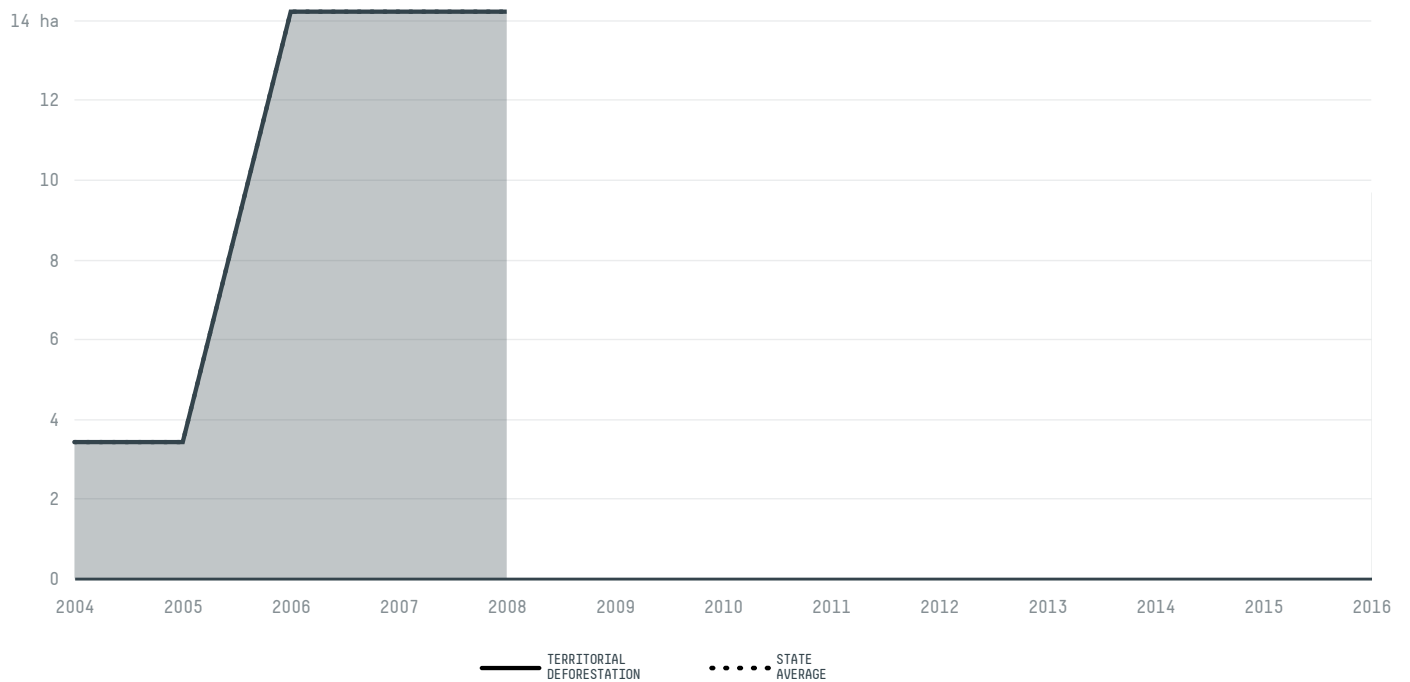
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
321 km² 29 t 30 ha

In 2017, Floresta Azul produced 29 t of coffee occupying a total of 30 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 509th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Floresta Azul was Eisa Empresa Interagrica, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Japan.

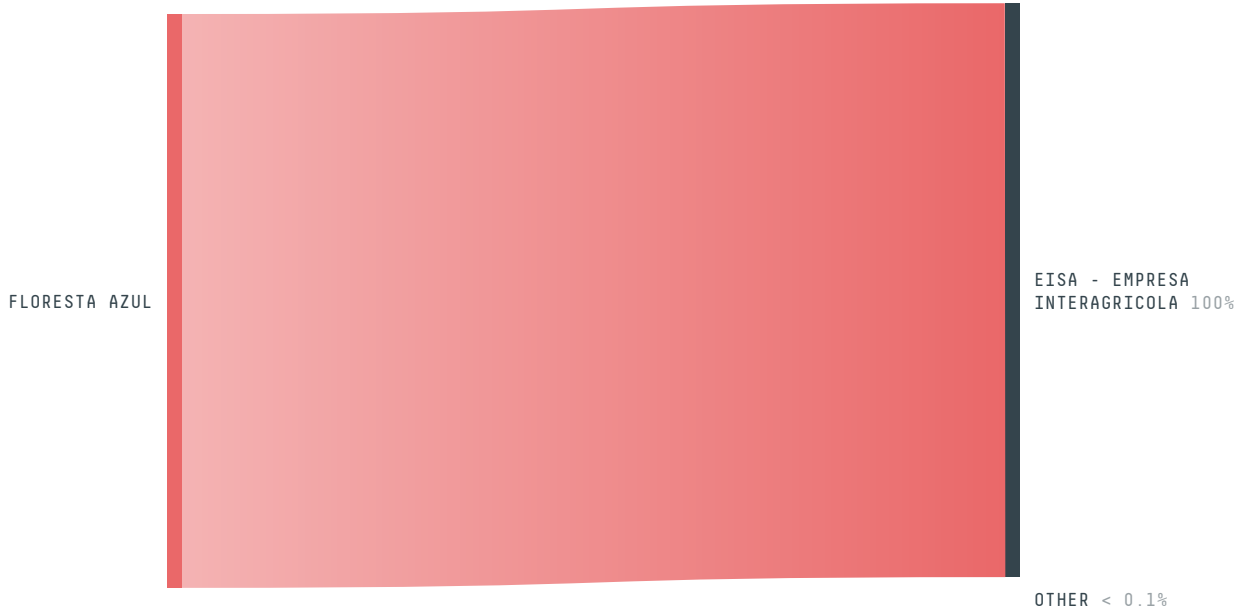
