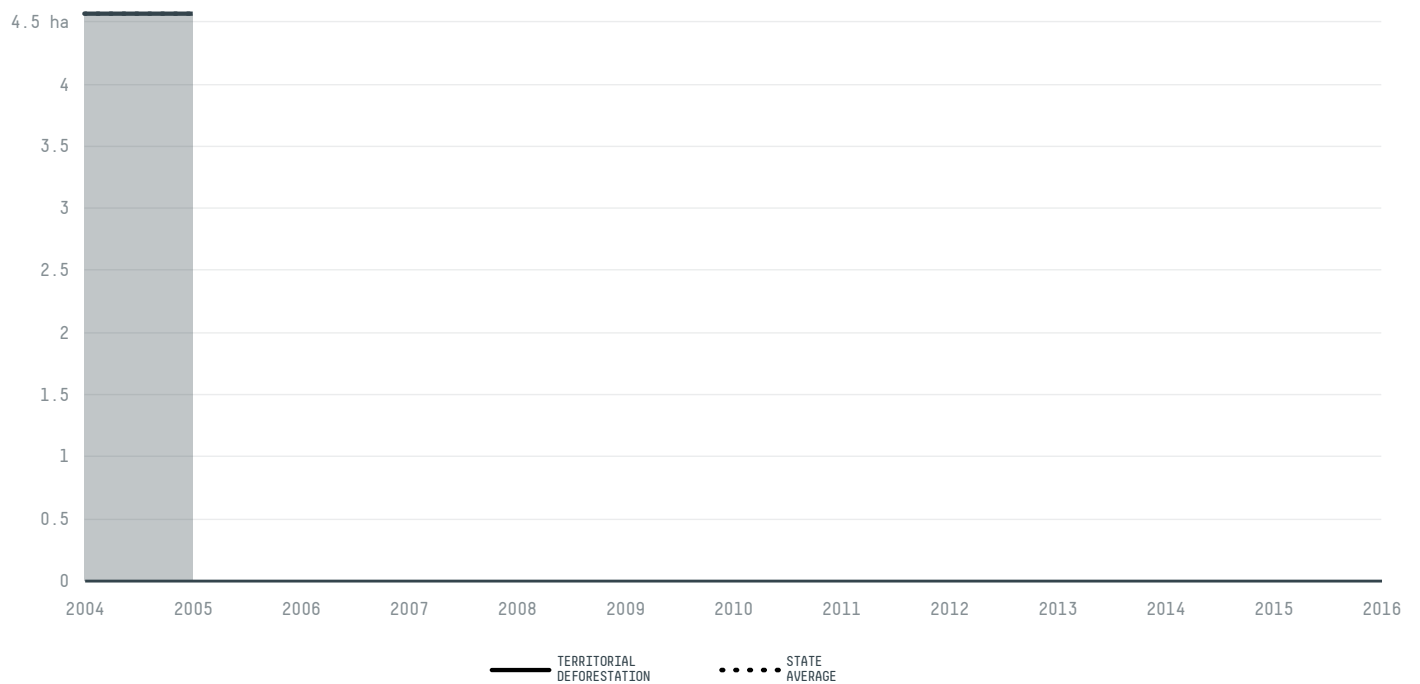
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
318 km² 27 t 40 ha

In 2015, Ibirataia produced 27 t of coffee occupying a total of 40 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 507th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Ibirataia was Brandao Filhos S A Comercio Industria E Lavoura, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.
