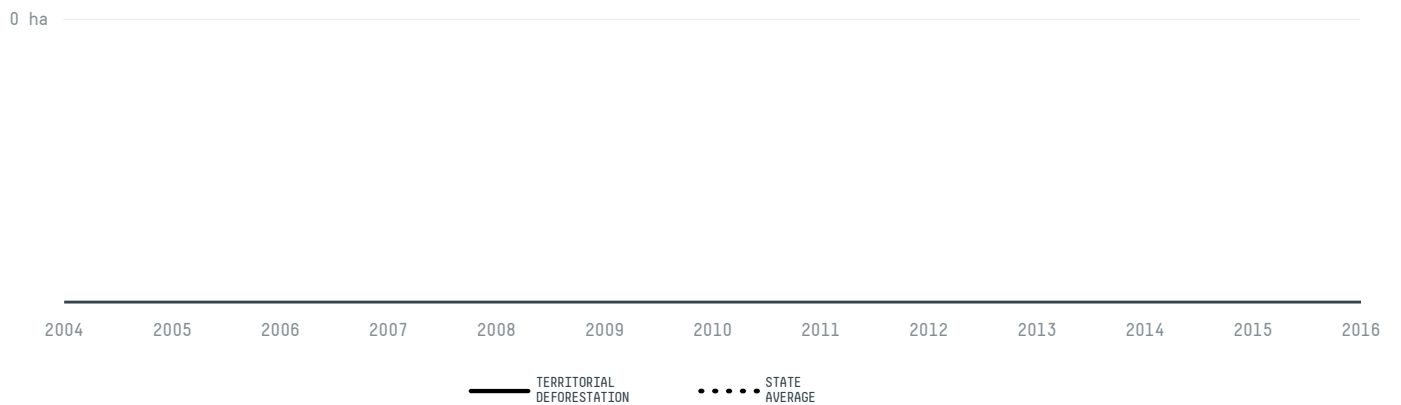

In 2016, Sobrado produced 5 t of corn occupying a total of 10 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1952nd in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Sobrado was Viera Agrocereais Ltda, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Uruguay.

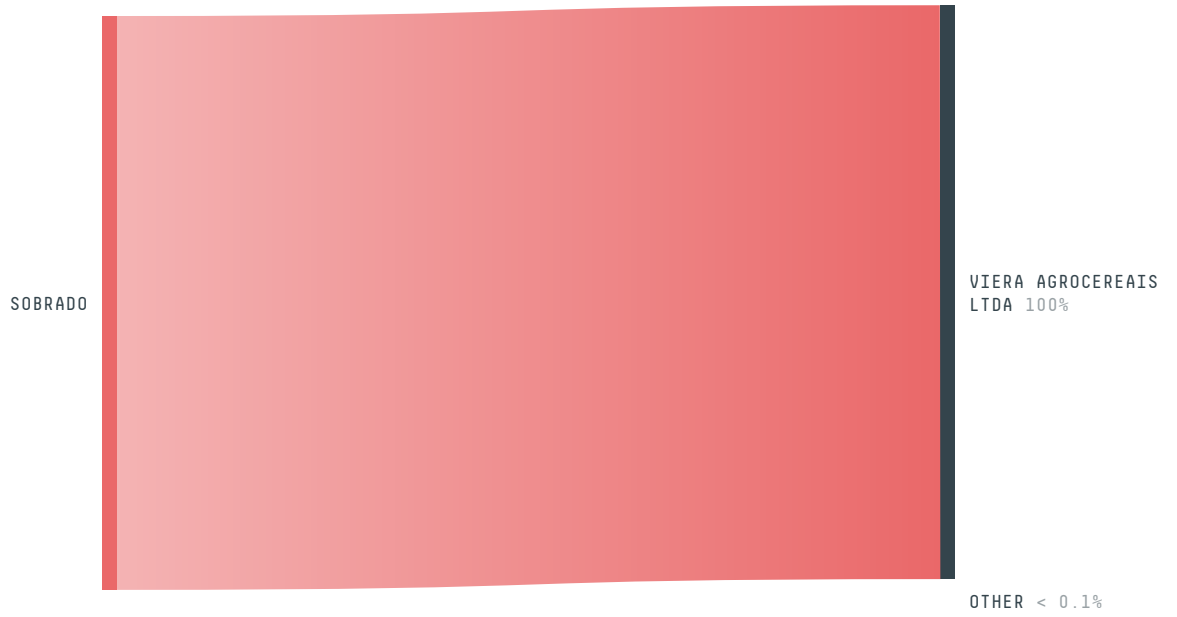
