In 2017, Bonito produced 4,200 t of coffee occupying a total of 7,000 ha of land. With 0.13% of the total production, it ranks 159th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Bonito was Sarpa Plantacoes E Comercio De Cafe Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was United States.
