In 2017, Cumaru produced 3,000 t of corn occupying a total of 4,000 ha of land. With less than 0.01% of the total production, it ranks 1346th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Cumaru was Usina Petribu Sa, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Egypt.
