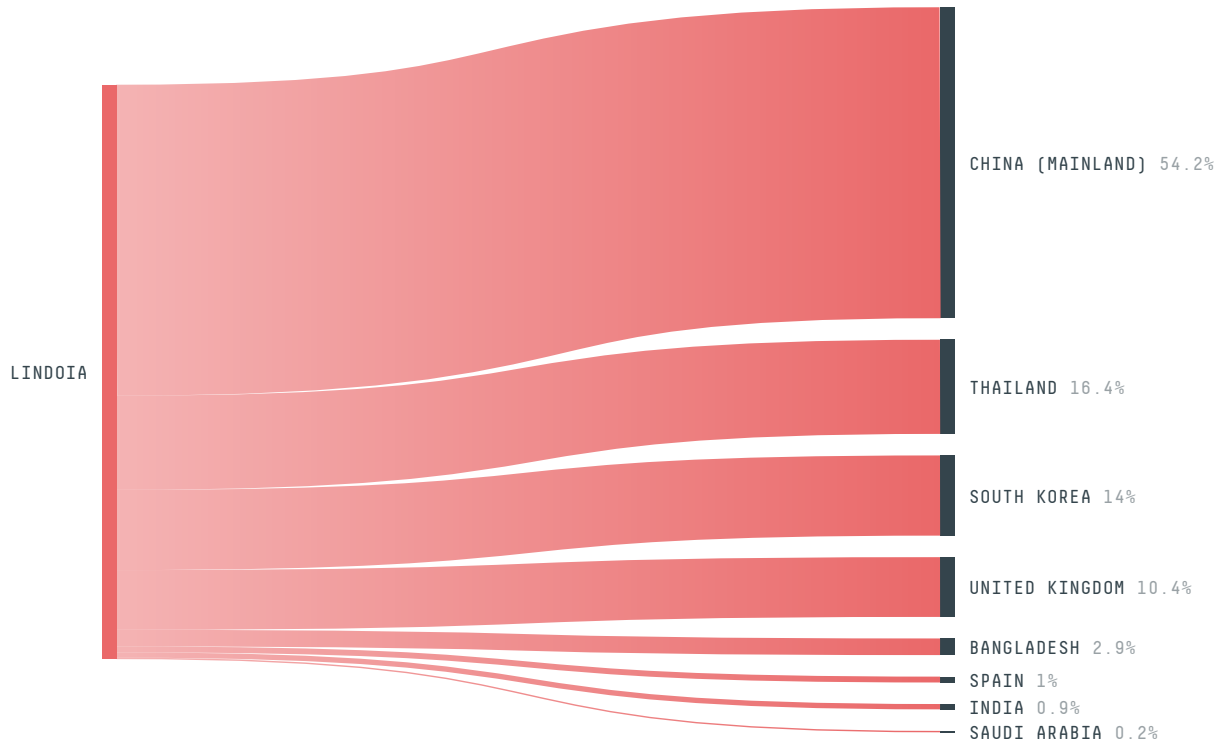

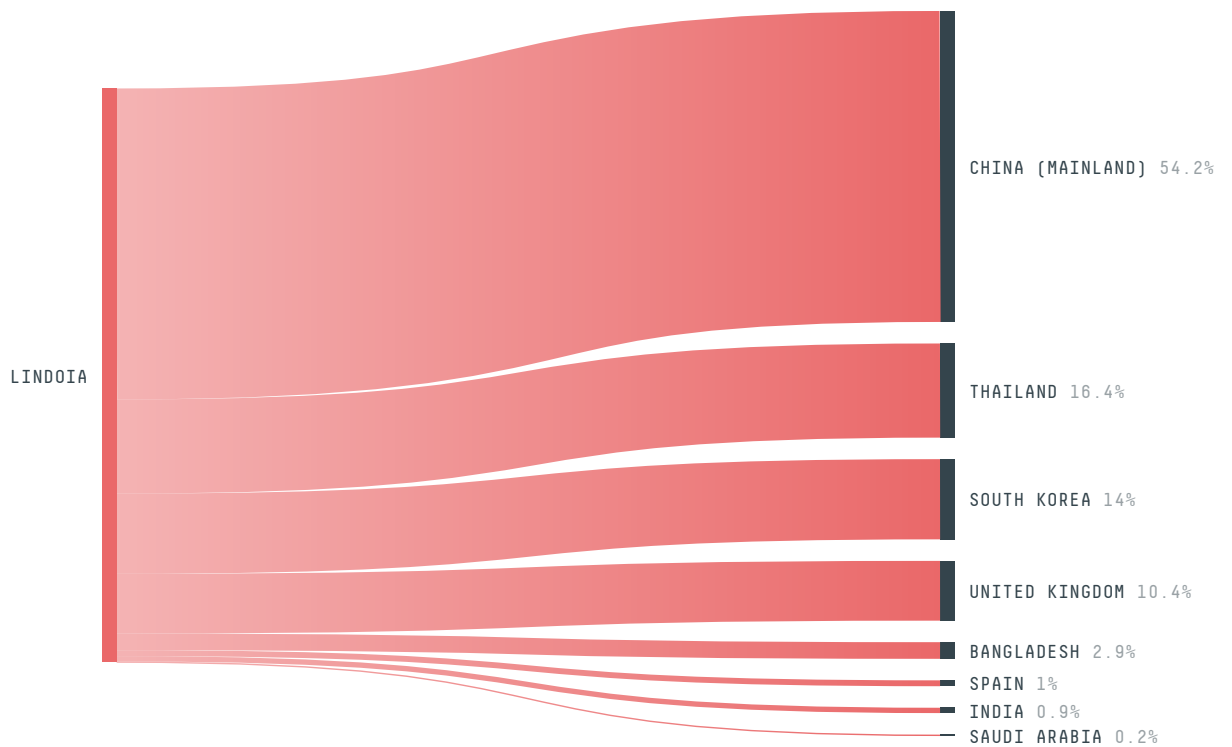
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF LINDOIA
