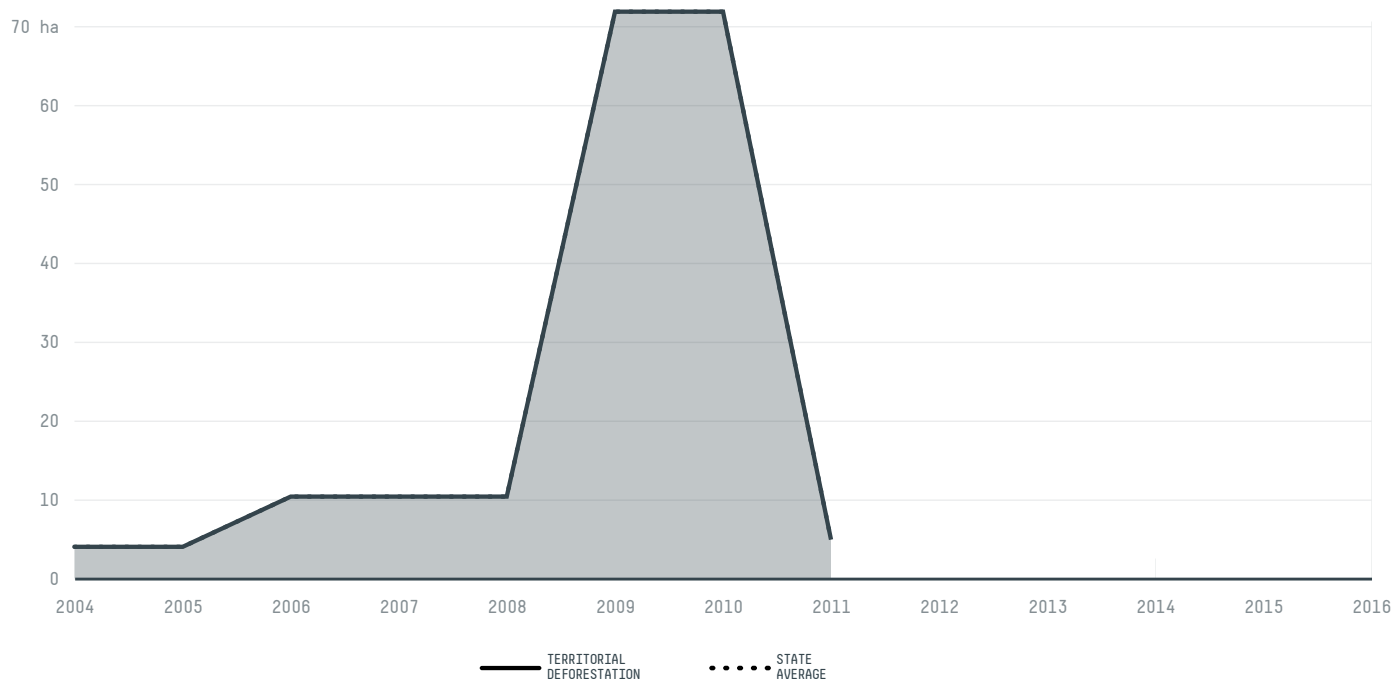
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND

In 2017, Jaguaripe produced 2 t of coffee occupying a total of 10 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 536th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Jaguaripe was Latitude 13 Trade Comercial Exportadora Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was United States.
