In 2015, Wenceslau Guimaraes produced 89 t of coffee occupying a total of 85 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 453rd in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Wenceslau Guimaraes was Brandao Filhos S A Comercio Industria E Lavoura, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Germany.

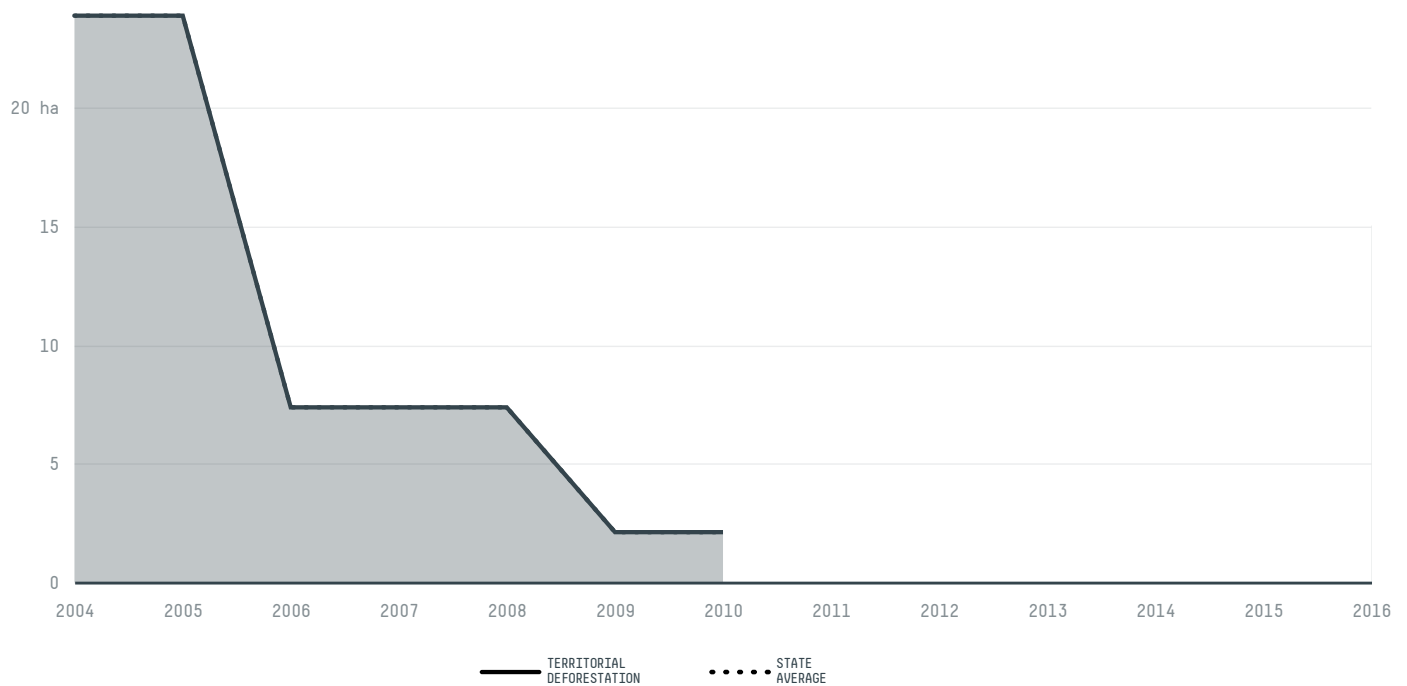

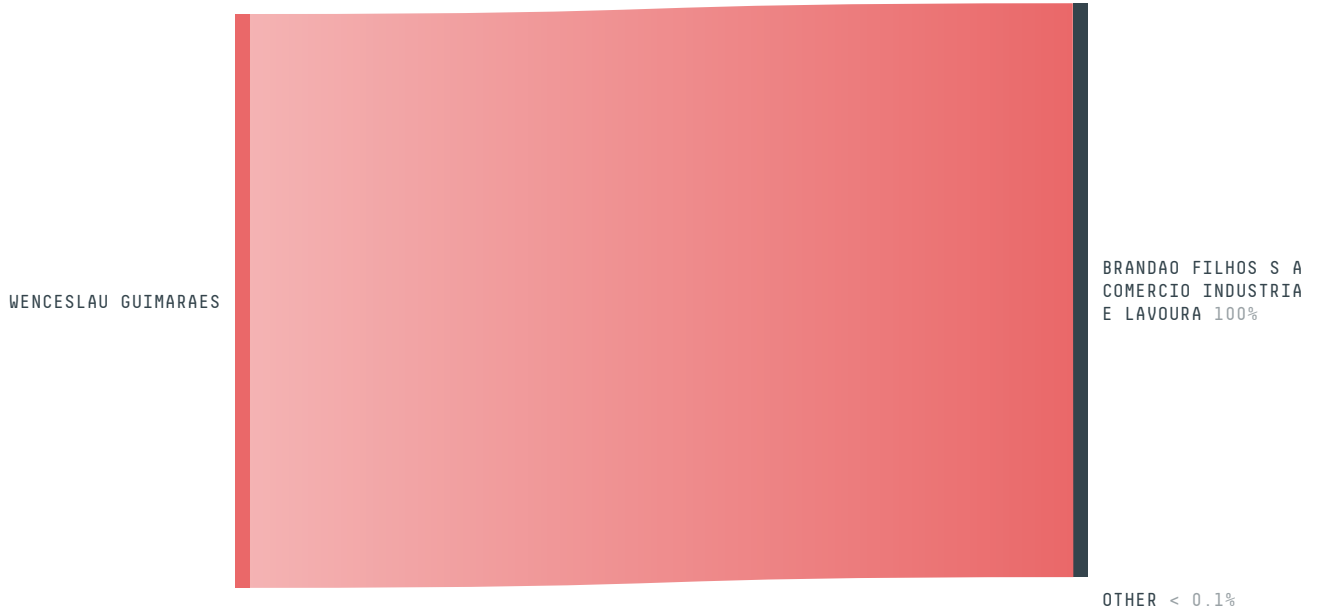
