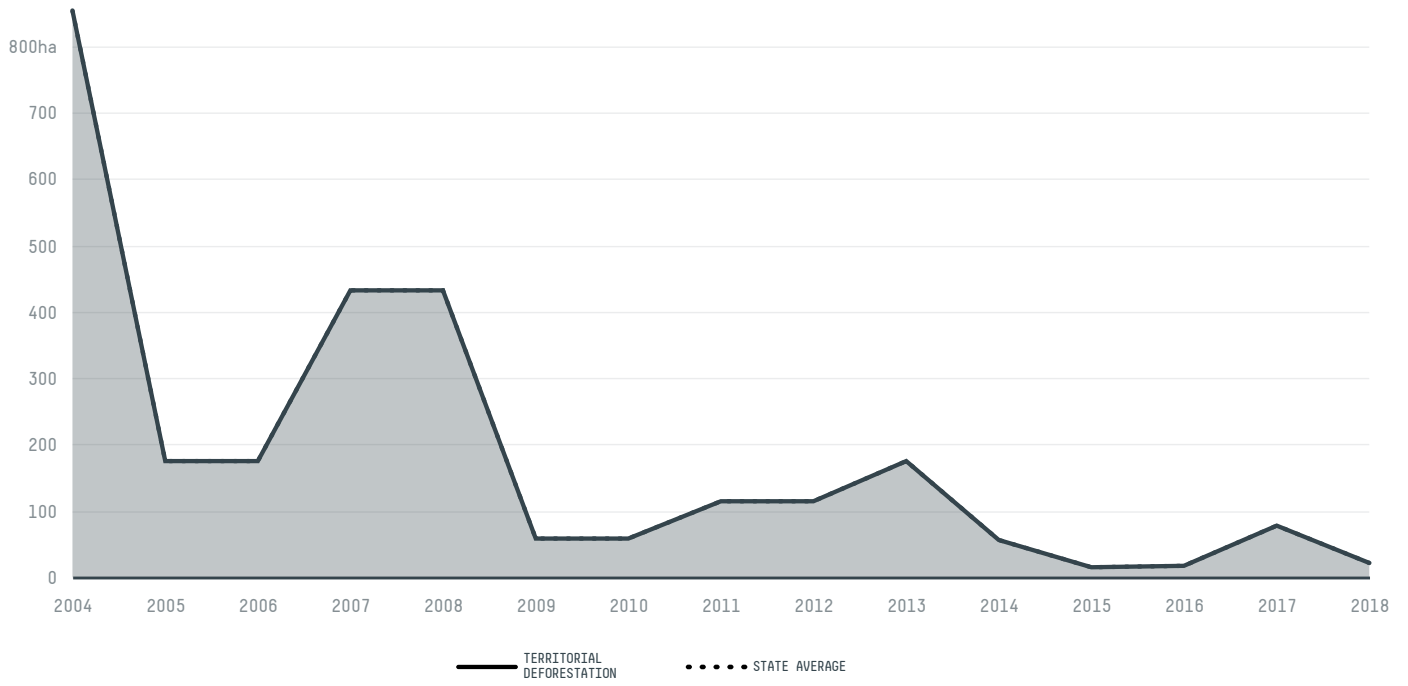

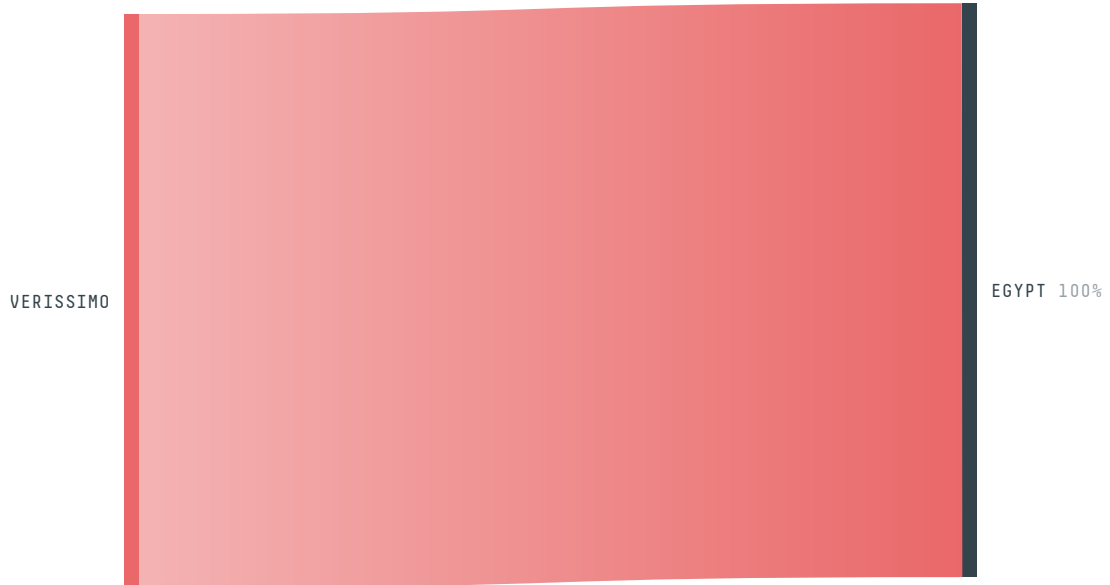
## DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF VERISSIMO
