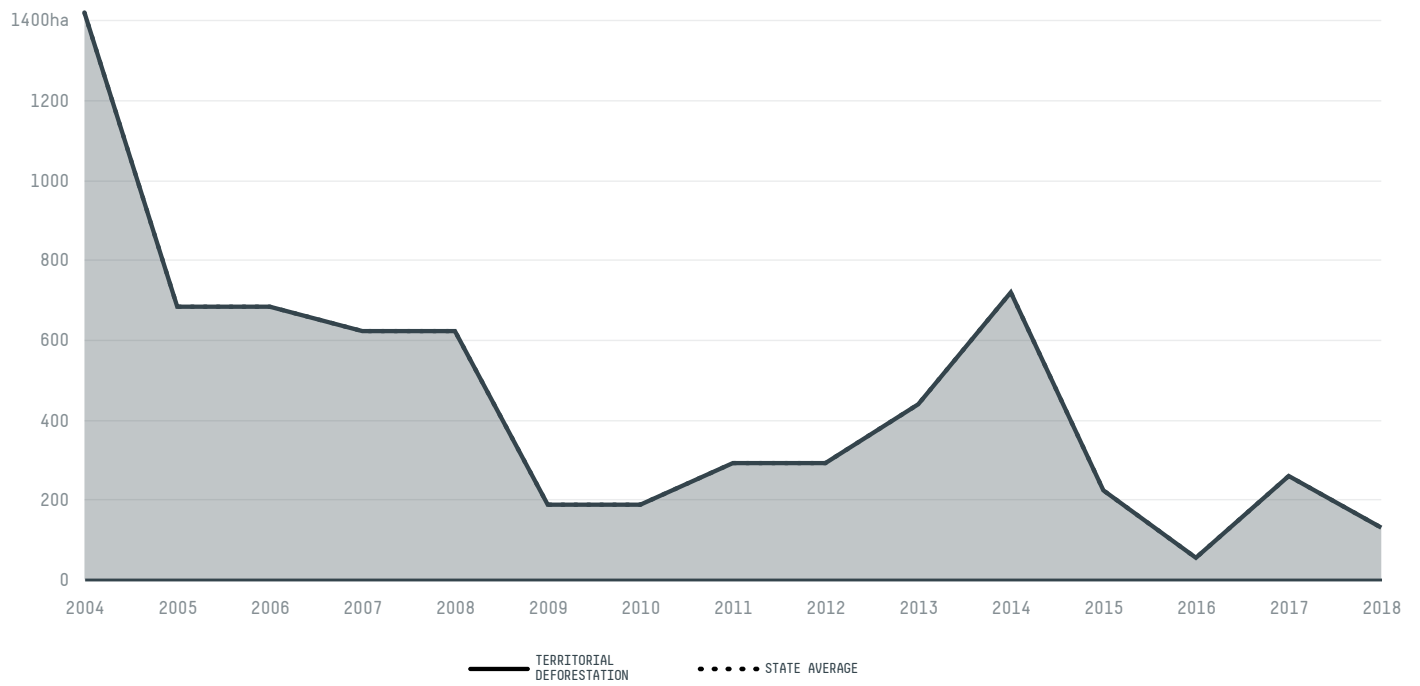

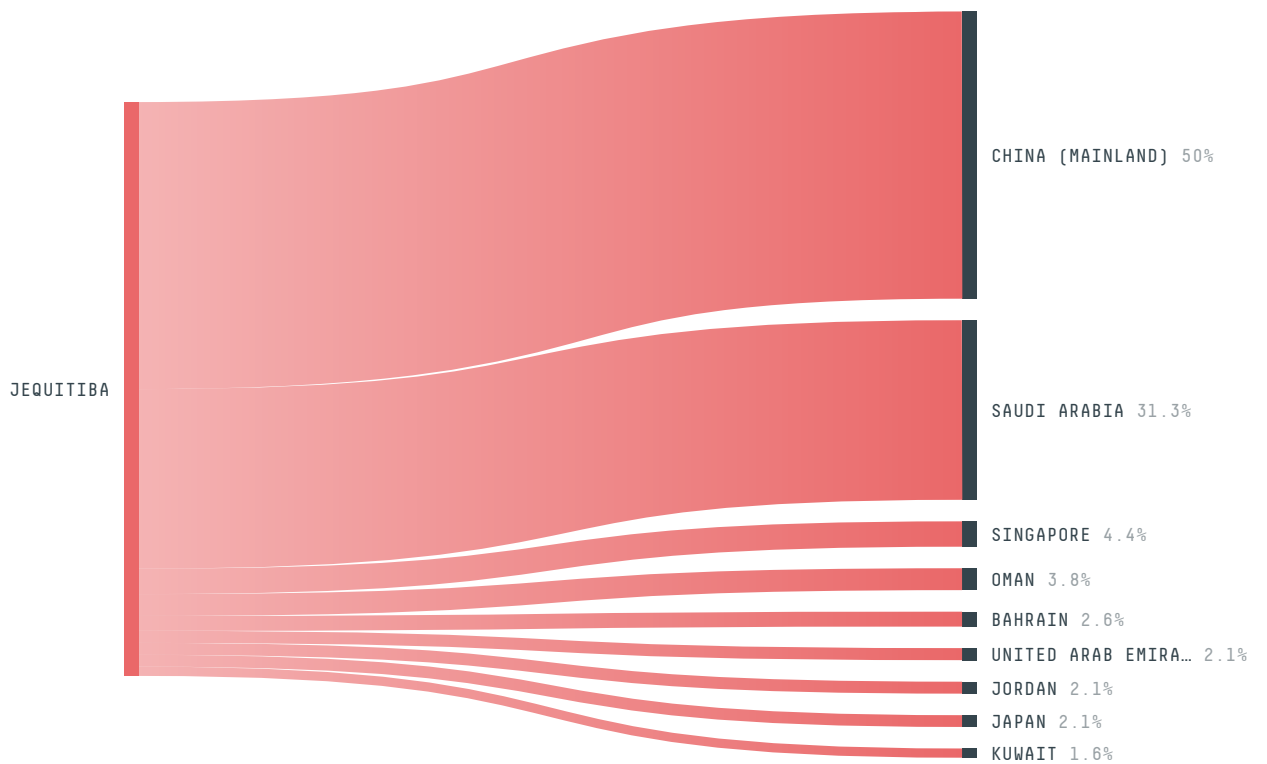

