In 2017, Inhambupe produced 28,800 t of corn occupying a total of 8,000 ha of land. With 0.02% of the total production, it ranks 539th in Brazil in corn production. The largest exporter of corn in Inhambupe was Proquigel Quimica, which accounted for 100.0% of the total exports, and the main destination was Brazil.

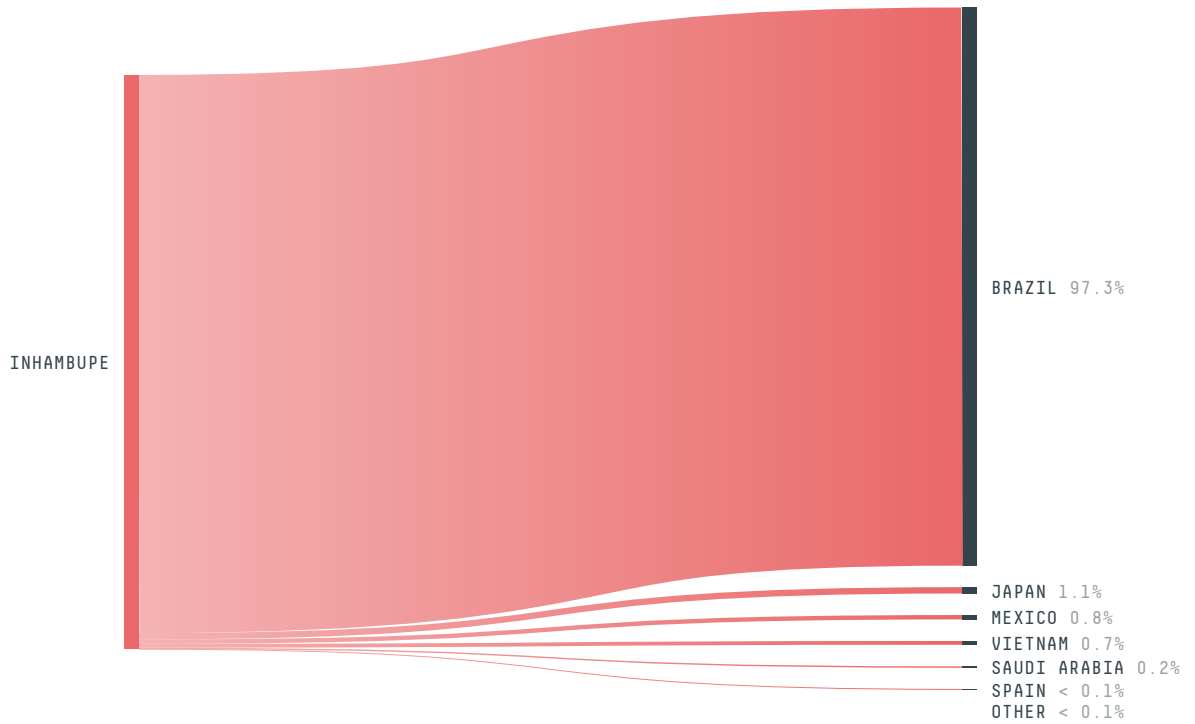
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF INHAMBUPE
