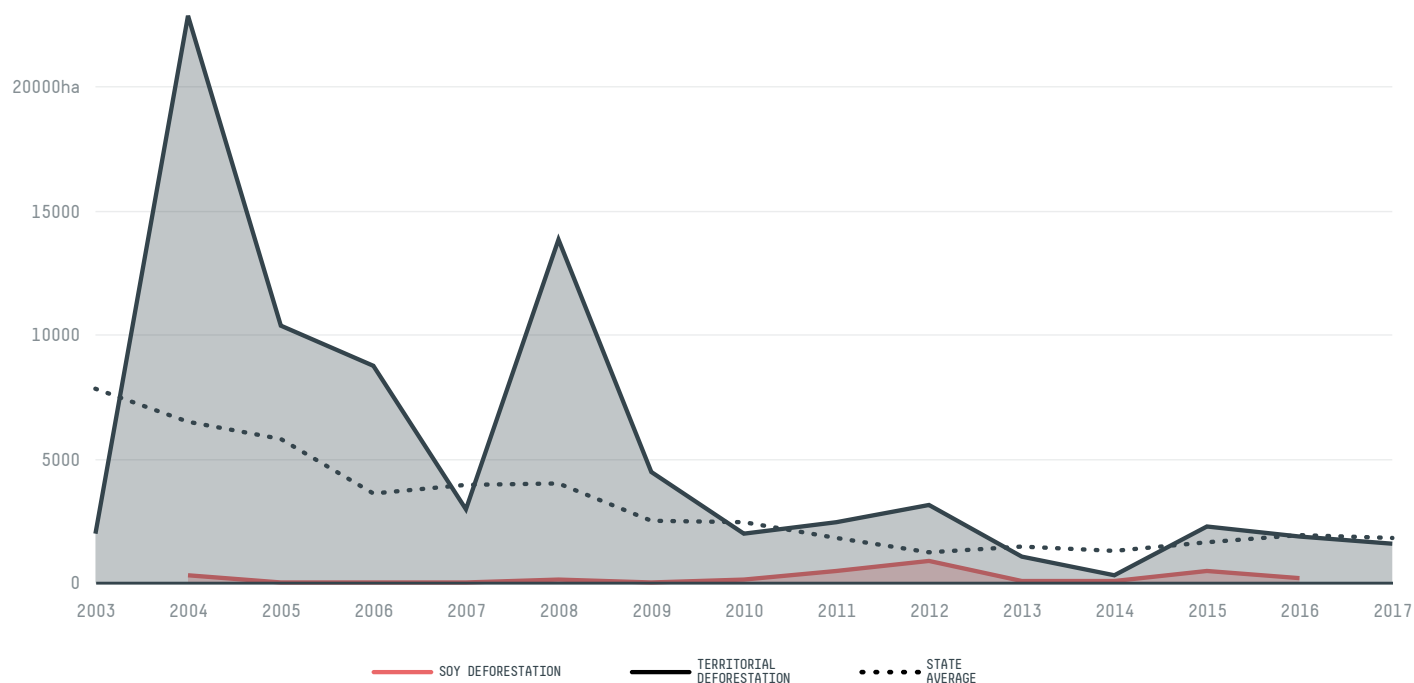
In 2017, Ulianopolis produced 174,600 t of soy occupying a total of 48,500 ha of land. With 0.09% of the total production, it ranks 143rd in Brazil in soy production, and 4th in the state of Para. The largest exporter of soy in Ulianopolis was Bunge, which accounted for 71.5% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

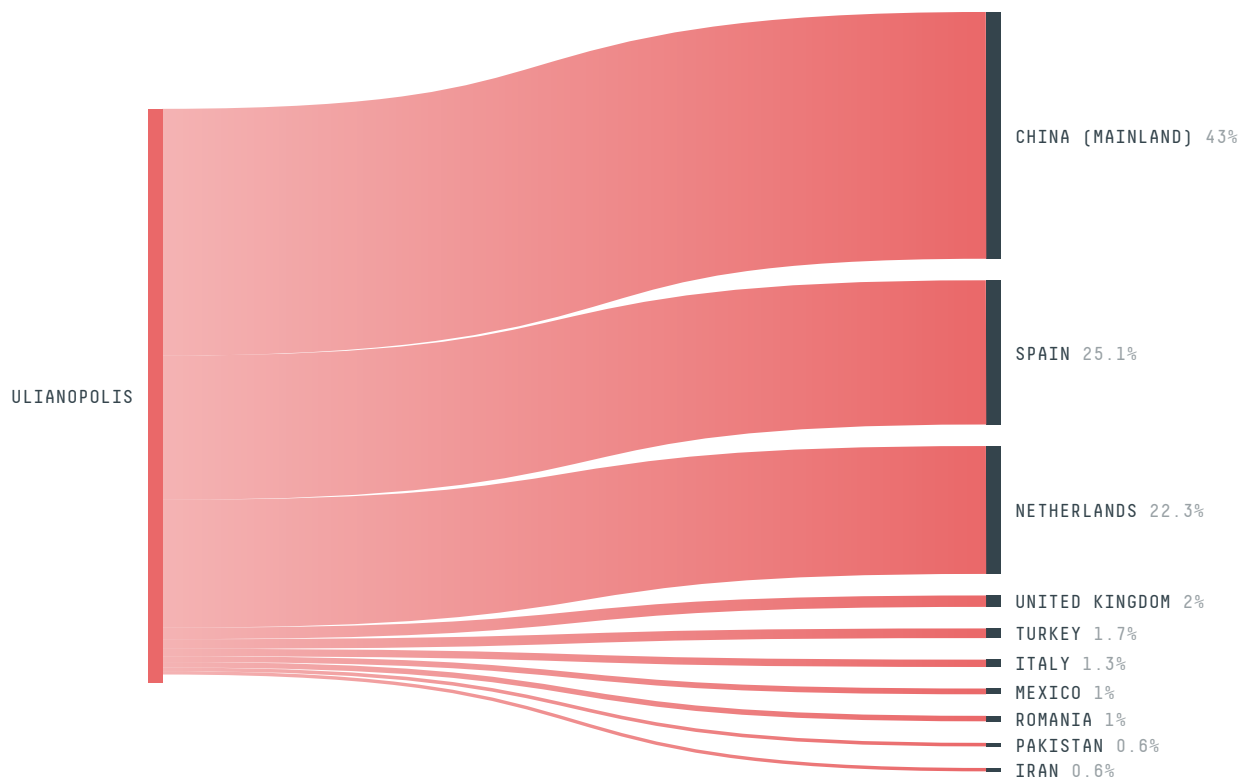
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ULIANOPOLIS

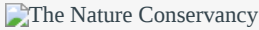
