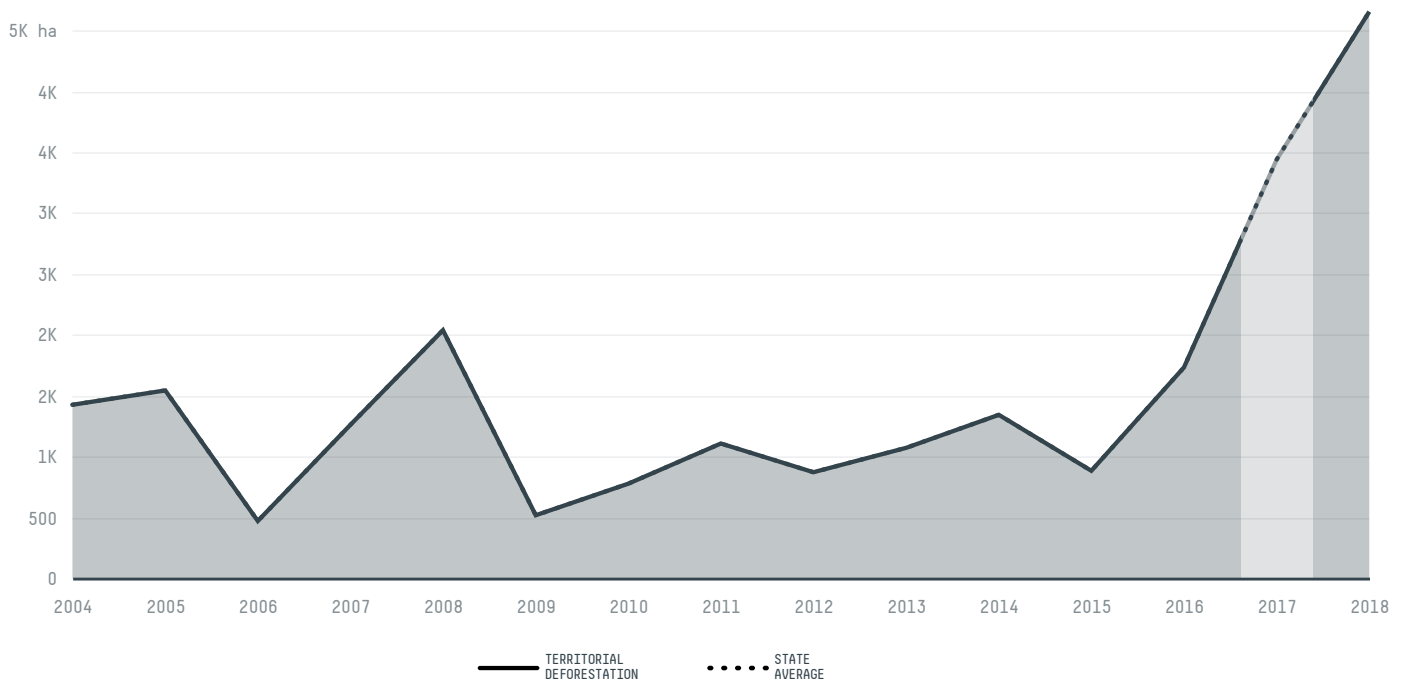
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND

In 2017, Humaita produced 18 t of coffee occupying a total of 17 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 520th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Humaita was Ricca Comercio Ltda Epp, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Venezuela.
