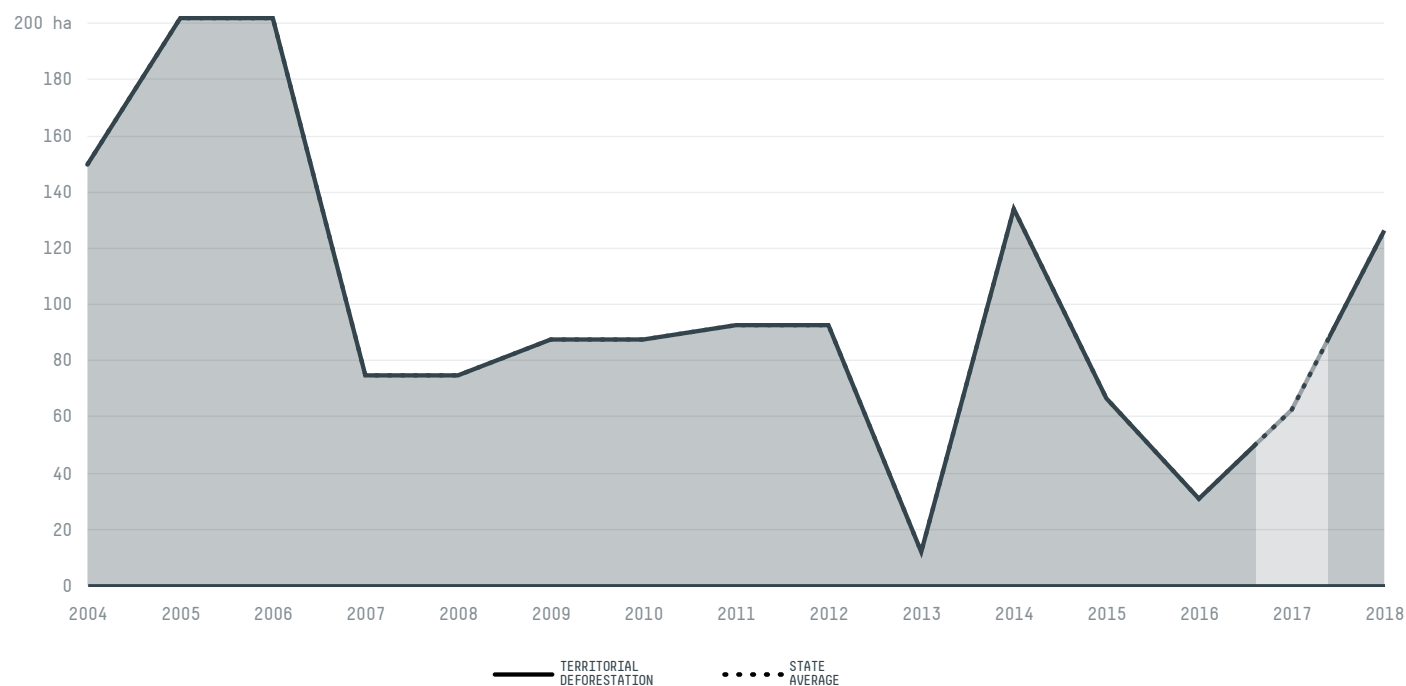

In 2017, Sao Joao Do Arraial produced 235 t of corn occupying a total of 294 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2025th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Sao Joao Do Arraial was Novaagri Infra Estrutura De Armazenagem E Escoamento Agricol, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.
