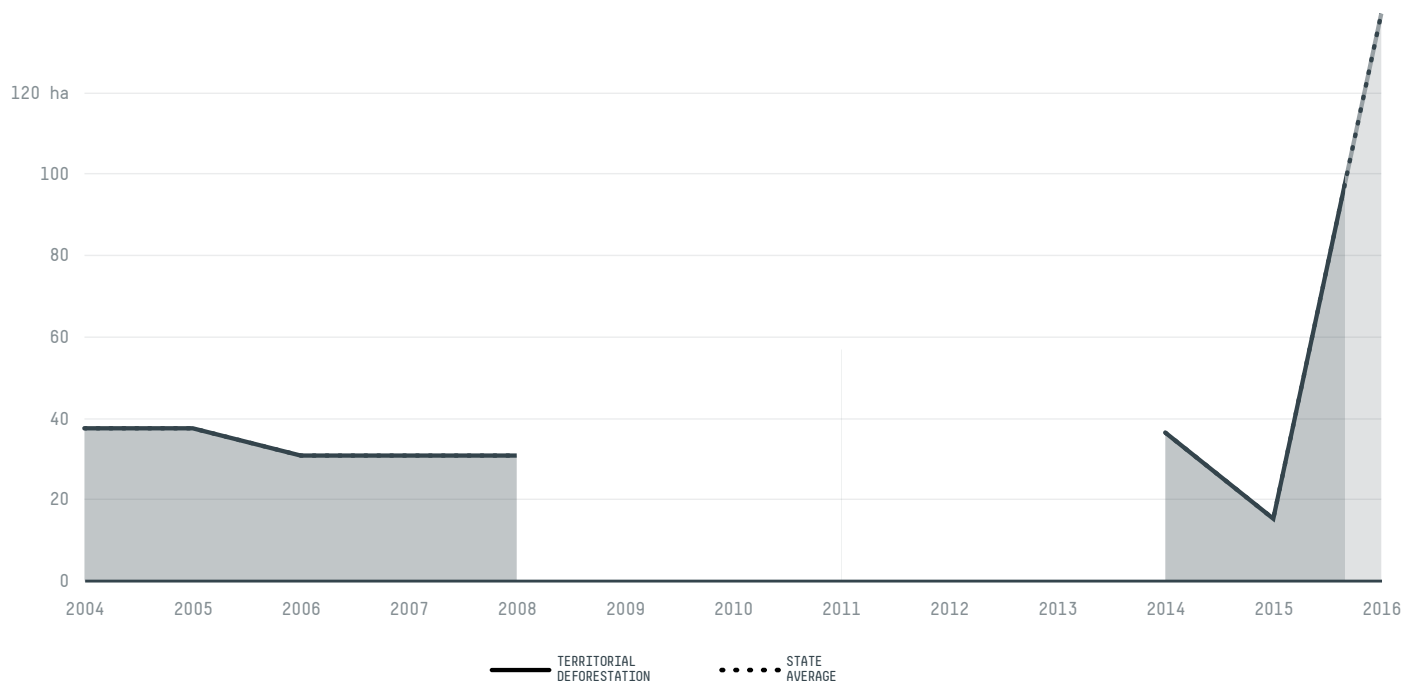
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
681 km² 351 t 650 ha

In 2016, Santa Luzia produced 351 t of coffee occupying a total of 650 ha of land. With 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 379th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Santa Luzia was Eisa Empresa Interagropecuária, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Belgium.

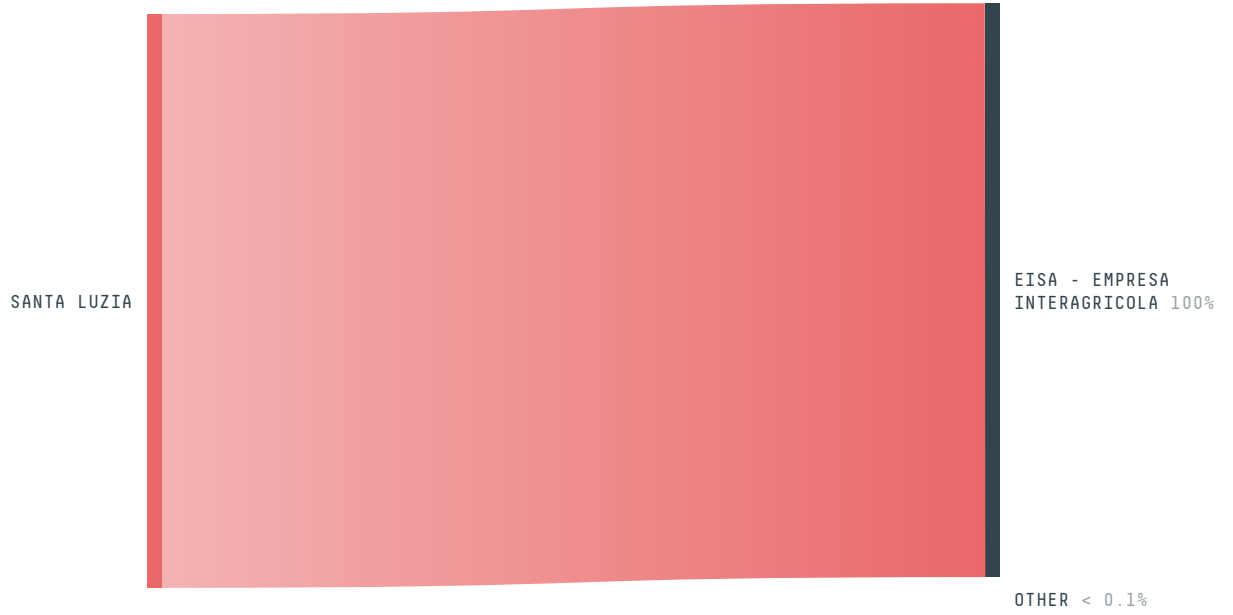
