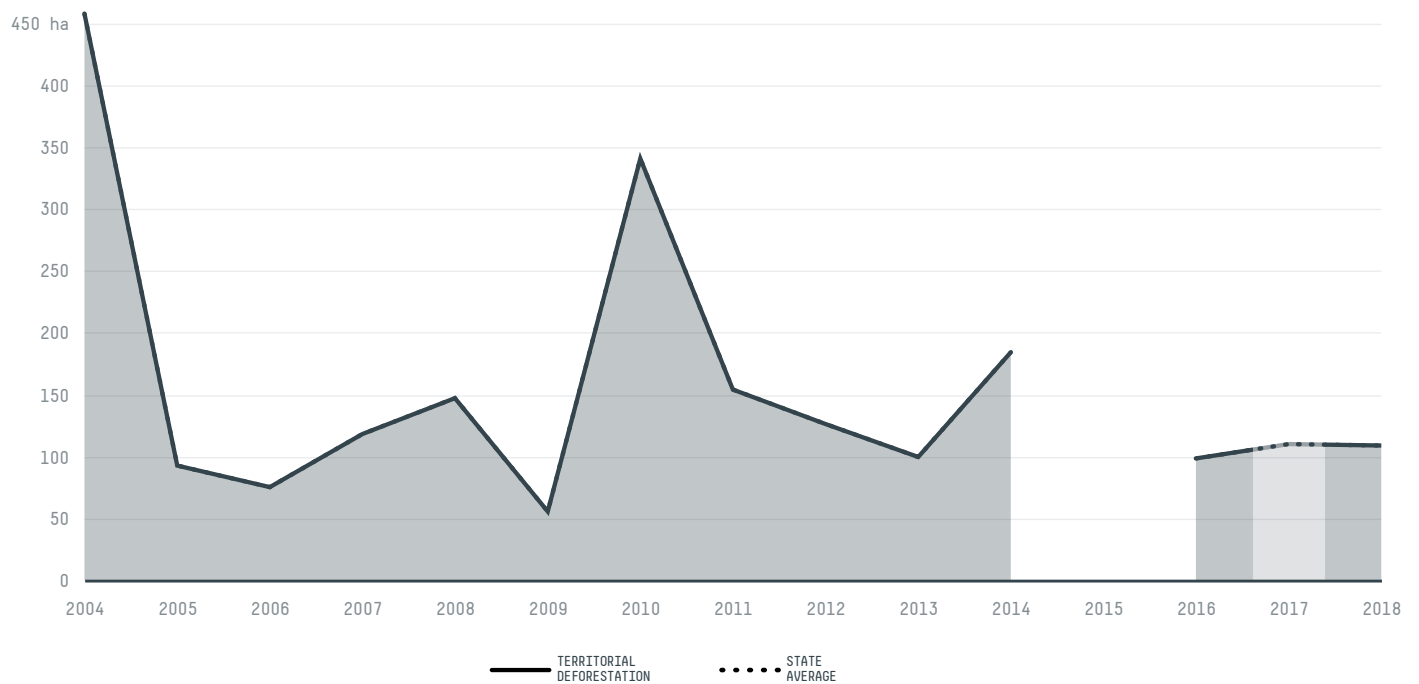
AREA PRODUCTION OF COFFEE COFFEE LAND
122,451 km² 4 t 4 ha

In 2017, Barcelos produced 4 t of coffee occupying a total of 4 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 534th in Brazil in coffee production. The largest exporter of coffee in Barcelos was Ricca Comercio Ltda Epp, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Venezuela.

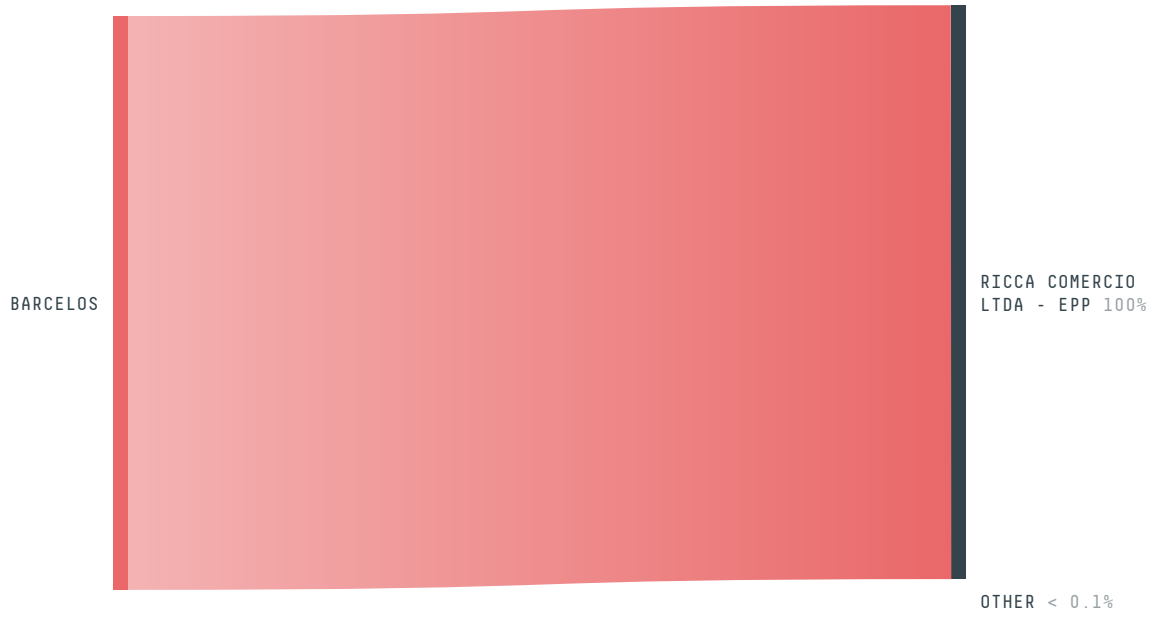
