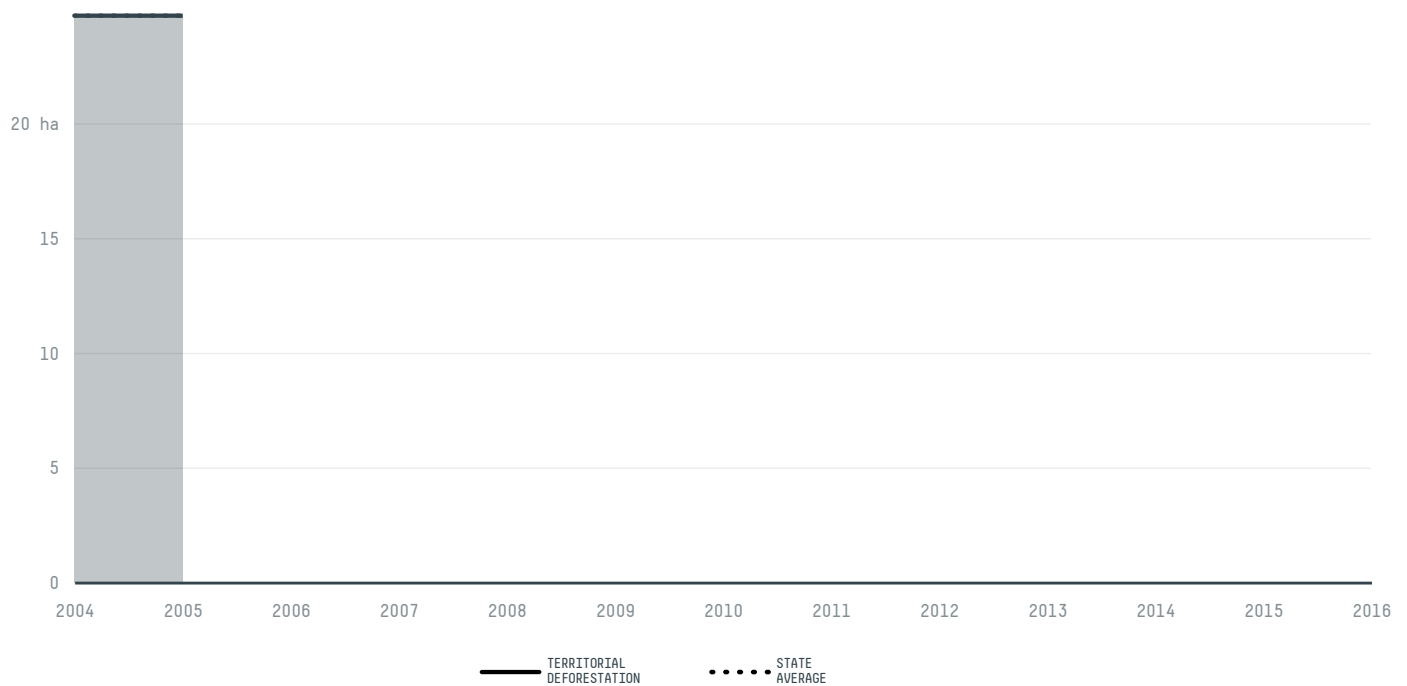

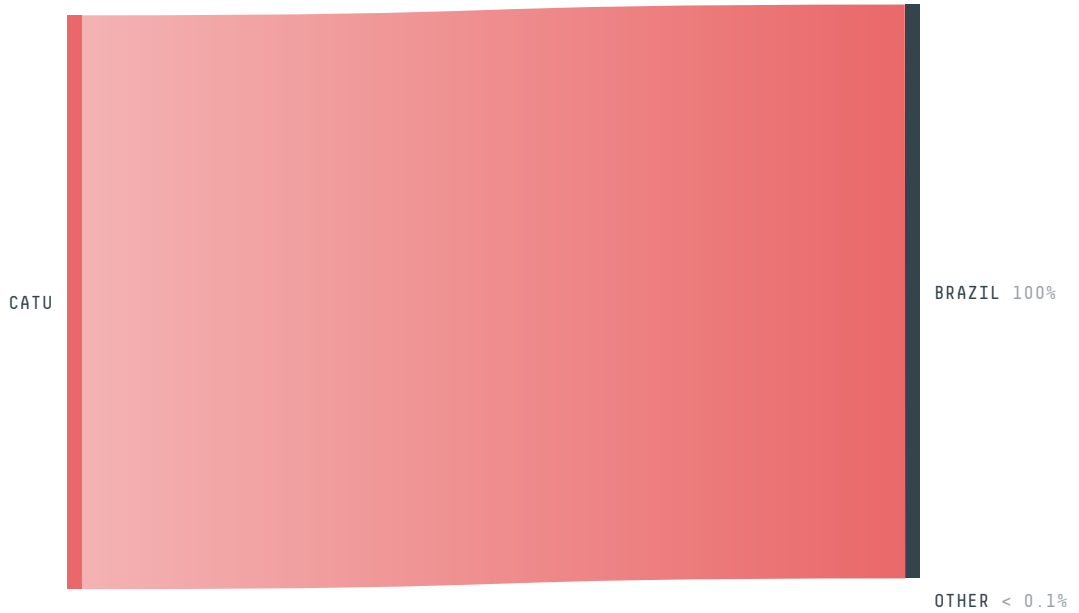
DEFORESTATION TRAJECTORY OF CATU
