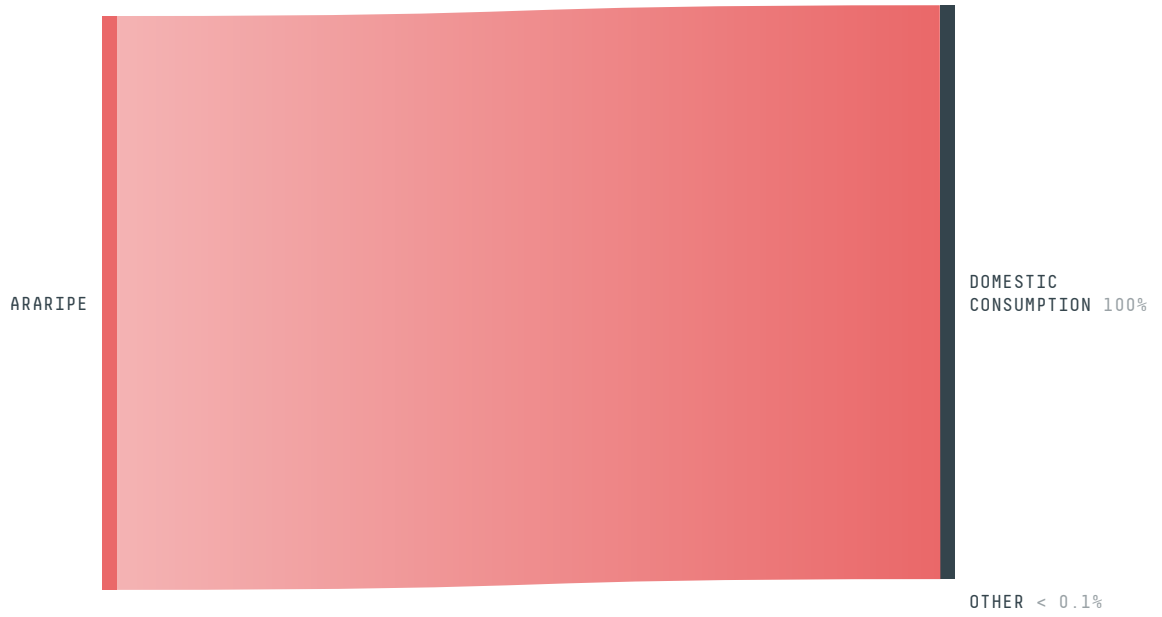

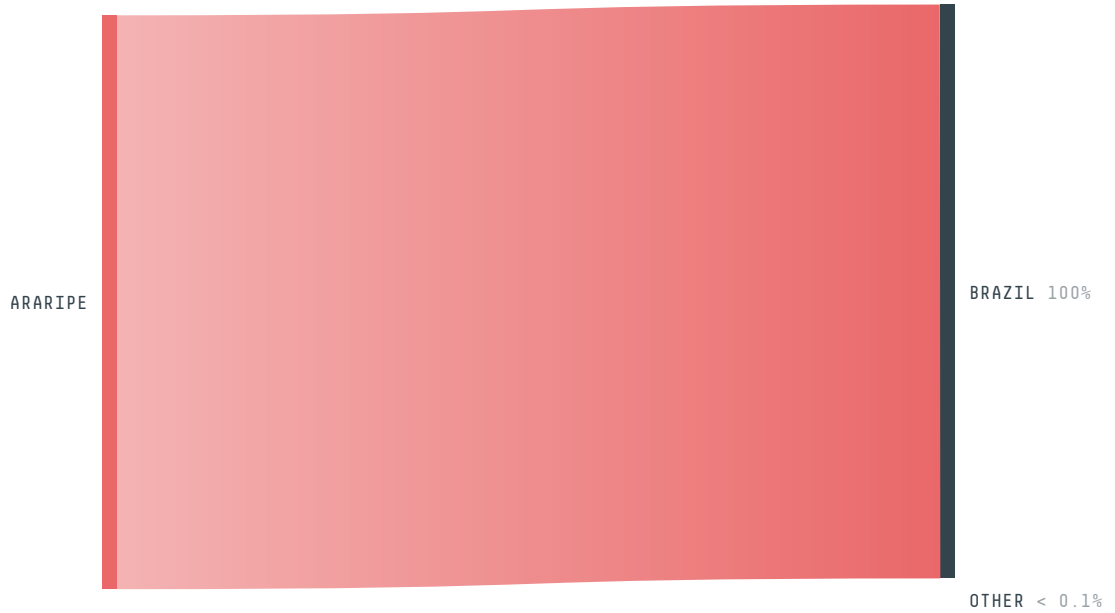
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF ARARIPE
