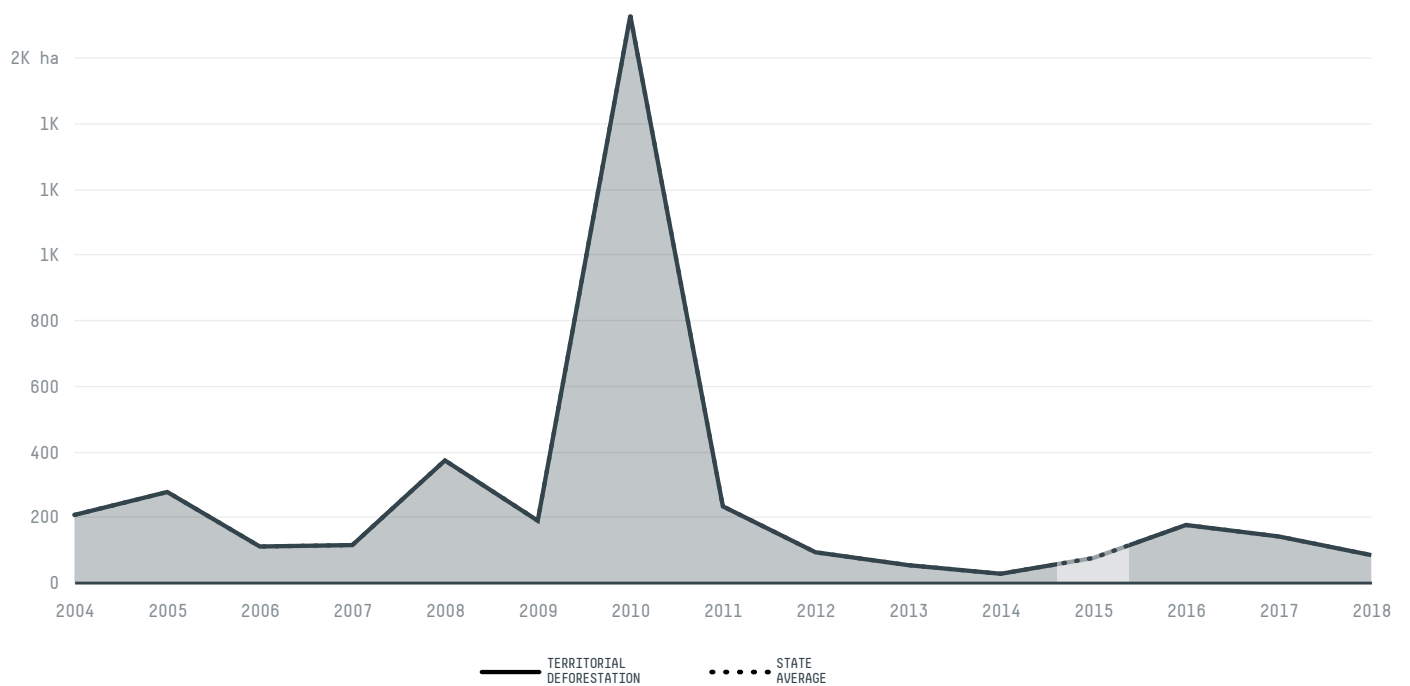

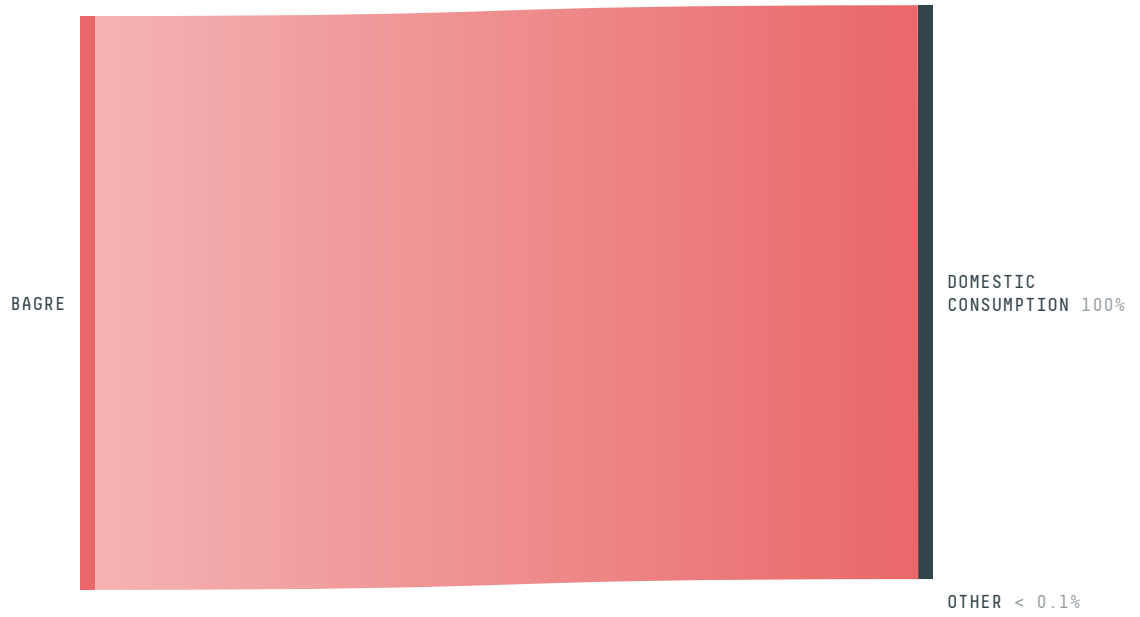

TOP TRADERS OF CORN IN BAGRE IN 2015

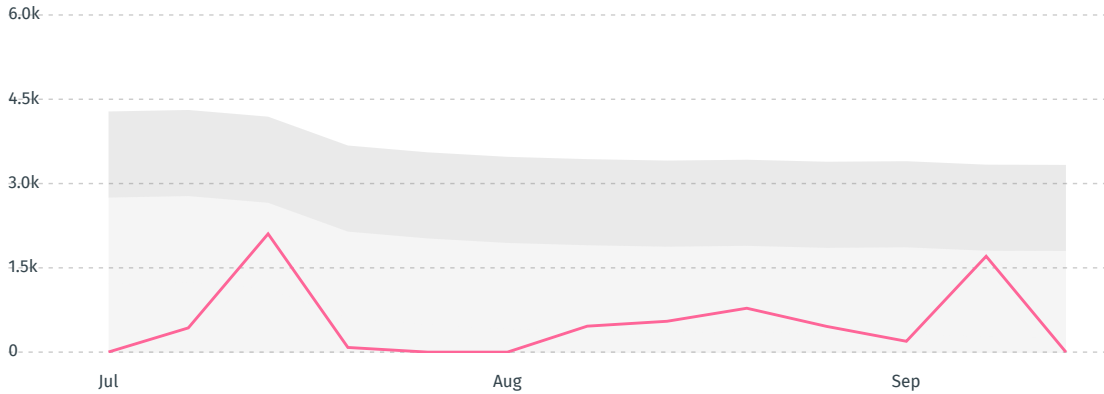


TOP IMPORTING COUNTRIES OF CORN FROM BAGRE IN 2015
