In 2017, Contendas Do Sincora produced 129 t of coffee occupying a total of 258 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 440th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Contendas Do Sincora was J. R. Comercio E Exportacao De Cafe Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Portugal.
