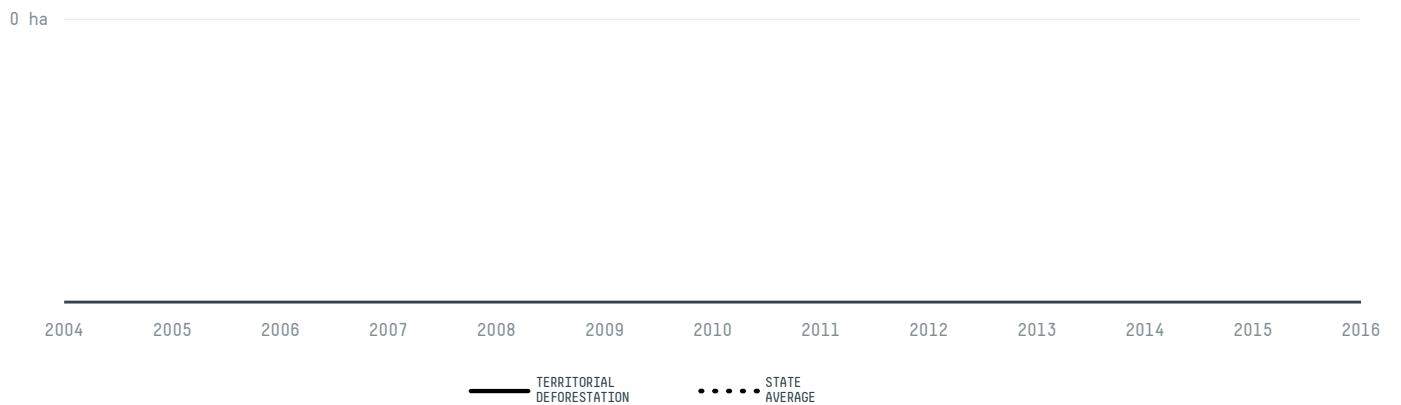
AREA PRODUCTION OF CORN CORN LAND

In 2016, Sape produced 2 t of corn occupying a total of 5 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1955th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Sape was Viera Agrocereais Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Uruguay.

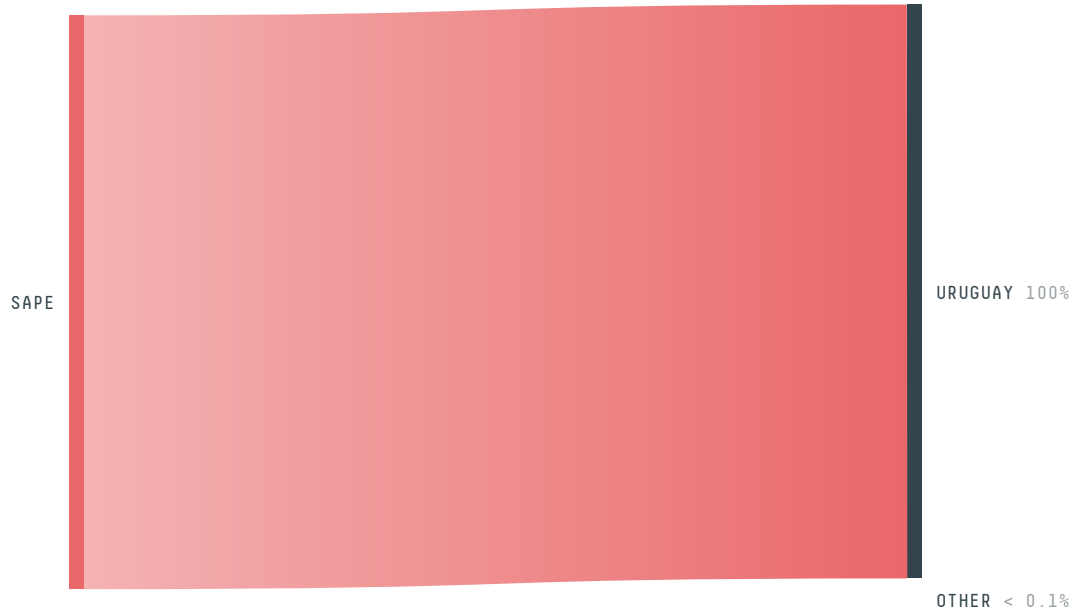
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF SAPE
