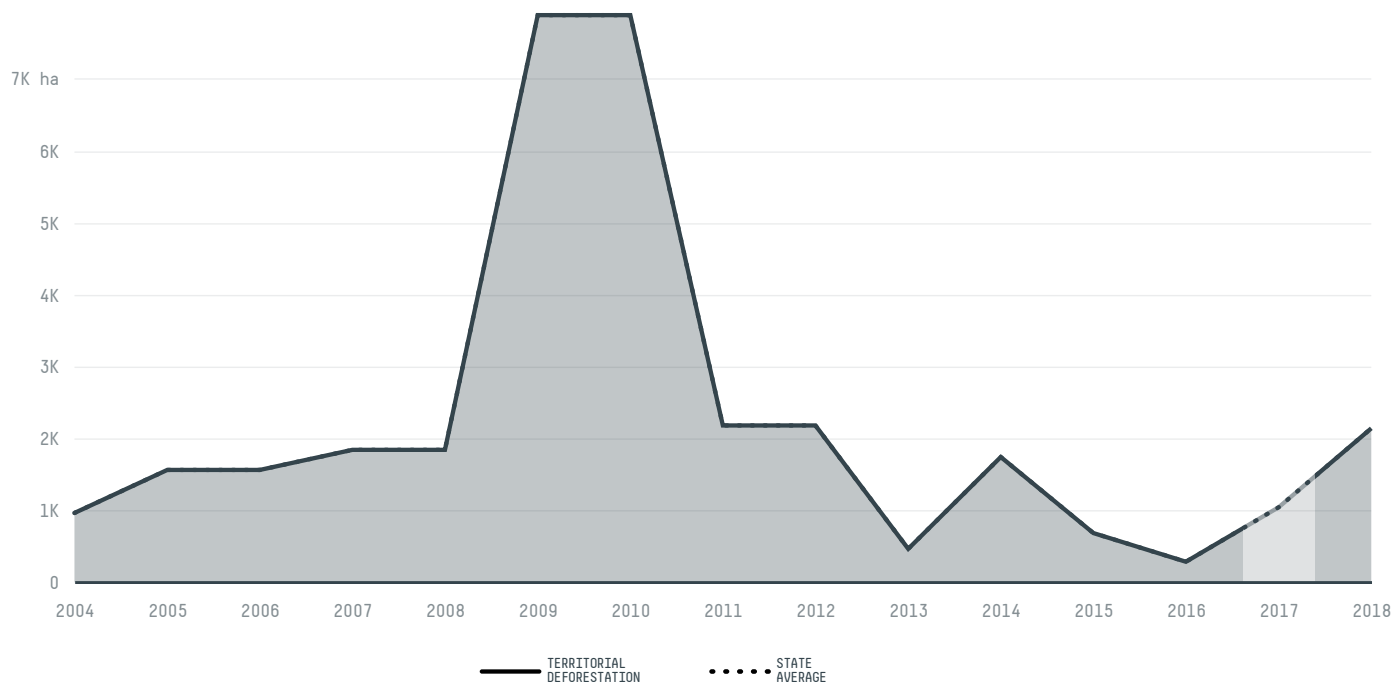

In 2017, Santa Quiteria Do Maranhao produced 1,221 t of corn occupying a total of 825 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1630th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Santa Quiteria Do Maranhao was Novaagri Infra Estrutura De Armazenagem E Escoamento Agricol, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.

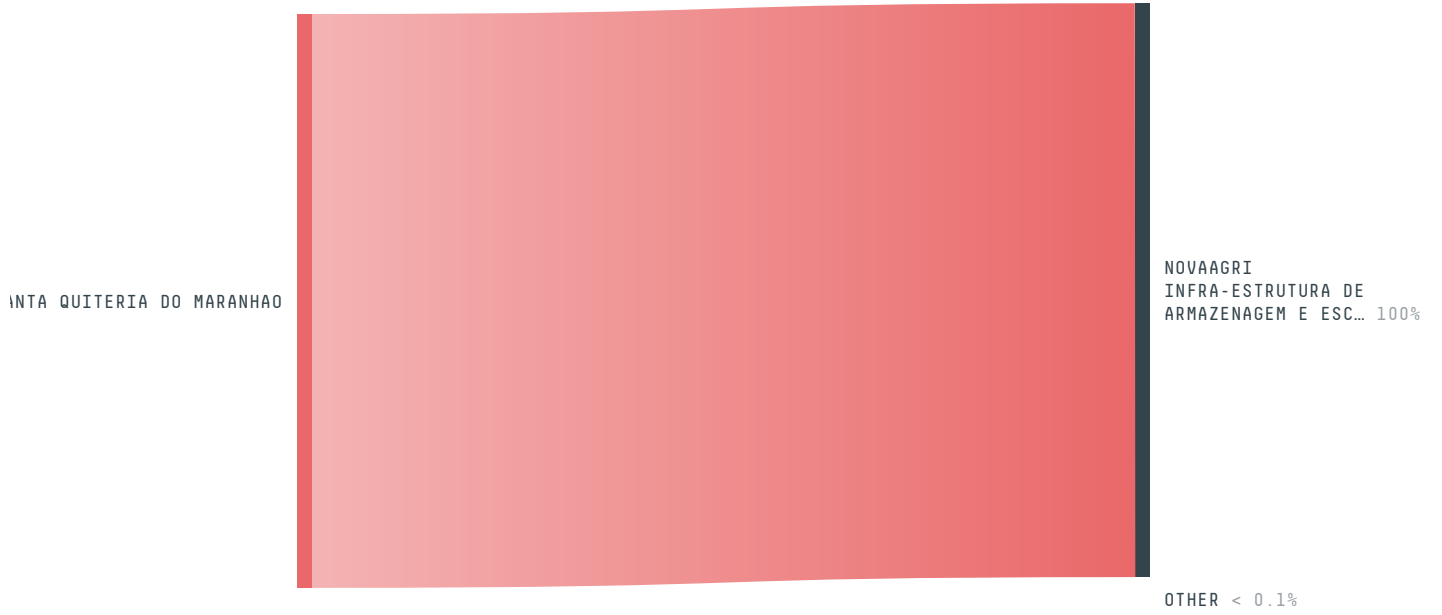
