In 2017, Riachao produced 91,791 t of corn occupying a total of 20,674 ha of land. With 0.06% of the total production, it ranks 193rd in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Riachao was Mitsubishi Corporation Do Brasil, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

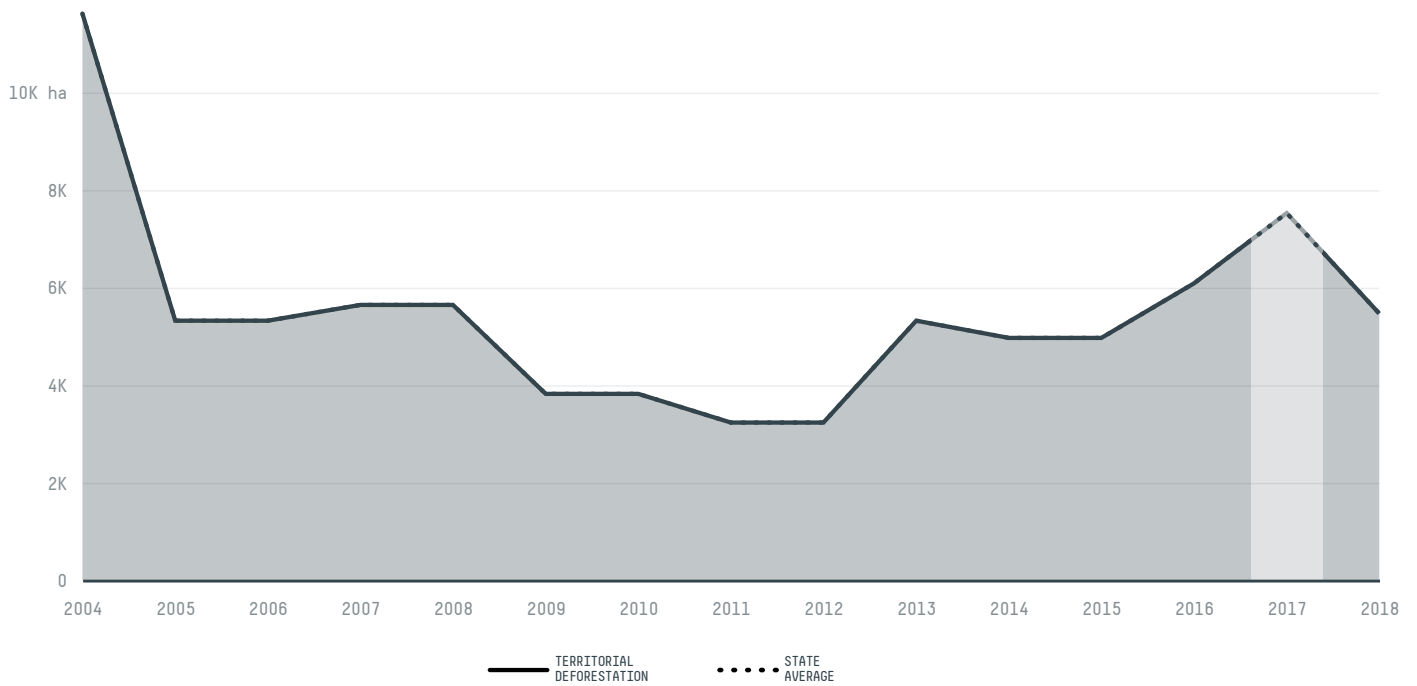

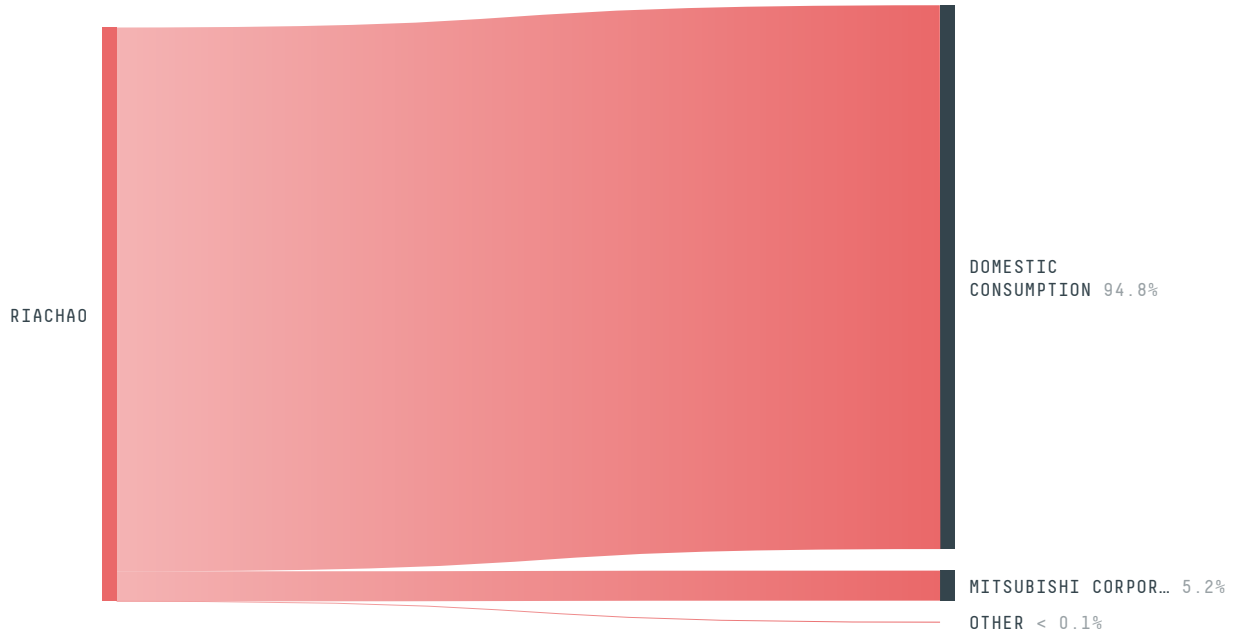
