In 2008, Caracarai produced 1,740 t of soy occupying a total of 600 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 901st in Brazil in soy production, and 5th in the state of Roraima.

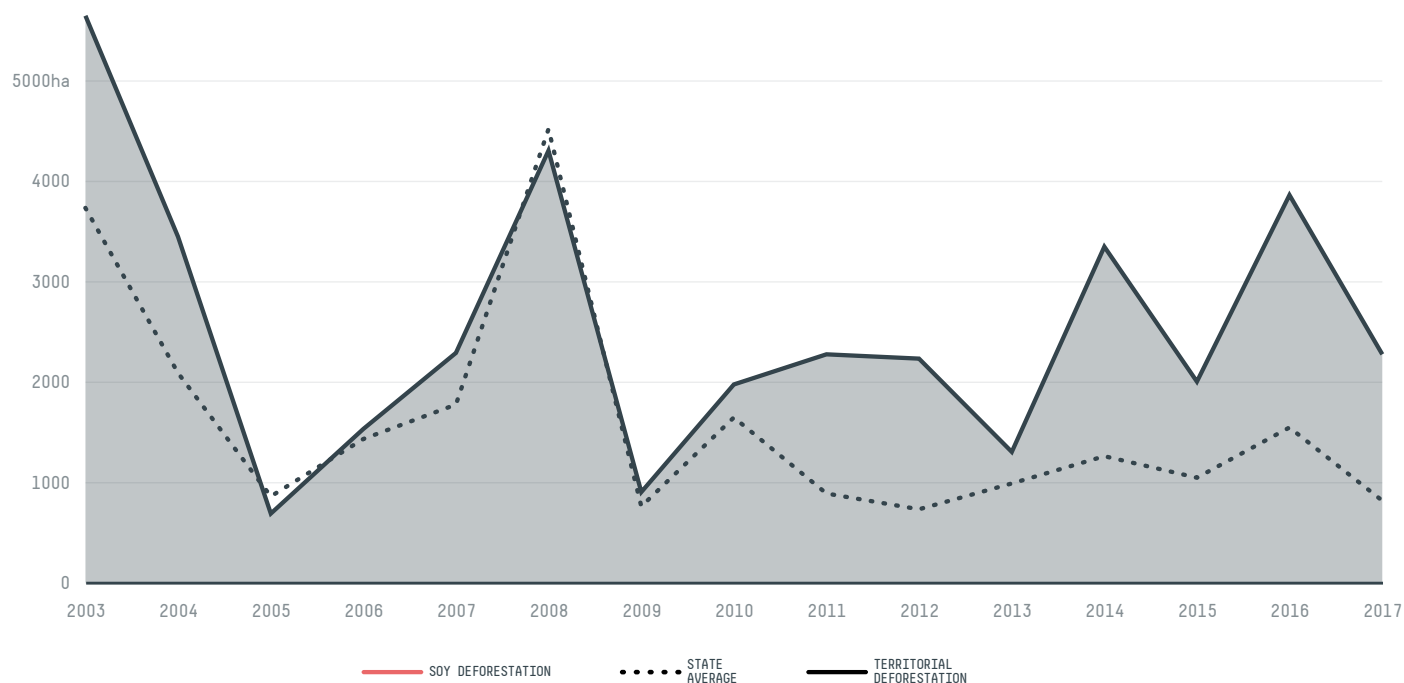

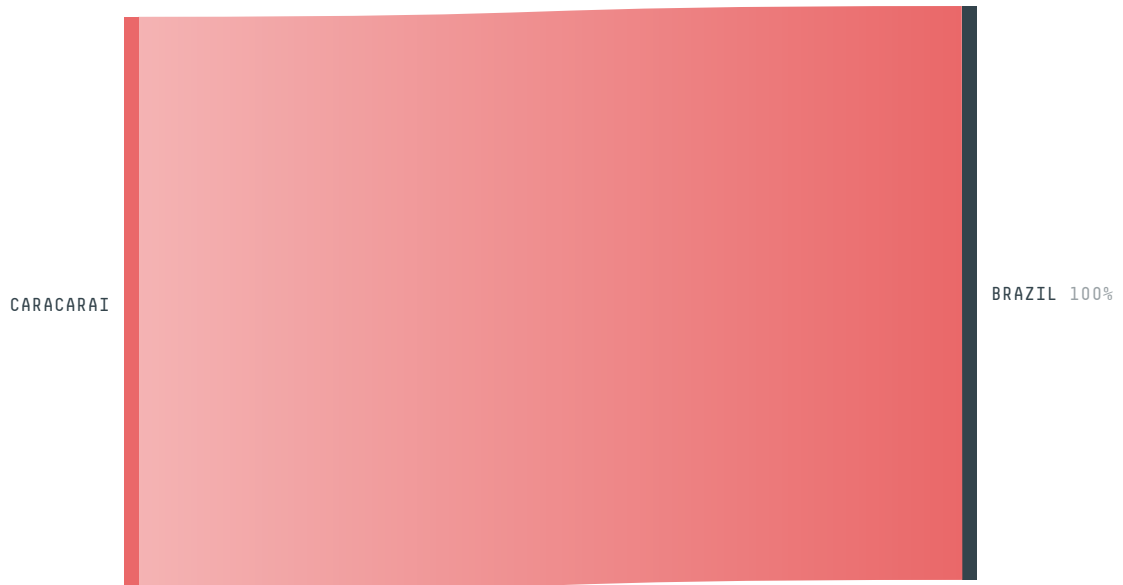
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CARACARAI
