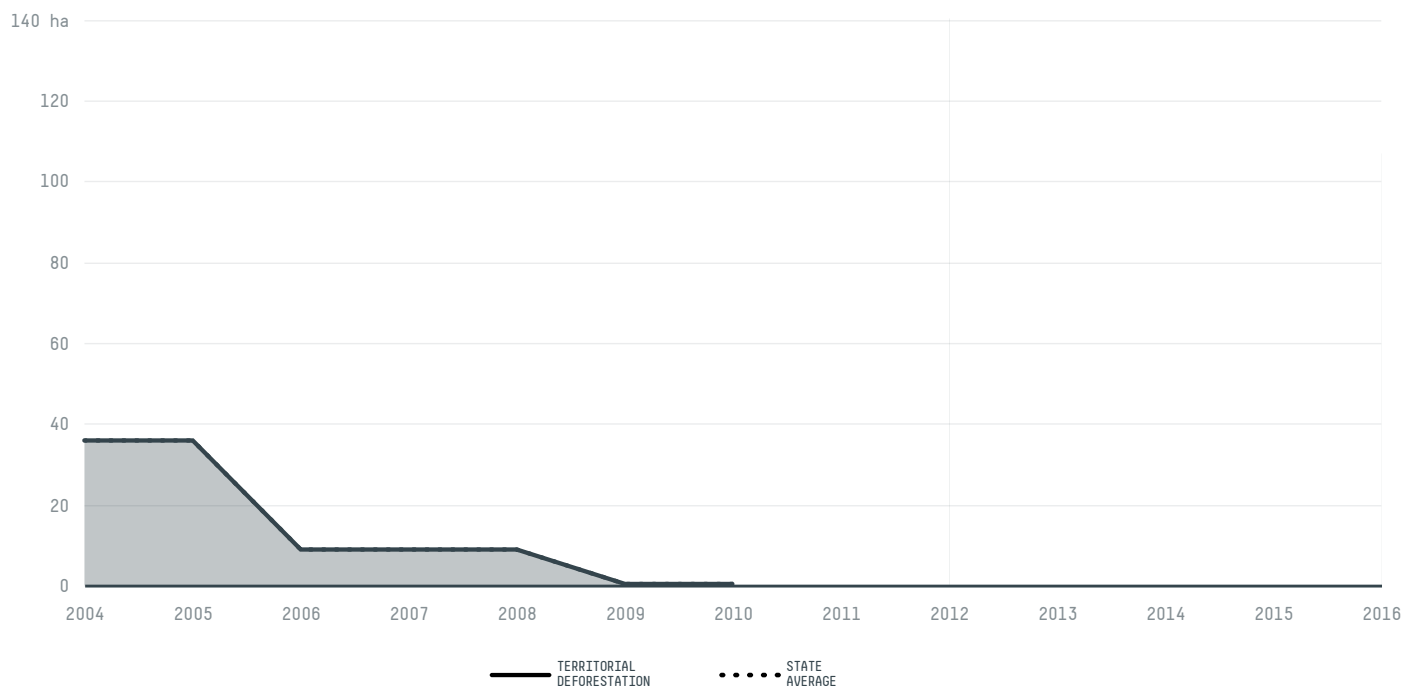
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
811 km² 6 t 8 ha

In 2016, Itagiba produced 6 t of coffee occupying a total of 8 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 521st in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Itagiba was Eisa Empresa Interagropecuária, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Jordan.

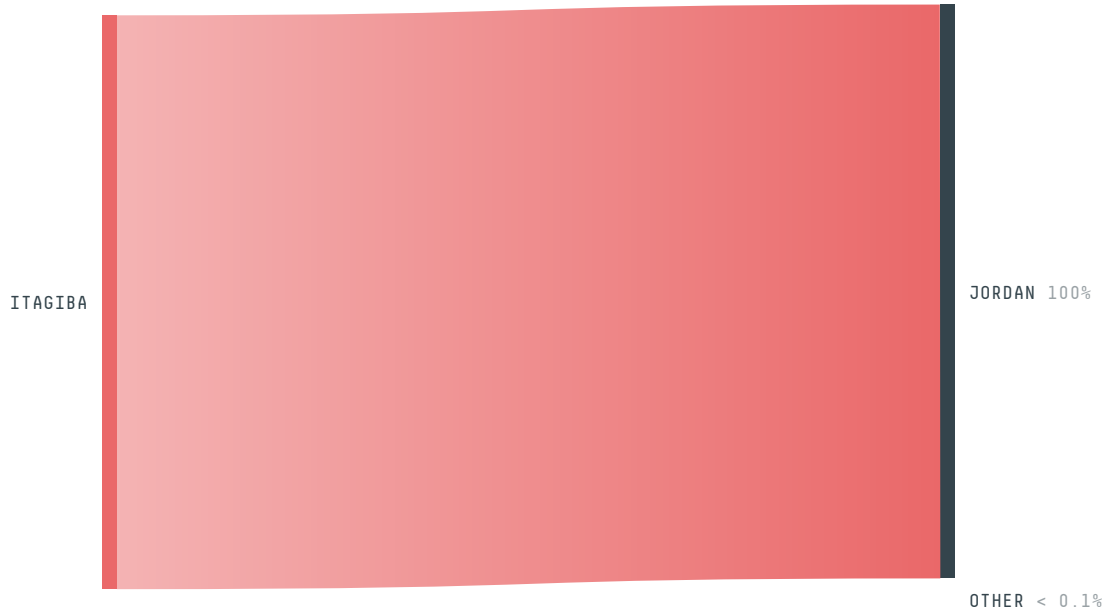
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ITAGIBA
