The largest exporter of coffee in Santo Antonio De Jesus was Latitude 13 Trade Comercial Exportadora Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was United States.

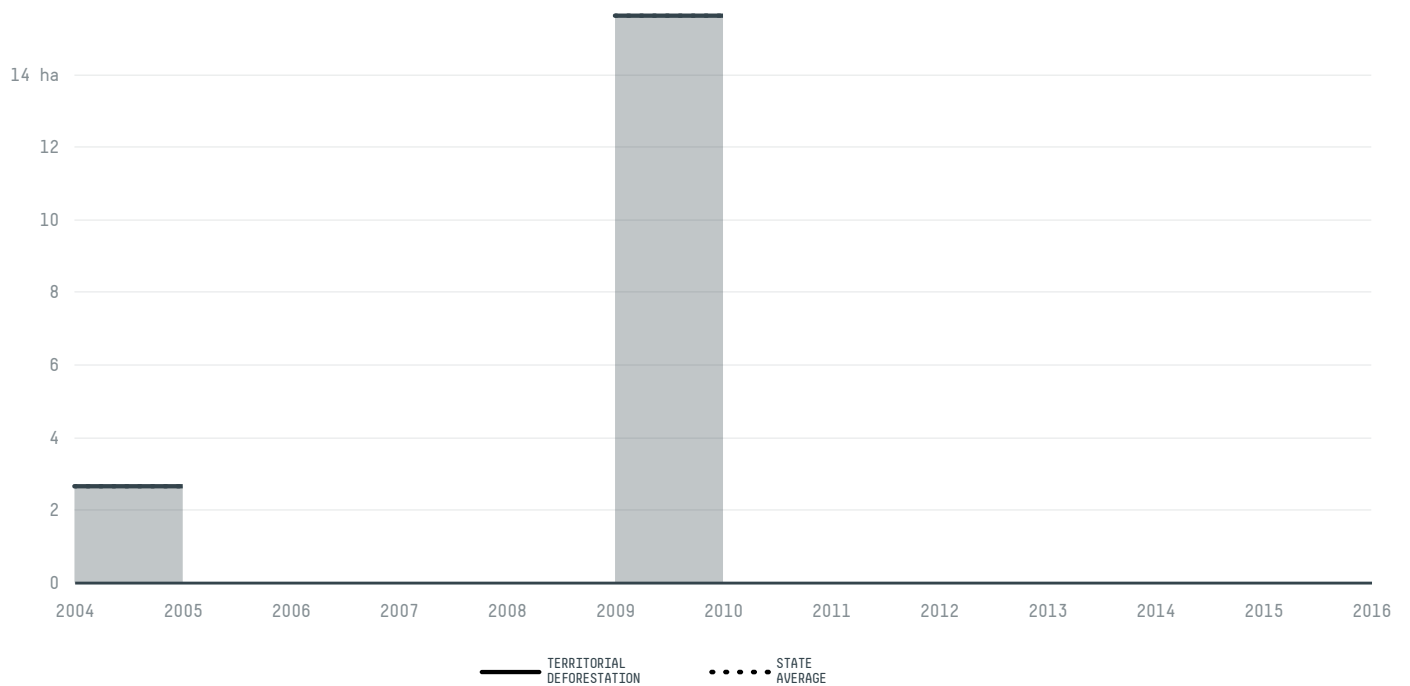
