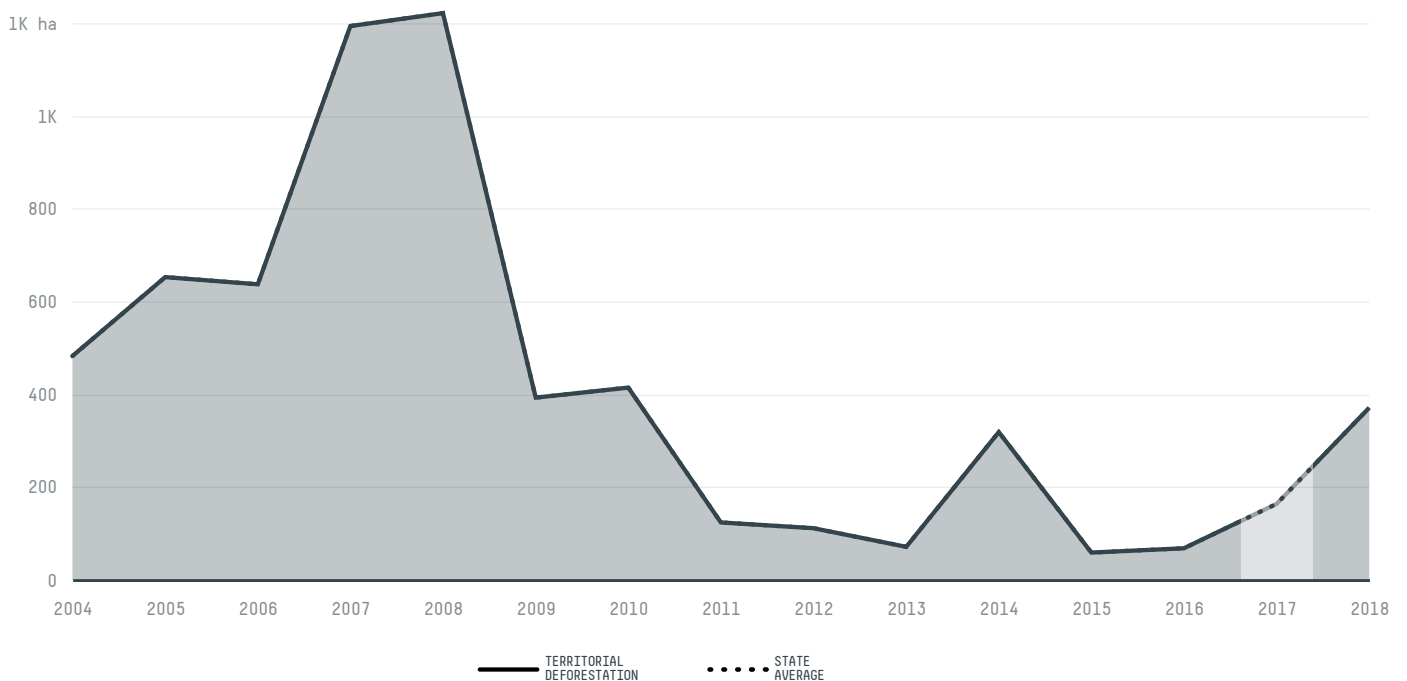

In 2017, Presidente Vargas produced 228 t of corn occupying a total of 600 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2030th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Presidente Vargas was Novaagri Infra Estrutura De Armazenagem E Escoamento Agricol, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.
