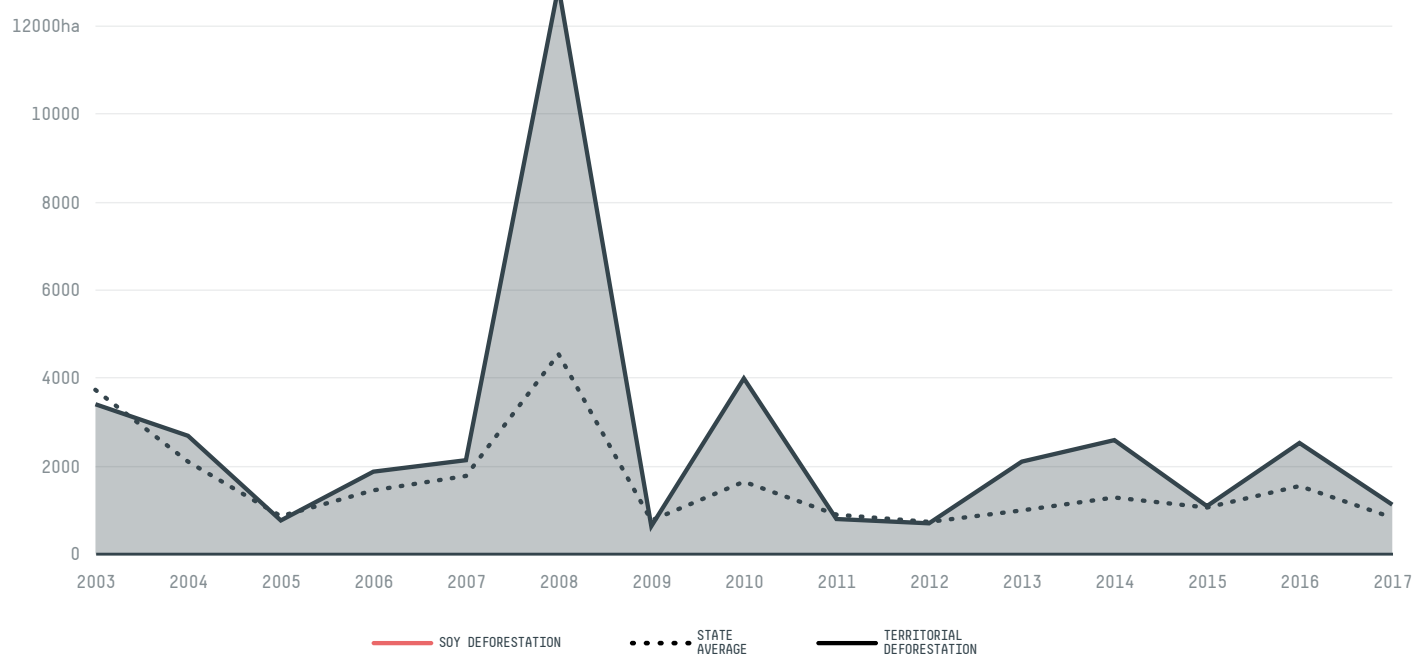

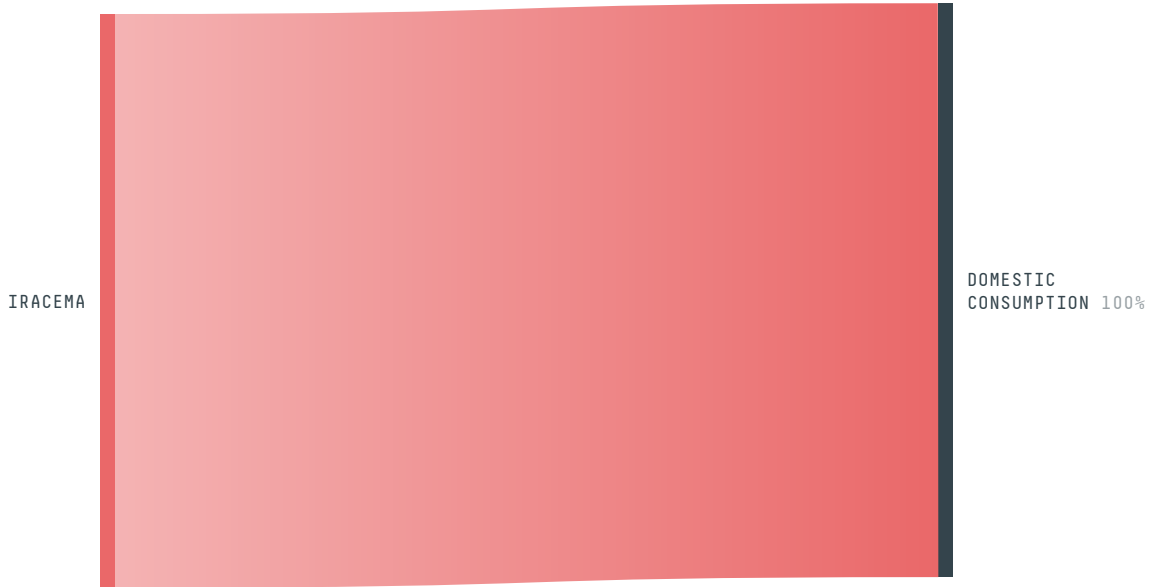

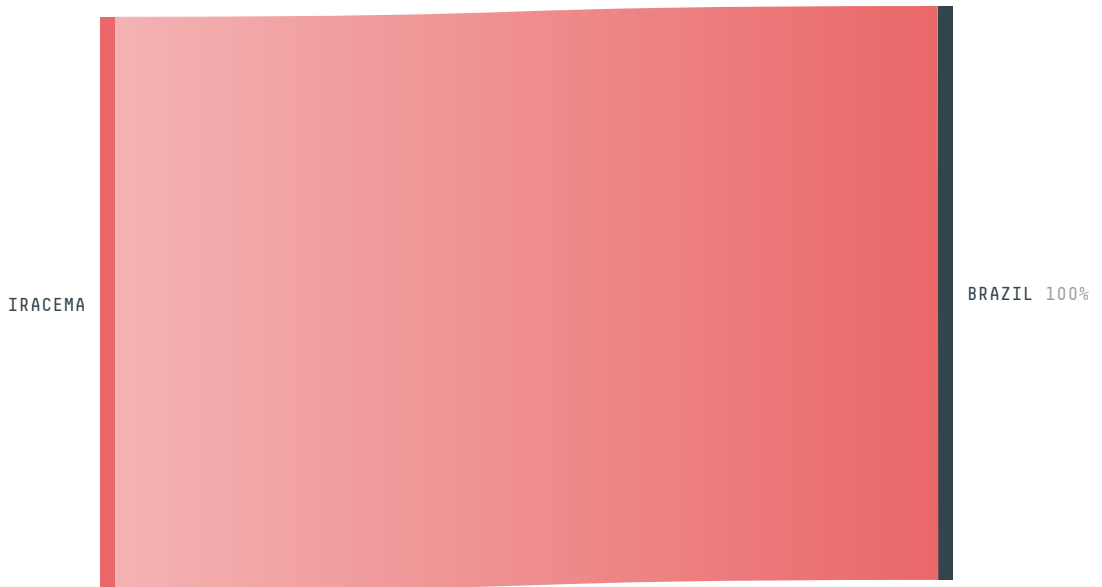
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF IRACEMA
