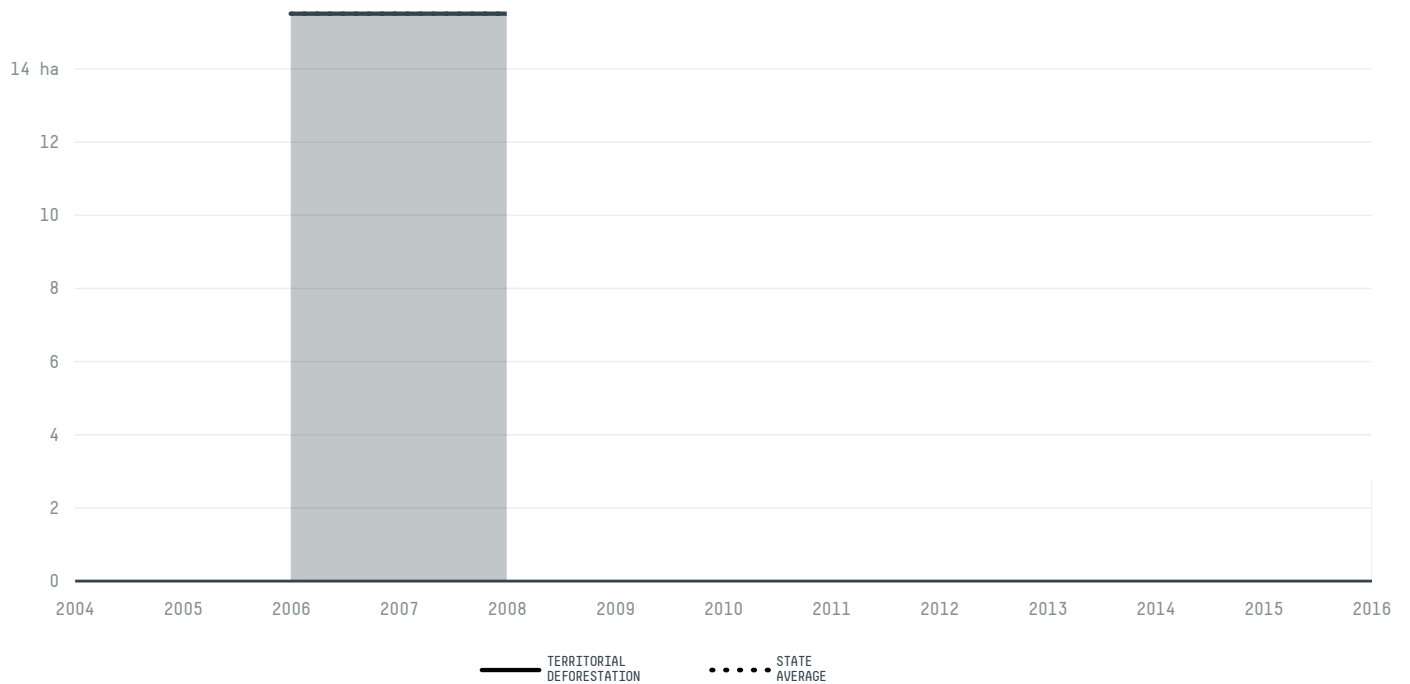
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND

In 2017, Camacan produced 1,100 t of coffee occupying a total of 1,030 ha of land. With 0.03% of the total production, it ranks 290th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Camacan was Eisa Empresa Interagropecuária, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was United States.