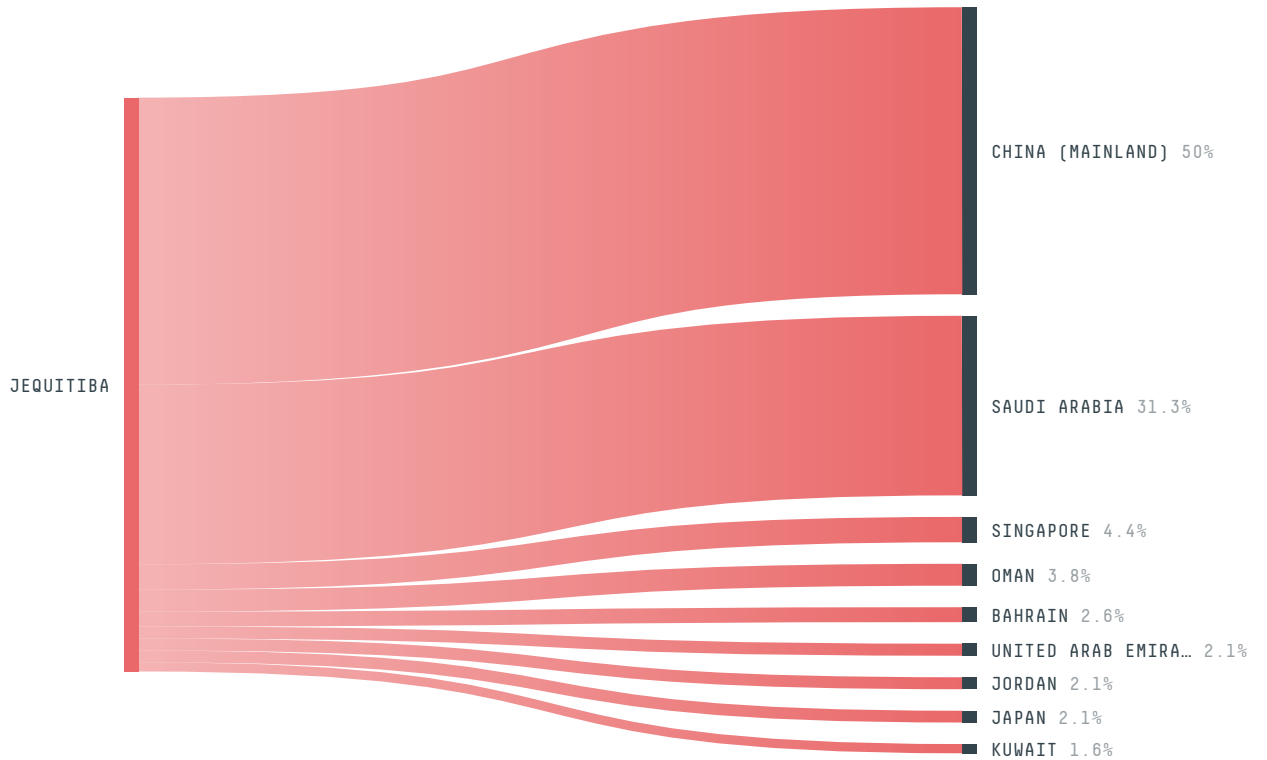
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF JEQUITIBA
