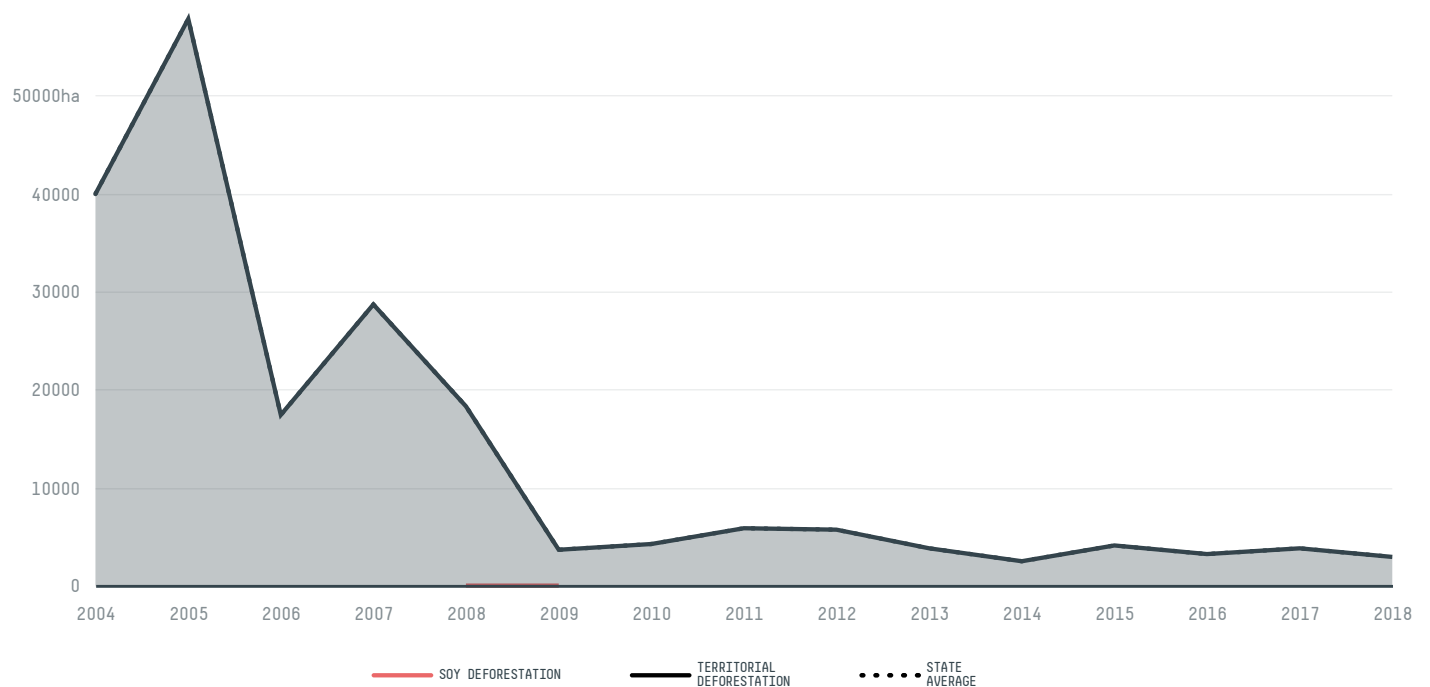
In 2018, Cumaru Do Norte produced 20,504 t of soy occupying a total of 10,252 ha of land. With 0.02% of the total production, it ranks 804th in Brazil in soy production. The largest exporter of soy in Cumaru Do Norte was Mitsubishi