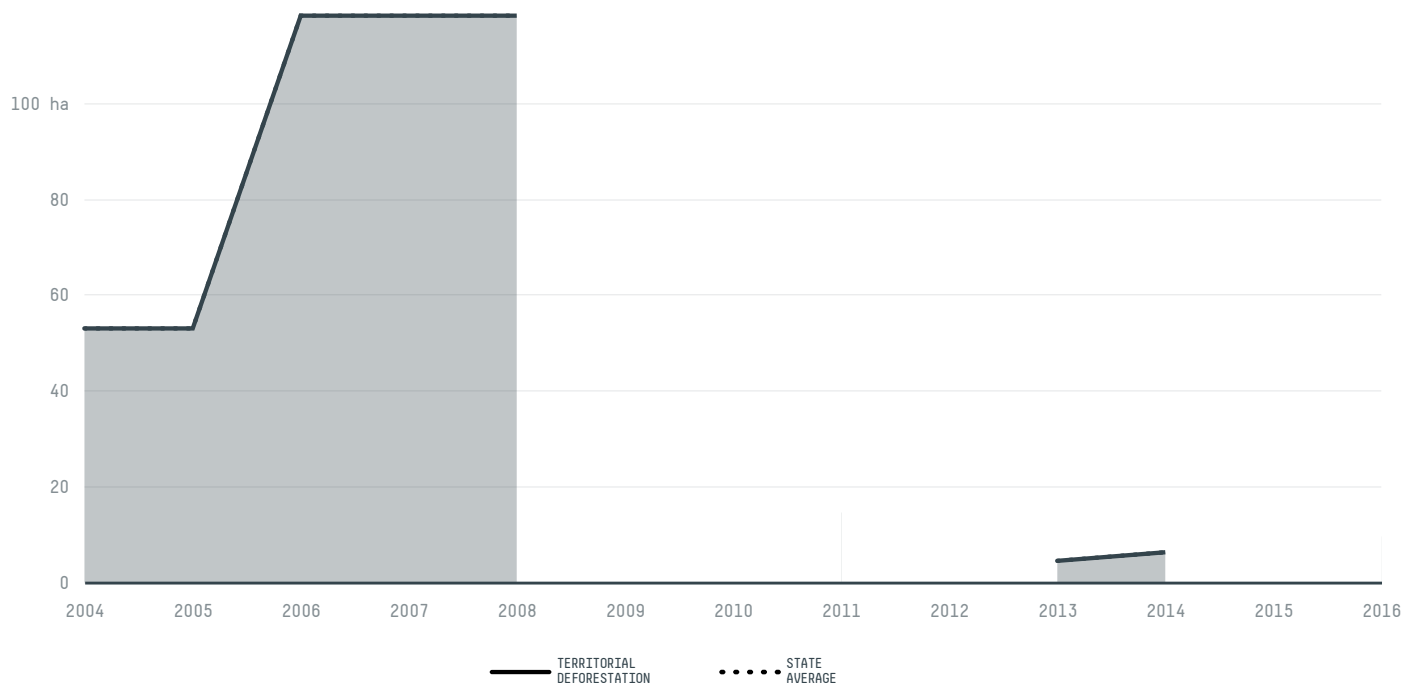
In 2016, Mascote produced 103 t of coffee occupying a total of 194 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 448th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Mascote was Eisa Empresa Interagropecuária, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Japan.

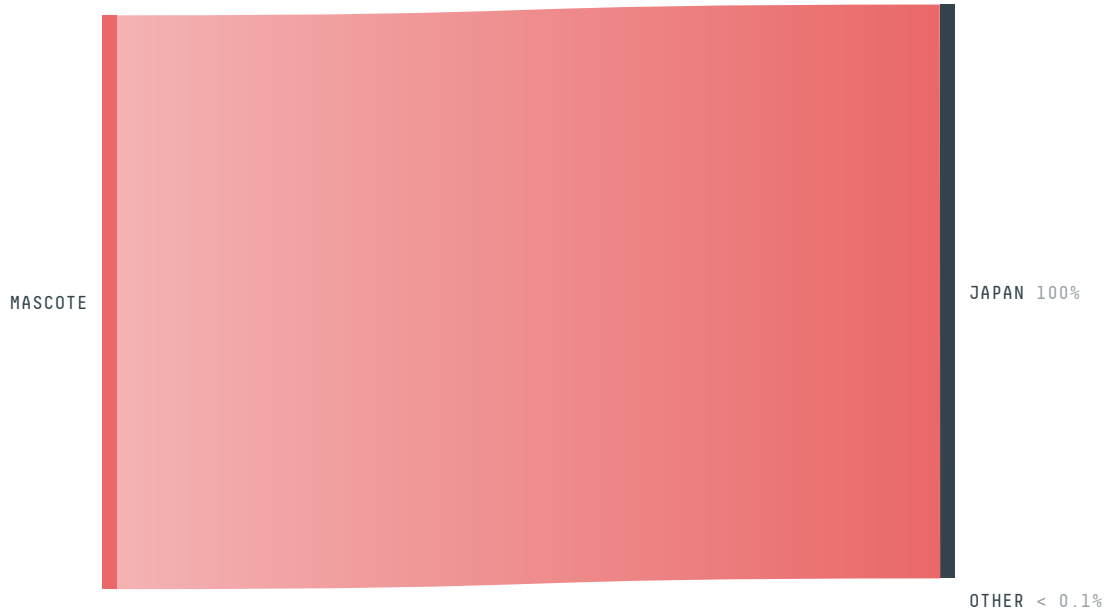
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF MASCOTE
