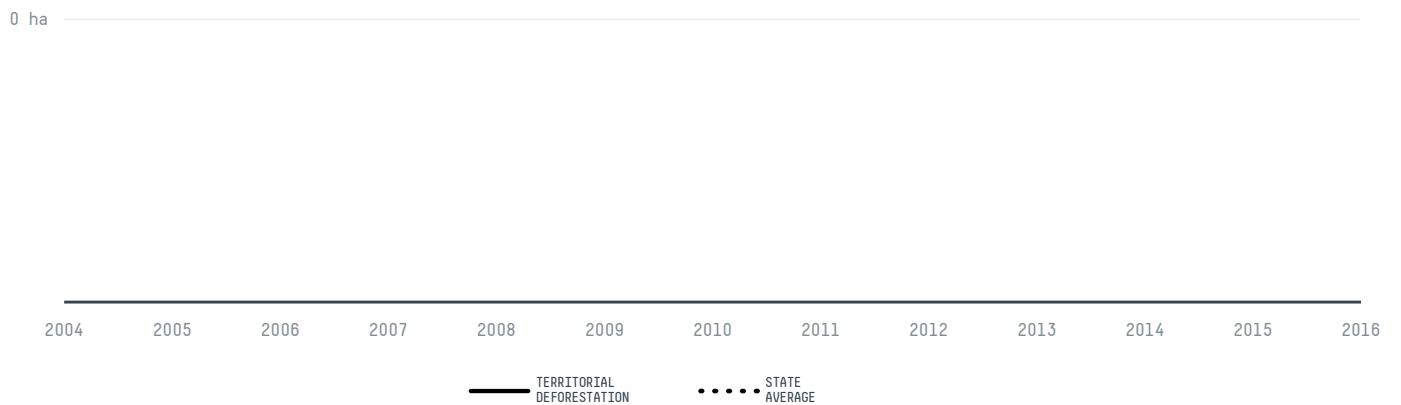
In 2017, Carpina produced 6 t of corn occupying a total of 10 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 2225th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Carpina was Ms Pescados Comercio, Importacao E Exportacao, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.
