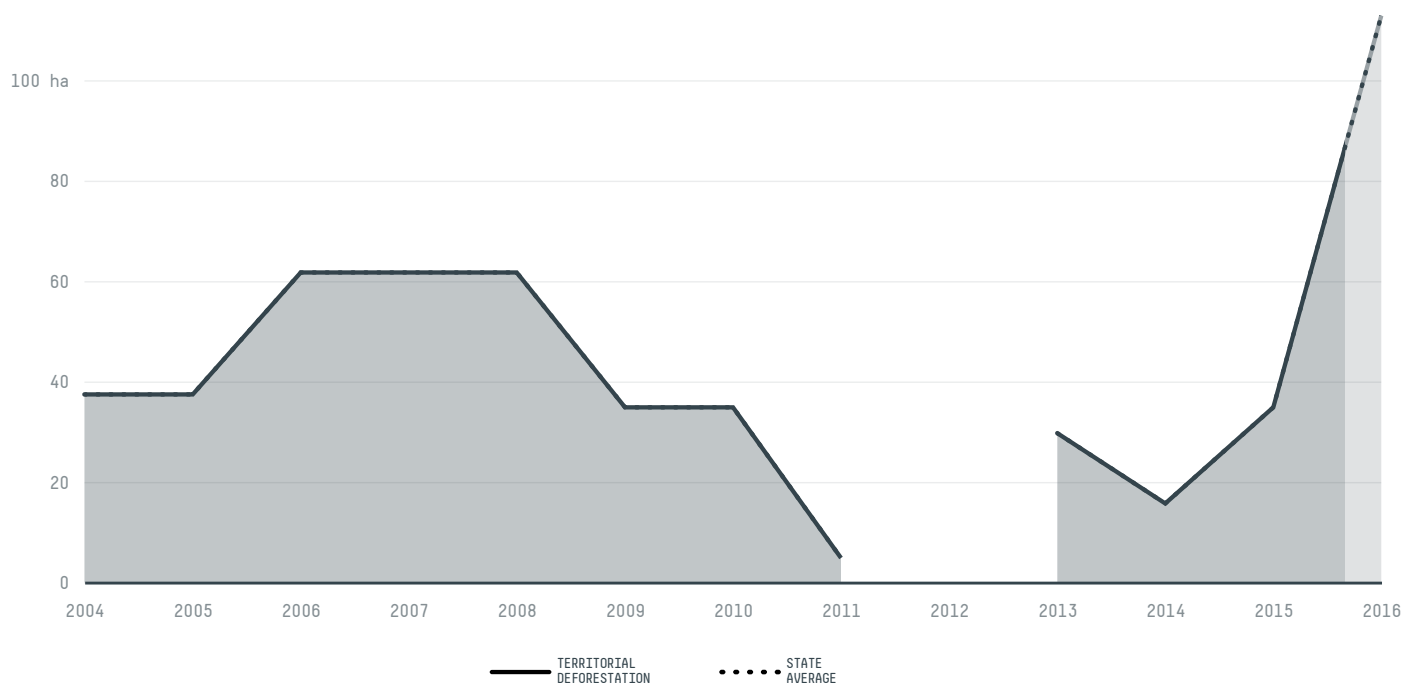
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND

In 2016, Itabela produced 3,609 t of coffee occupying a total of 3,807 ha of land. With 0.09% of the total production, it ranks 187th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Itabela was Aroma Coffee Com. Imp. E Exp. De Cafe Eireli, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Syria.
