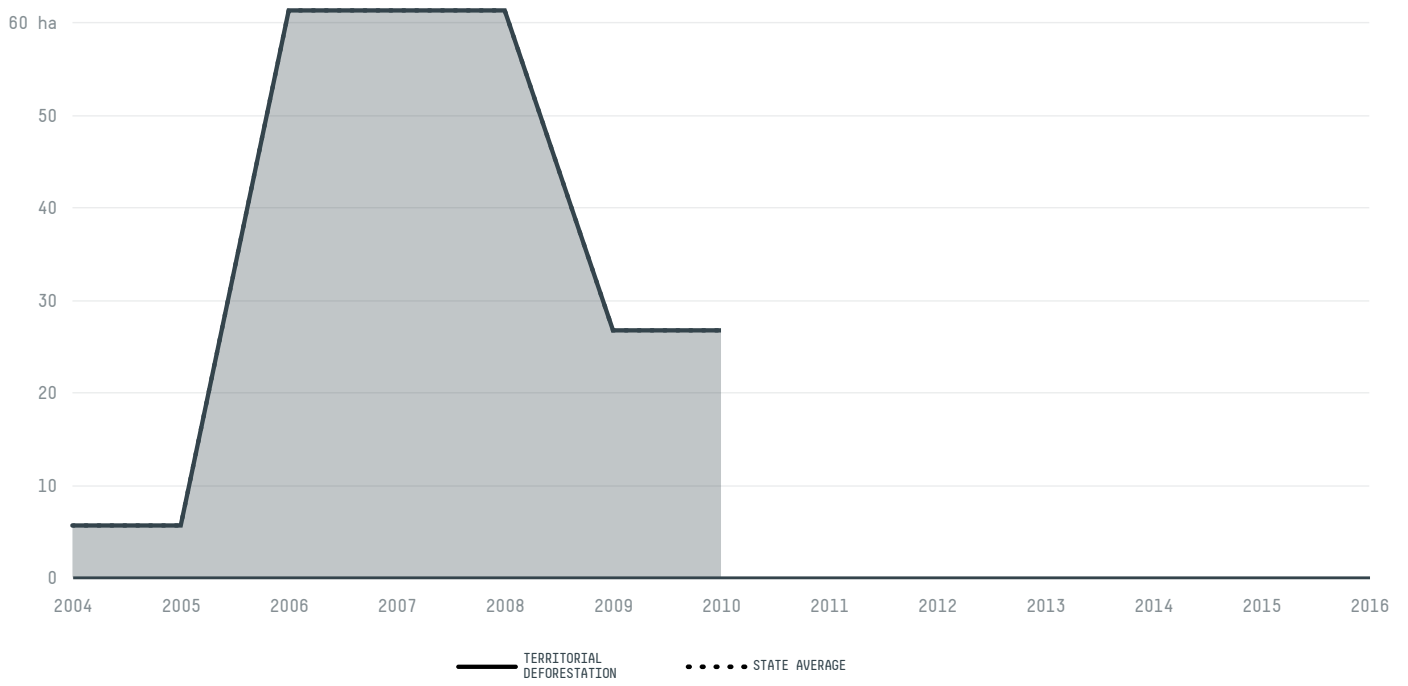

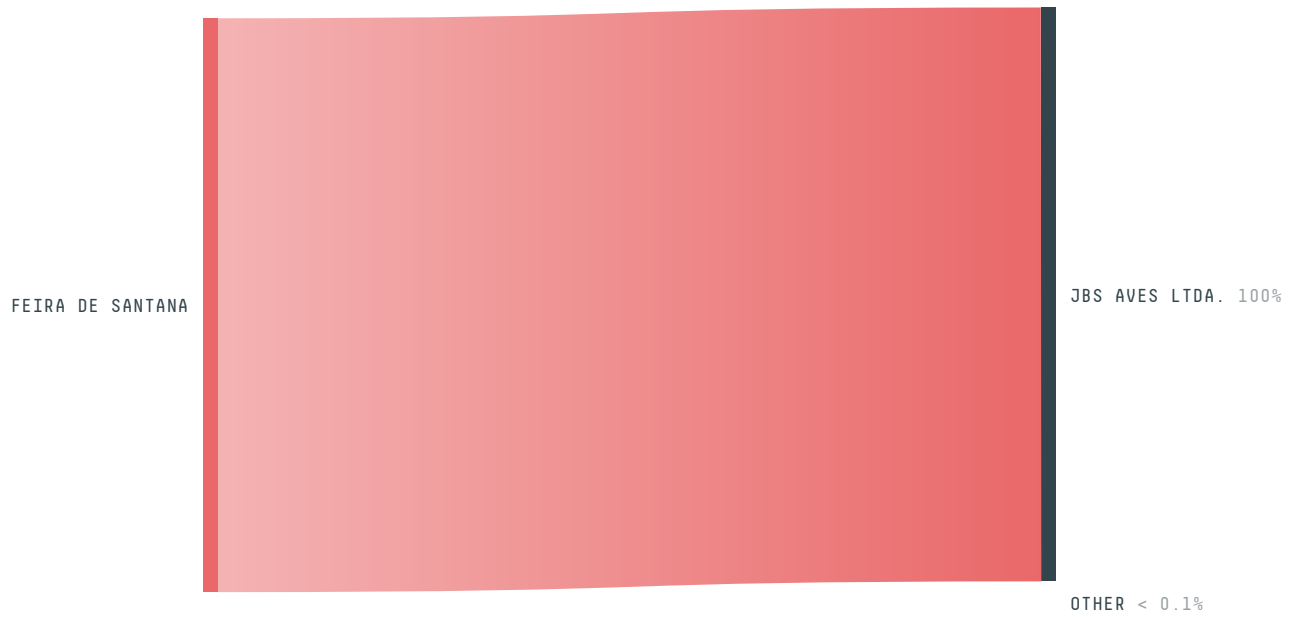

TOP TRADERS OF CHICKEN IN FEIRA DE SANTANA IN 2017

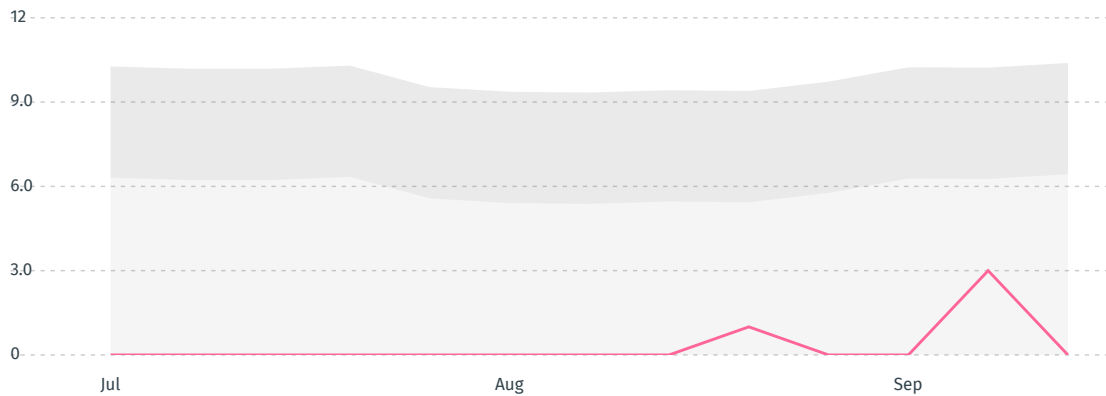


TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF CHICKEN FROM FEIRA DE SANTANA IN 2017
