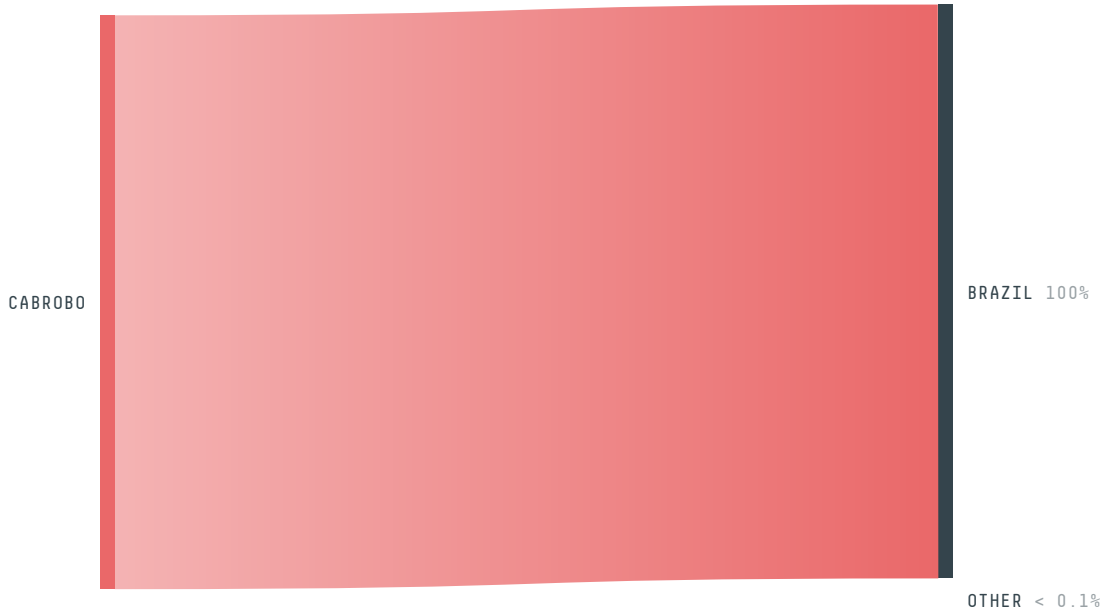
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CABROBO
