In 2017, Bom Conselho produced 10 t of coffee occupying a total of 20 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 528th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Bom Conselho was Industrias Alimenticias Marata Ltda., which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.

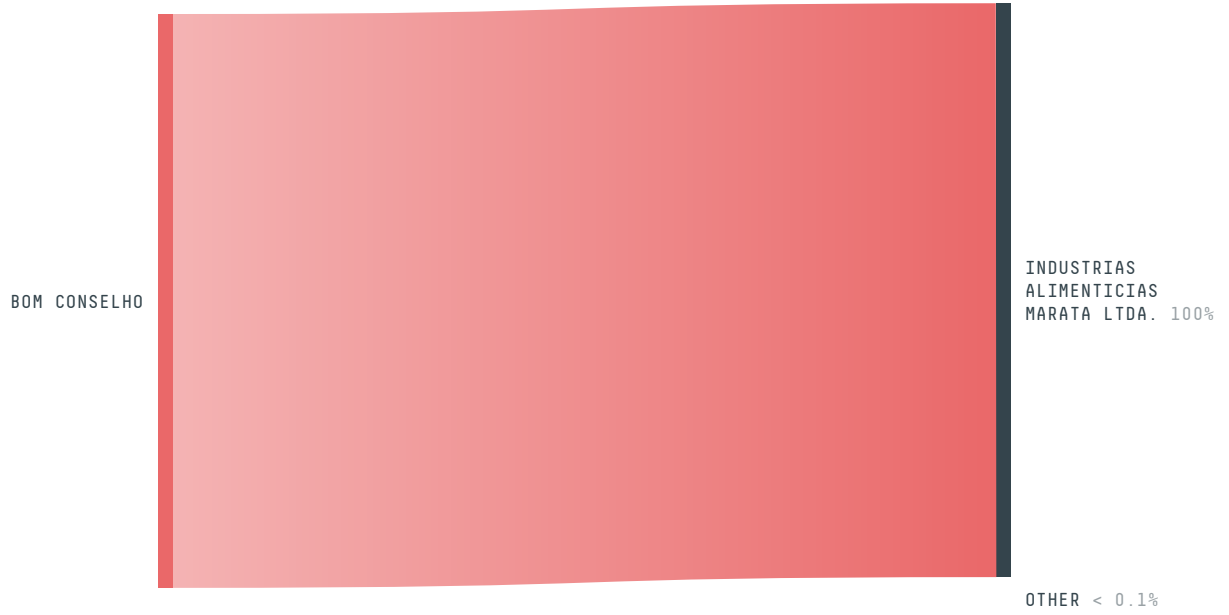
