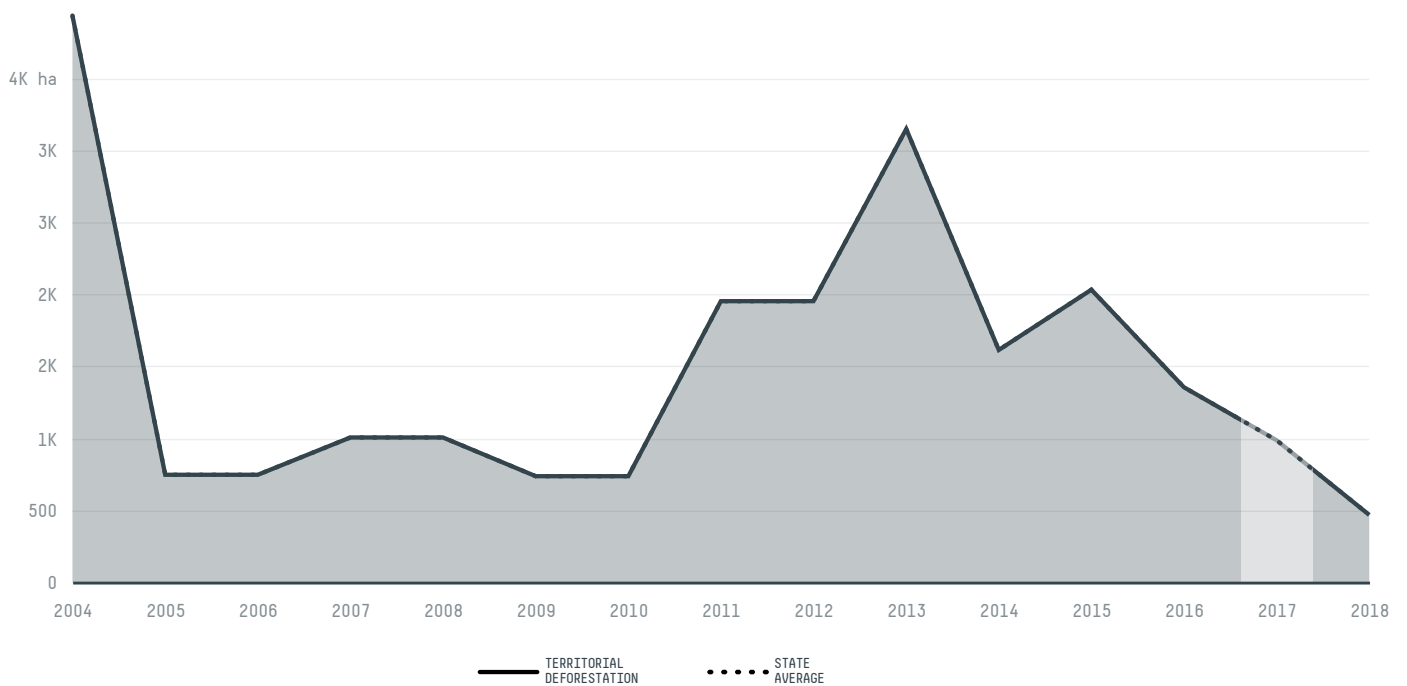

In 2017, Aparecida Do Rio Negro produced 2,400 t of corn occupying a total of 500 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 14,21st in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Aparecida Do Rio Negro was Gavilon, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Spain.

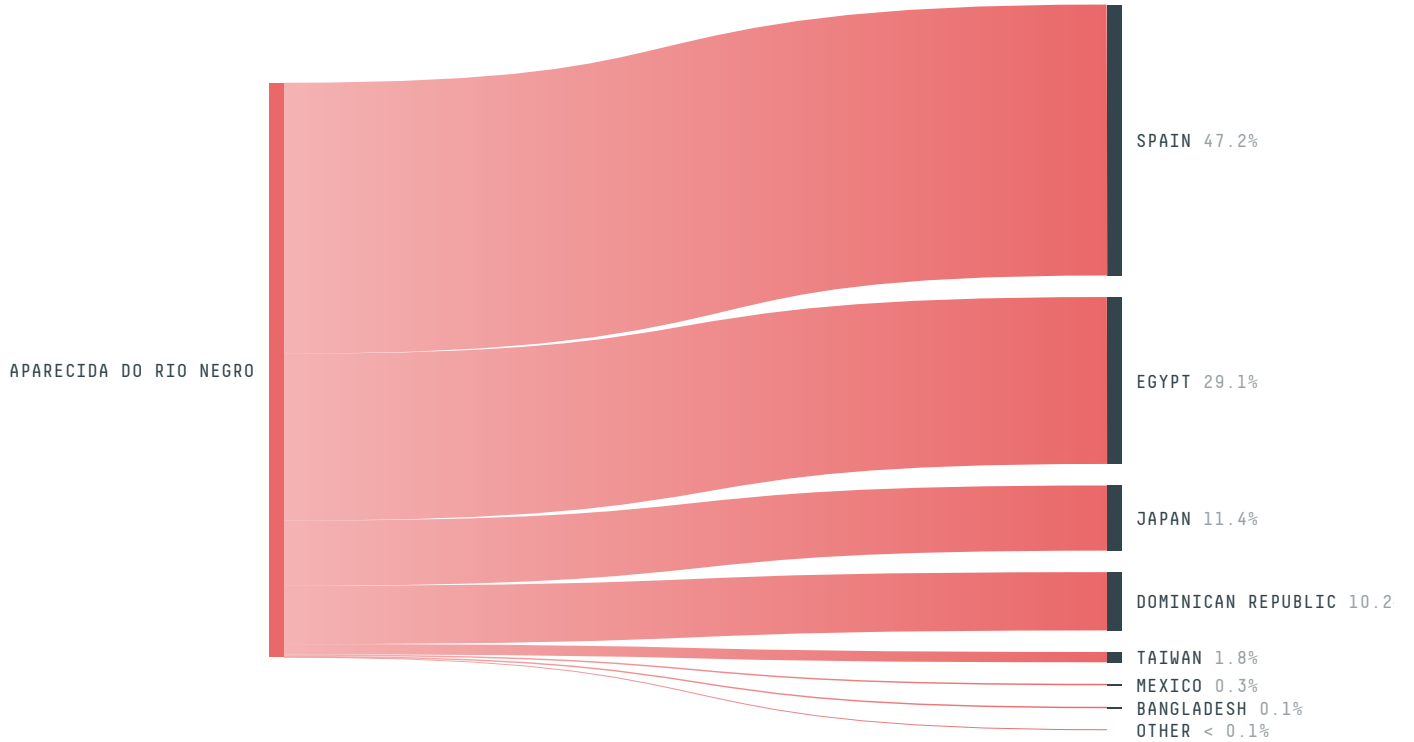
### DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF APARECIDA DO RIO NEGRO
