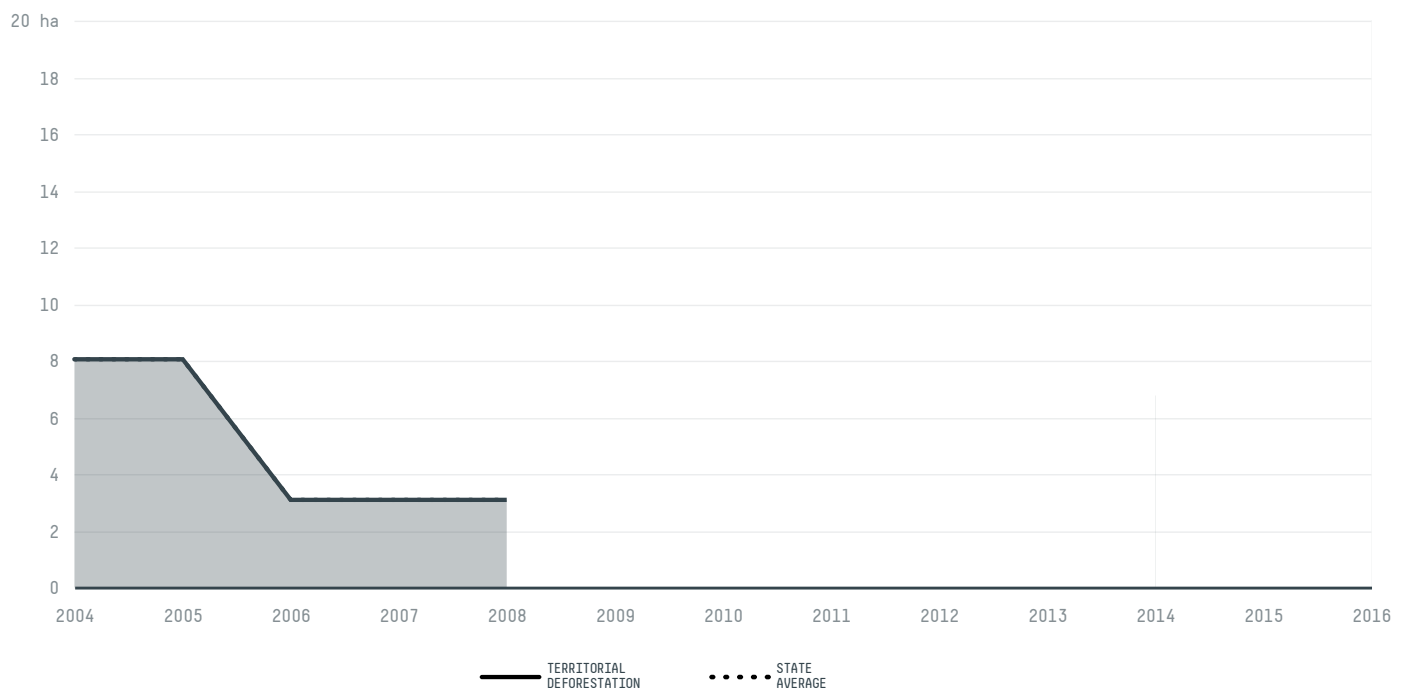
In 2016, Pau Brasil produced 36 t of coffee occupying a total of 51 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 492nd in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Pau Brasil was Eisa Empresa Interagricola, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.
