In 2017, Luis Eduardo Magalhaes produced 2,806 t of coffee occupying a total of 1,700 ha of land. With 0.08% of the total production, it ranks 197th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Luis Eduardo Magalhaes was Farmers Elevator Do Brasil Agropecuaria Ltda, which accounted for 73.7% of the total exports, and the main destination was United States.

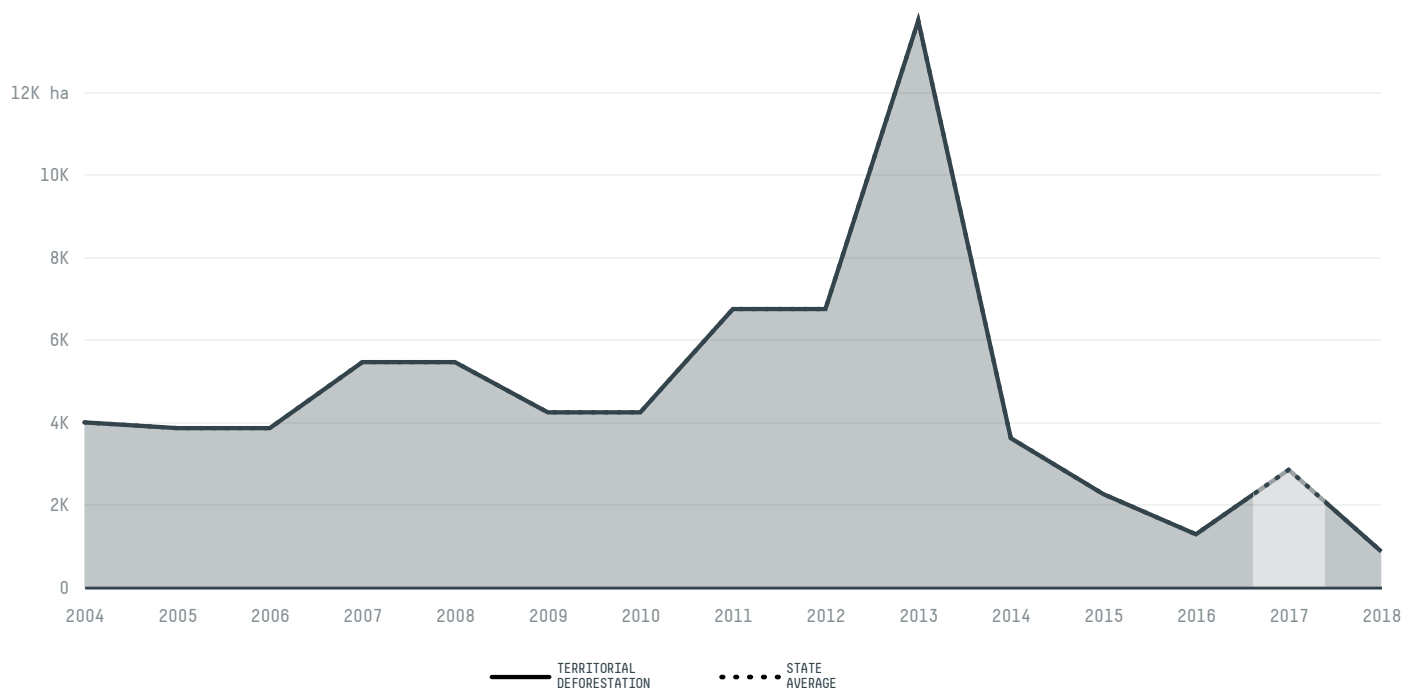