Corporation Do Brasil, which accounted for 47.2% of the total exports, and the main destination was China (Mainland).

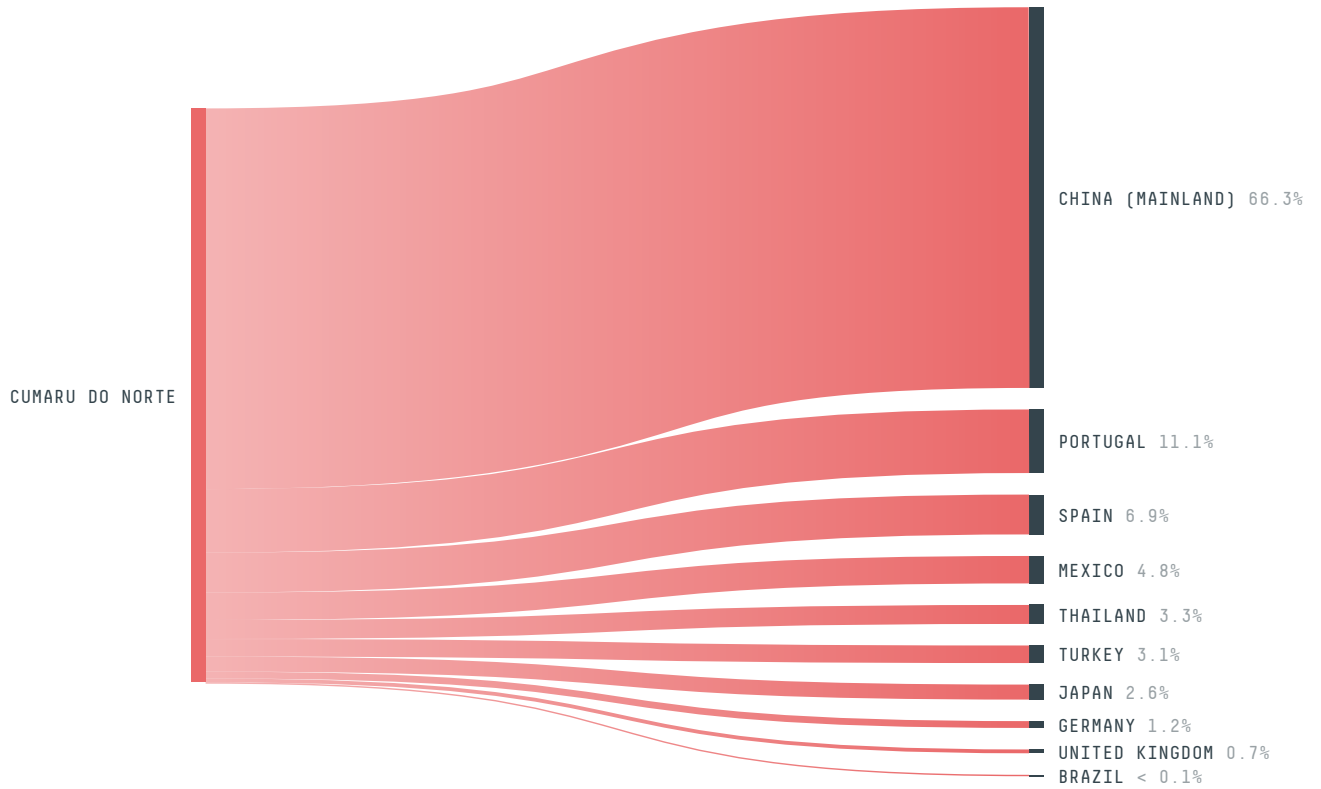

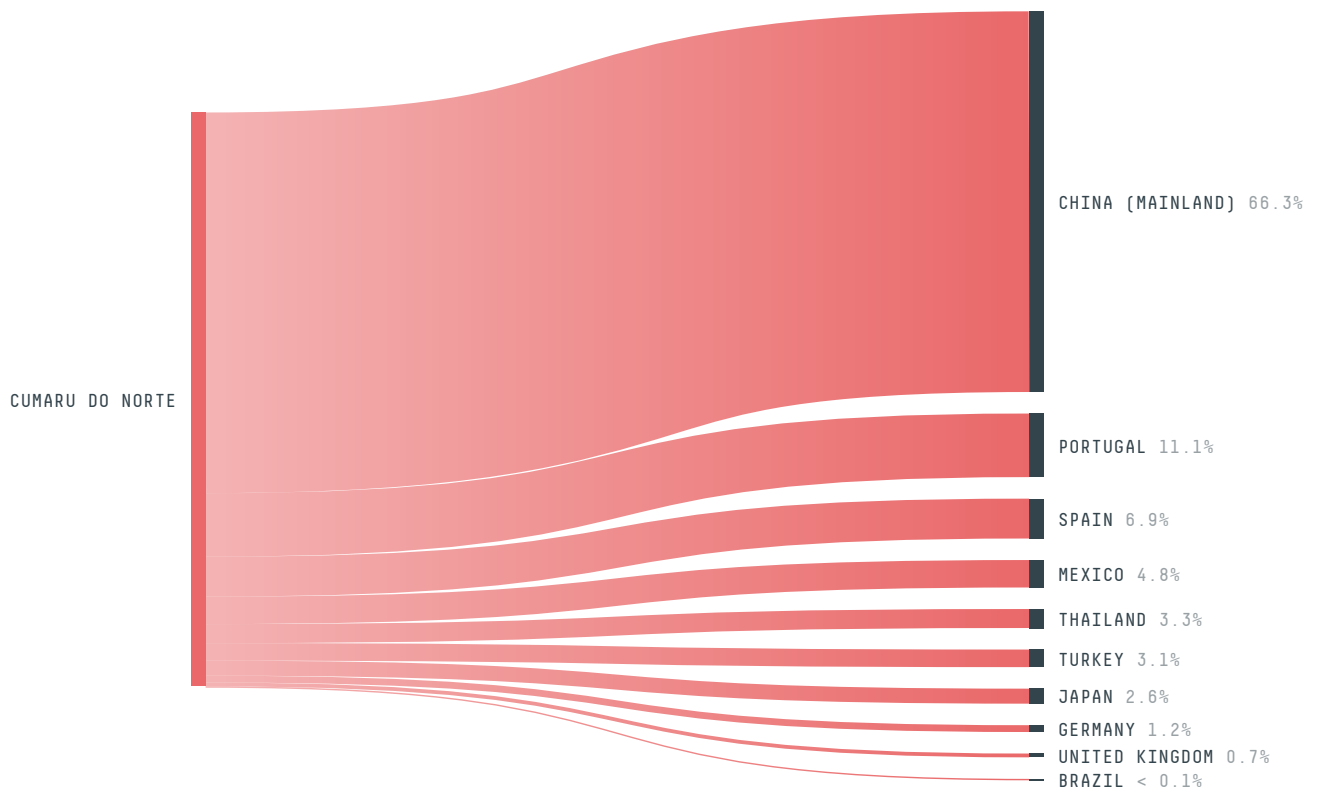
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CUMARU DO NORTE
