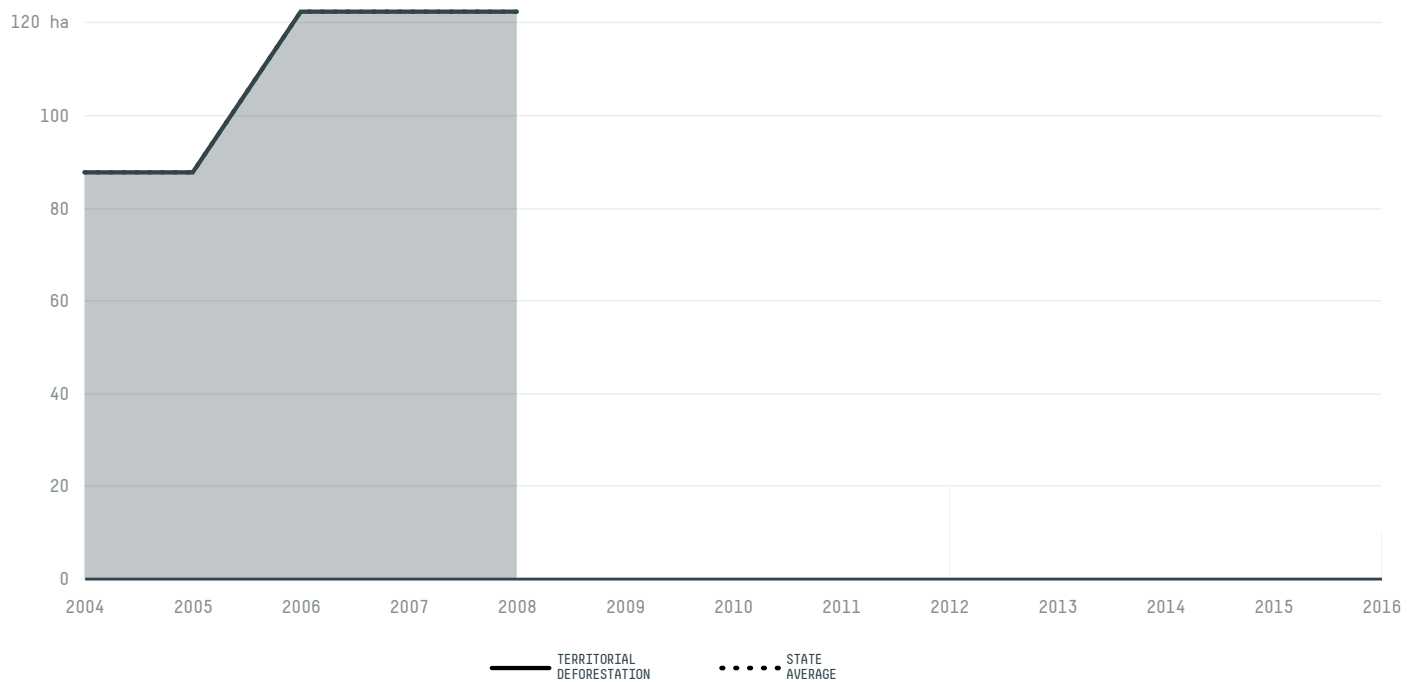
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
805 km² 440 t 600 ha

In 2017, Nova Canaa produced 440 t of coffee occupying a total of 600 ha of land. With 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 367th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Nova Canaa was Eisa Empresa Interagricola, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Turkey.
